Looking to start committee back up—maximum of 9 members; must be Ridgefield resident. Tony Phillips, Dir. Of Social Services, pointed out that COA needs to clarify if Commissioner can be an official member on the Committee. Commissioners would be more than welcome to attend committee meeting and have input.

Need for more options of affordable housing in town was discussed at length.

John Frey was our scheduled speaker but did not show.

Chris stated that MSP was reinstated to what it was before.

Karen indicated that Rudy Marconi has asked us to organize a picnic at Martin Park for seniors. September time frame of this year was talked about after park officially closes for

season. Suggestion was made to have new Parks & Rec admin, Dennis DiPinto, come to a meeting.

Also discussed various intergenerational programs in town.

Chris spoke of COA meeting with police and K9 unit on May 15th. Turn out was a bit low, but meeting was informative. Another meeting with police department to be set up in the future.
