

**Minutes – Parks and Recreation  
Buildings and Grounds  
Sub-Committee Meeting  
April 1, 2009**

Meeting was convened to continue discussions on the requests made by SCOR, Lacrosse and the Ridgefield Rebels to allow additional out-of-town players on Ridgefield teams.

1. Mr. Tinker asked Mr. Kearns to summarize discussions, perspectives, and decisions made.
2. Mr. Tinker instructed Mr. Schneider to formerly answer Mr. Phil Bergen/SCOR's request to develop a premier program, and to continue to monitor youth Lacrosse and reiterate as needed the Field Use Criteria.
3. Mr. Tinker would contact the Rebels to set-up a meeting (requested by the Rebels) with the P&R Buildings and Grounds sub-committee.
4. It was decided to extend the Youth Sports Field Allocations, Field Use Criteria item # 8, to adult sports limiting out-of-town players.
5. Mr. Tinker instructed Mr. Schneider to formerly contact adult sports informing them of this decision.
6. The sub-committee agreed to "grandfather" adult womens softball to allow them time to work towards complying beyond 1/1/2010. This will be reviewed at a later date.
