Tony stated that Neighbors to Neighbors has continued to serve seniors and have adjusted accordingly. They currently have 70 residents they shopping for. The COA may help them obtain volunteers with our marketing efforts if needed should we see a second wave.

Karen brought up the issue of fire alarms always going off when resident cook at Ballard and Congregate and has been a long standing issue.

Lynn Marie offered to research RFD calls from Ballard and Congregate and report back at our next meeting.

Lynn Marie suggested writing a letter to the RPD to thank them for all their help during with seniors at Ballard Green during the last storm by doing wellness checks and water deliveries. Lynn Marie will send to Laura for approval.

Debra discussed if we should update our COA resource flyer with additional shopping methods. She will share list for next meeting.
