The Commission plans to have quarterly reviews with Vanguard.

<u>MISCELLANEOUS</u>: The Commission discussed a number of issues to include closing of a T. Rowe Price account, governance issues on bill payments, reviewing the Pension Funds trust document, reviewing the Investment Policy Statements for the Pension funds and OPEB, and liability insurance. The 2016 attendance report was reviewed and will be submitted to the Town Clerk.
