- a) Easement Enforcement
 - Mr. Beckenstein reported on the December meeting with Mr. Marconi. Mr. Marconi agreed to meet with Mr. Reddington about the tree cutting on open space and discuss the \$75,000 reimbursement to the Town for the value of the trees cut down.
- b) McKeon Farm Ms. Snow will contact a local certified organic farmer that may be able to help with the development plan for the farm. The McKeon Committee (Ms. Snow, Mr. Beckenstein & Mr. Brewster) hope to develop a long term plan by March, 2016.

<u>High School Interns</u> – Ms. Snow was approached by Ridgefield High School about the RCC's interest in sponsoring interns during Spring, 2016. Mr. Cronin & Ms. Snow agreed to supervise 3 students over the 4-6 week period. Other RCC members are encouraged to help.

<u>Conservation Fund</u> - Dr. Oko mentioned an effort to introduce legislation that would allow CT communities to create a conservation fund, attained through a surcharge on the buyers of residential property sales. Dr. Oko would like to promote this effort on behalf of the RCC.
