The meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm.

ITEM# 1: REVIEW MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING.

A MOTION WAS MADE, SECONDED AND UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTED TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS WRITTEN.

ITEM # 2: REPORTS AND DISCUSSION ON COURSE OPERATIONS.

Mr. Sergiovanni:

1. Handed out and reviewed financials.
2. The work on rewiring the cart barn is being completed. Mr. Sergiovanni gave an overview of the work that was being done and a brief history of the incidents that

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occurred that required the rewiring of the battery chargers for the electric carts. Mr. Sergiovanni indicated that after his review of the original contract for the work initially provided by Club Car five years ago, it appeared the responsibility for the rewiring fell upon Club Cars' shoulders. The work would be completed tonight and there will be no cost to the Golf Course.

ITEM # 3 OLD BUSINESS:

Ms. Gerhard indicated work on the Plaque for recognition of the Flagpole donations was still in progress. Ms. Gerhard felt the Plaque should be completed by next month.

ITEM # 4 NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Fazi brought up the topic of a new Club House being brought back onto the Capital Budget for FY 2012. Mr. Sergiovanni indicated that the majority of his day, every day, is spent putting band aids on problems relating to the deteriorating conditions of the Club House. Discussion took place. The Committee agreed to continue discussions at the next meeting. It was generally agreed a decision needed to be made by sometime in November 2010.

ITEM # 6 PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Ms. Doty again indicated the need for directional signage to the next Tee Box at certain locations throughout the Golf Course. Mr. Sergiovanni stated that identification of those areas will be made.

It was also noted that there are comments being made daily by residents, non-residents, and first time players about how impressed they are with the "great" condition the Golf Course is in. There is much praise for the Maintenance Department.
