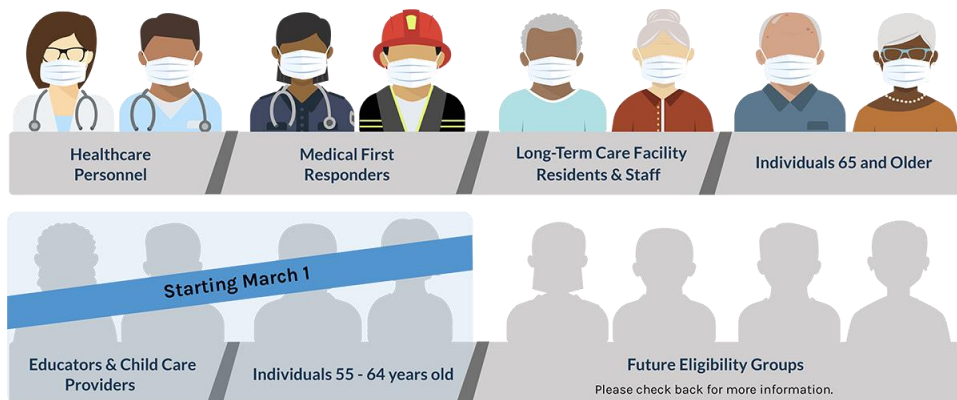

RIDGEFIELD, CT: February 26, 2021: BEGINNING MONDAY, MARCH 1, 2021, the State will require verification to confirm eligibility at the time of the vaccination appointment. PLAN TO BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- For 1A, congregate and education/childcare staff individuals should provide an employment ID badge, payroll stub, business card, letter from employer or other documentation.*
- All individuals eligible due to age bracket should bring an ID or other documentation demonstrating date of birth/age.*
- Proof that you live or work in the State of Connecticut. If a recent move/relocation to CT, some documentation of residence ie; electric bill, tax form, etc. is required.
- Health Insurance card if you have one.
- Confirmation of appointment. **The clinic does not take walk-ins.**
- Second dose recipients, please bring first dose vaccination card.
- First dose recipients must make sure they are not signing for a second dose only clinic as the system will allow it, but they will be bounced out later before their appointment
