1) 74 High Ridge Avenue – Paving of driveway with asphalt and enlargement of parking area

Voted 5-0 to approve the revised application as presented by Attorney Jewell and Mr. Ali for the paving of the driveway with asphalt in the current form and design while retaining the Belgium block as borders.

2) 50 High Ridge Avenue - Replacement of current wood shingled roof with a tin roof

Voted 5-0 to deny the application without prejudice in view of the application withdrawal for a replacement of the current wood shingled roof with a tin roof.

3) Approval of the February 17, 2022 HDC minutes and March 13, 2022 HDC site visit minutes

Voted 5-0 to approve the February 17, 2022 regular HDC minutes and March 13, 2022 HDC site minutes with Commission members who did not attend such meeting abstaining.
