Town of Ridgefield Code of Ordinances Review and Update

R. Marconi called the meeting to order at 2:10 p.m.

Discussion ensued about the suggested changes to the Code of Ordinances by General Code, the new publisher of the Town Code. General Code has granted an extension to the Town's original deadline of October 28, 2005 to submit the editorial analysis response. The new deadline is January 1, 2006. It was decided that several special meetings of the Board of Selectmen might be necessary to review the Code and suggested changes.

W. Lionetti was asked to research the correct name of the Commission on the Disabled. Is it "on the Disabled" or "for the Disabled?"

The decision was made to change Article X. Commission on Alcohol and Drug Use to reflect current committee—Ridgefield Community Prevention Council.

The Board will write to the Charter Revision Commission to notify them to change the terminology in the Charter from "Civil Preparedness" to "Emergency Preparedness" as in current practice.

W. Lionetti will send Article IV. Auxiliary Police Department to Police Chief Ligi for review. She will also send section on Alarm Systems and Fire Alarm Systems to Police Chief Ligi and Fire Chief Lou Yarrish for their review.

R. Marconi moved and J. Plock seconded a motion to adjourn the Board of Selectmen meeting at 3:40 p.m. Motion passed 5-0.
