ITEM # 2 REPORTS AND DISCUSSION ON COURSE OPERATIONS

Mr. Sergiovanni:

1. The Golf Course has been busy. The month of August was
solid as well as the beginning of September.

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2. Clean up of downed trees after the August storm is almost completed.
3. A town easement by the 17th Tee has been cleared to allow Emergency Vehicles to enter the Golf Course by Sarah Bishop Road.
4. With the weather getting cooler, the Irrigation system may be winterized earlier than usual.
5. The revised Covid-19 procedures pertaining to riding carts has been working out well. There is a sufficient number of carts with a divider between the driver and the passenger.
6. The RFP for the new Riding Cart Lease will go out to the three vendors who supply Riding Carts to Golf Courses in Connecticut. Two proposals will be requested from each vendor. One proposal will be for carts without GPS units and the second proposal will include installation of GPS units on each cart. A review of the proposals will take place to see if the addition of GPS units is feasible.

1. The Paving of Cart Paths was discussed. Paving of cart paths and installation of new paths should begin in October. Mr. Sergiovanni gave a brief overview of where paving would take place.
