

Connecticut and US: Age 18+ Initiated and Completed Vaccinations




Age 18+: Initiated and Completed Vaccinations



Number of Doses Administered Each Day




Connecticut: Doses Administered Each Day






Connecticut: First Doses are decreasing again after brief surge. Second doses continue to decrease.
