1. PINE MOUNTAIN MEDITATION STRUCTURE

Each commissioner was given five minutes to explain their position on the meditation structure.

Two options were discussed. Option A – Leave the wooden structure and surrounding rocks in place. Option B – Leave the wooden structure as is until early-mid fall, at which point the creator will remove only the wooden structure, leaving the rocks undisturbed.

UPON motion duly made (Welby), seconded (Levine), and carried it was RESOLVED to vote on Option A or Option B.

Option A received four votes (Beckenstein, Levine, Snow, Welby)
Option B received five votes (Brewster, Coyle, Cronin, Kace, Keller).

Option B carries. The wooden structure will be removed with guidance from the RCC in the fall of 2020.
