



## Area 27 COLONIAL HEIGHTS REFUGE

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Trail Section with Woods and Wetlands

Size: 19 acres

**ACCESS/PARKING:** Pumping Station Road, 0.1 mile from Oscaleta Road on the left. [GPS Address: 35 Pumping Station Road]

**DIFFICULTY:** Easy with one rocky intermittent stream crossing. About 1 hour out and back.

**FEATURES:** A hemlock/hardwood forest and wetland with two streams, a view of a pond, and plentiful wildflowers in spring. The trail leads across a bridge over the stream along the road and then through a hemlock forest along a marsh. After crossing another stream, it leads through a hardwood forest to a wooded knoll before ending in about 0.5 mile at a meadow around a pond (private property) on the New York state line.

**HISTORY:** Acquired by subdivision.



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
