ITEM # 2 REPORTS AND DISCUSSION ON COURSE OPERATIONS

Mr. Sergiovanni:

1. The Golf Course re-opened for business on April 27th for walkers only. On May 2nd – May 14th riding carts were available and restricted to 1 person per riding cart with a maximum of 2 individuals playing per tee time. After May 14th, the maximum group per tee time increased to 4 individuals with the same restriction of 1 person per riding cart.
2. The Restaurant had been providing take out only service until today. Today the deck was opened for outdoor sit-down dining. The tent was re-installed on the deck.
3. Most individuals are adhering to the New Rules and Regulations for Play. There have been minor enforcement challenges. All requirements are published on the Golf Course Website. There is also a PDF online to print score cards for use by the public.
4. As expected, due to the closure and riding cart restrictions, revenues are off.
5. The availability of riding carts due to the one person per cart restrictions has worked so far. Riding Carts are being sanitized after morning rounds and are being sent out again for afternoon play. So far, the Golf Course has been able to keep up with the demand for riding carts.
6. The Golf Course grounds are in exceptionally great shape.

1. The Ash Trees on the Golf Course identified for removal will be done "in house" during the remainder of the year.
