1. Branchville Station permit parking discussion. Now that approved, discuss how the distribution of permits will occur, if a kiosk is appropriate for day parking, and how the process will work (including if able to determine commuting regularity can be included in the decision to issue a permit)
2. Addressi request to increase time limits on Main Street in front of his building and those buildings along the same strip.

1. A discussion of the lottery system to be used at Branchville now that the permit costs have been approved took place. The annual permits would likely be a first come, first serve on a Saturday morning. This is still to be determined and presented to the BOS on September 1, 2010. Discussion on a kiosk, weekly, monthly passes and if the parking enforcement officer should be providing the ticketing took place. Marconi indicated he would be looking into kiosks. McNicholas indicated he would be finding out how many commuter passes are being purchased from Branchville. There was also a discussion on if we can provide discounts for senior parking.
2. Wayne Addressi requested a review of the time limits on Main Street in front of his building. The parking enforcement officer is going to speak to the other tenants to get their opinion of changing the limits to 2 hrs instead of 1 hr.
