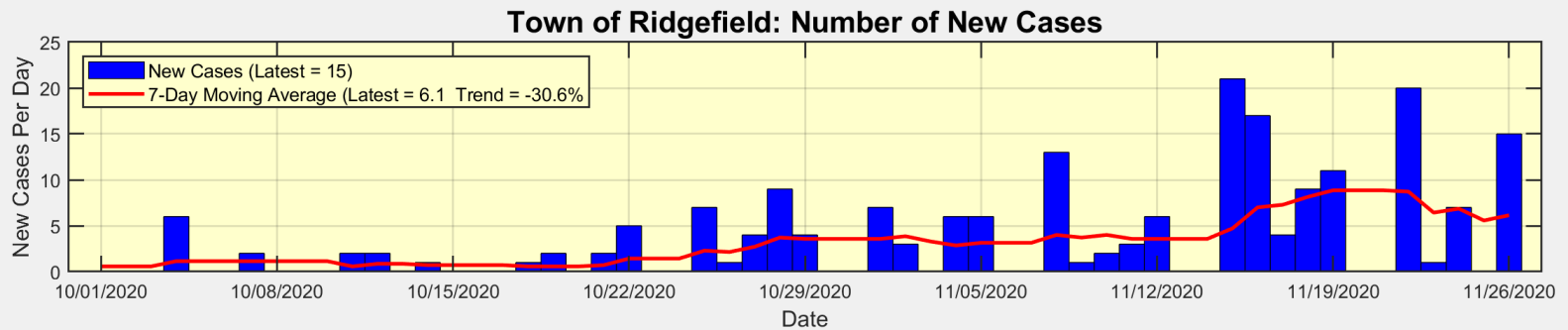

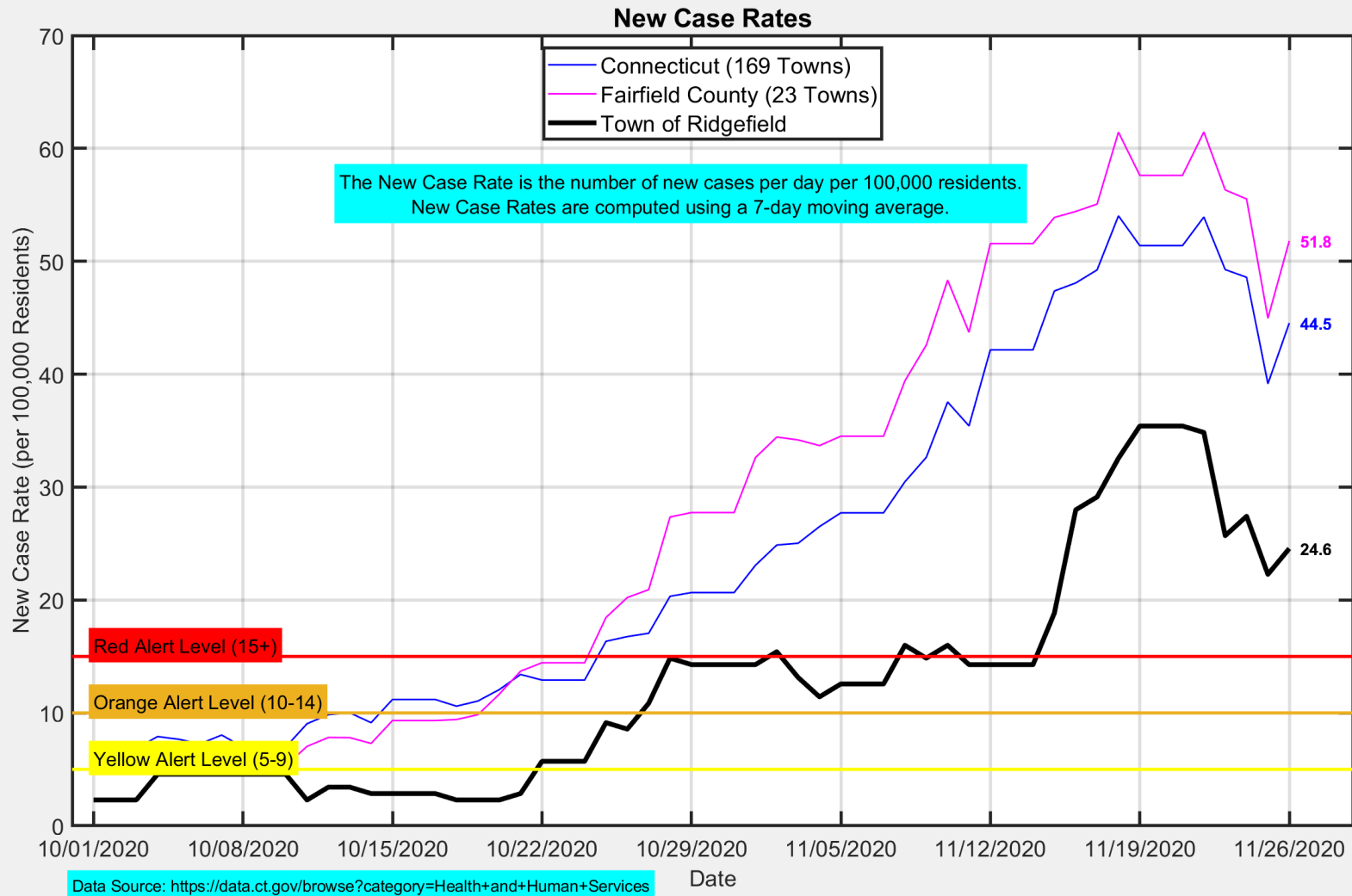
There were 15 new cases reported in Ridgefield over the past 2 days (no report on Thanksgiving)



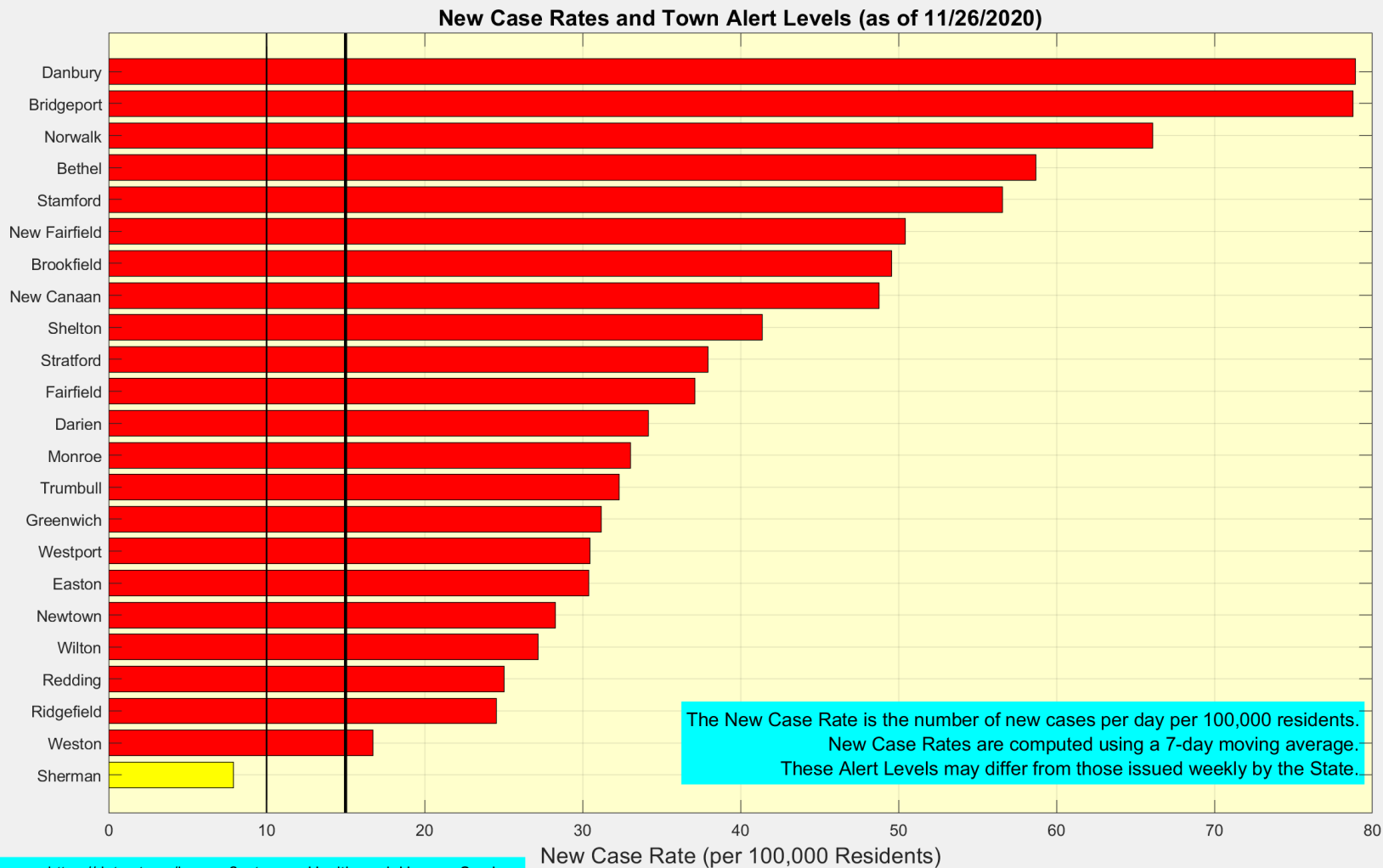

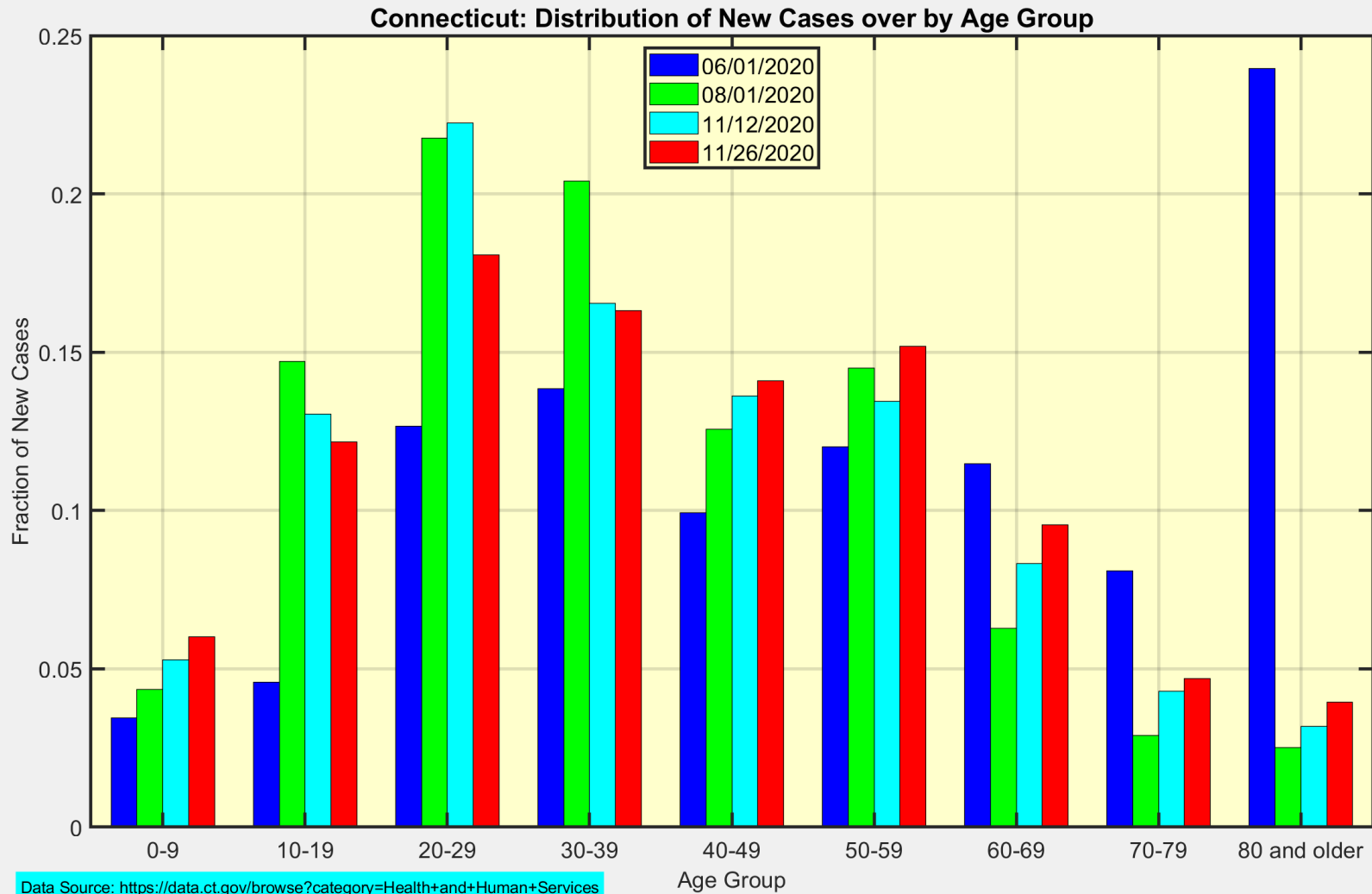
The Ridgefield New Case Rate remained stable at 24.6 per 100,000 residents.



These are the latest New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County.



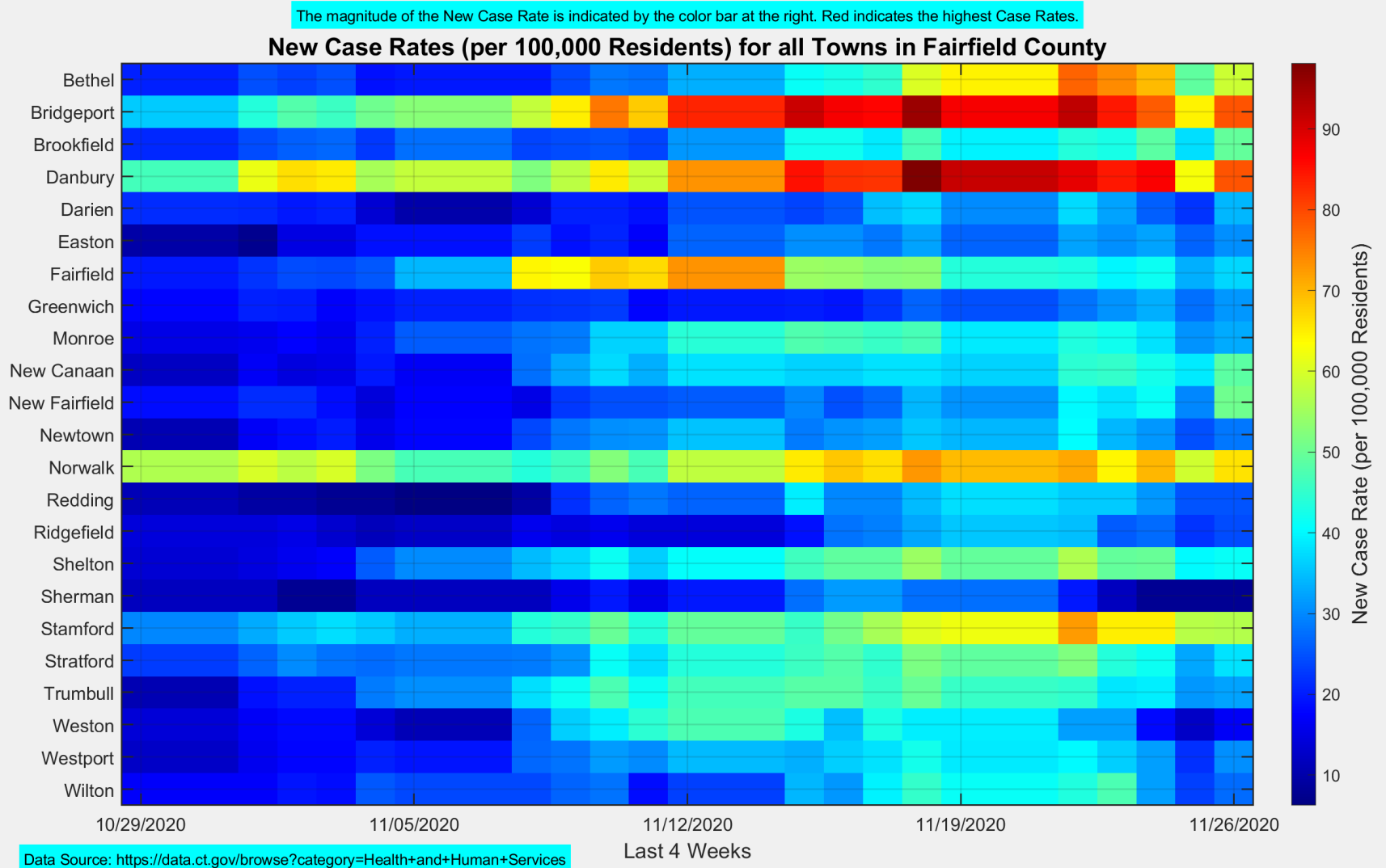
This is the distribution of New Cases over age group for the entire State of Connecticut.



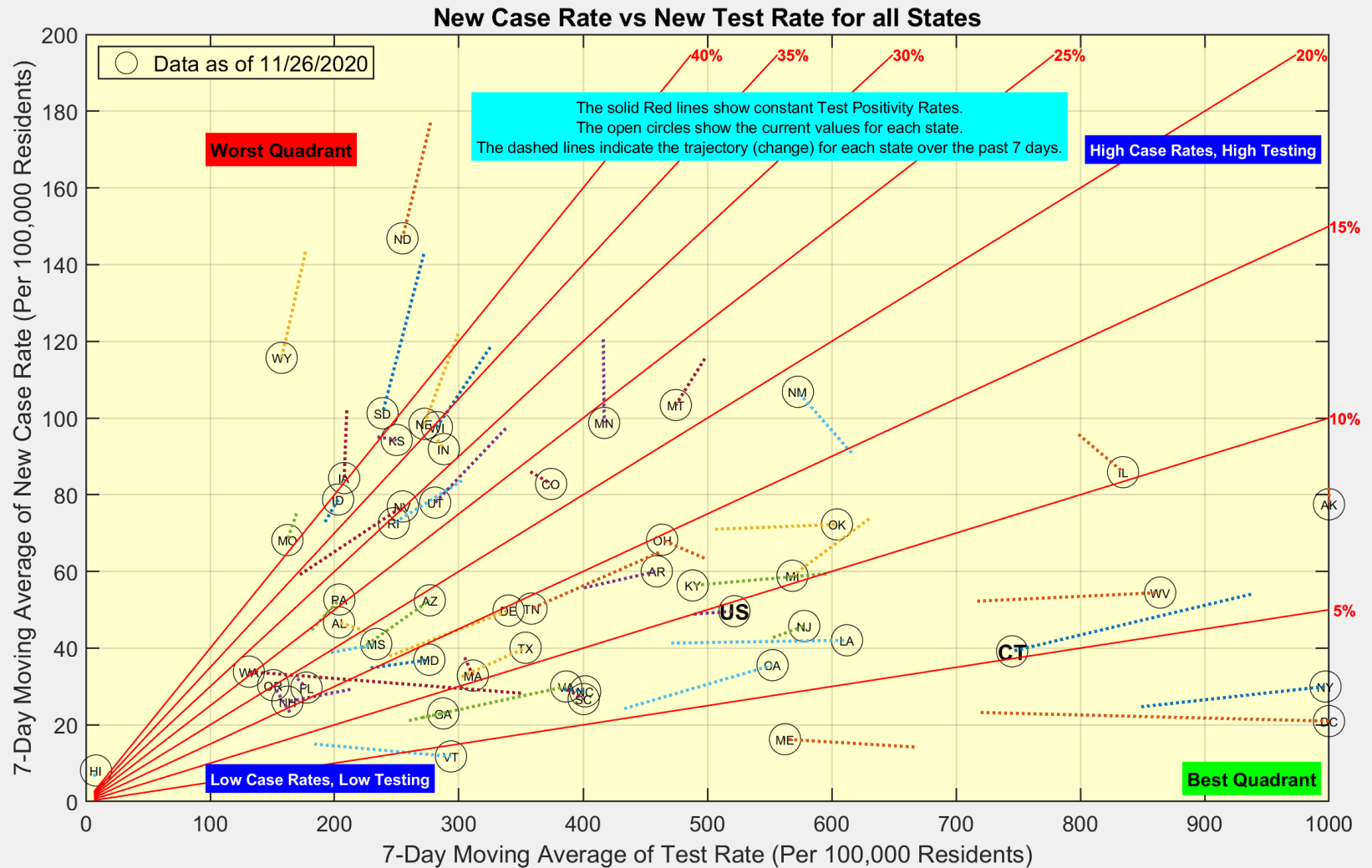

Connecticut Test Rate dropped over the past 7 days ... still higher than most states

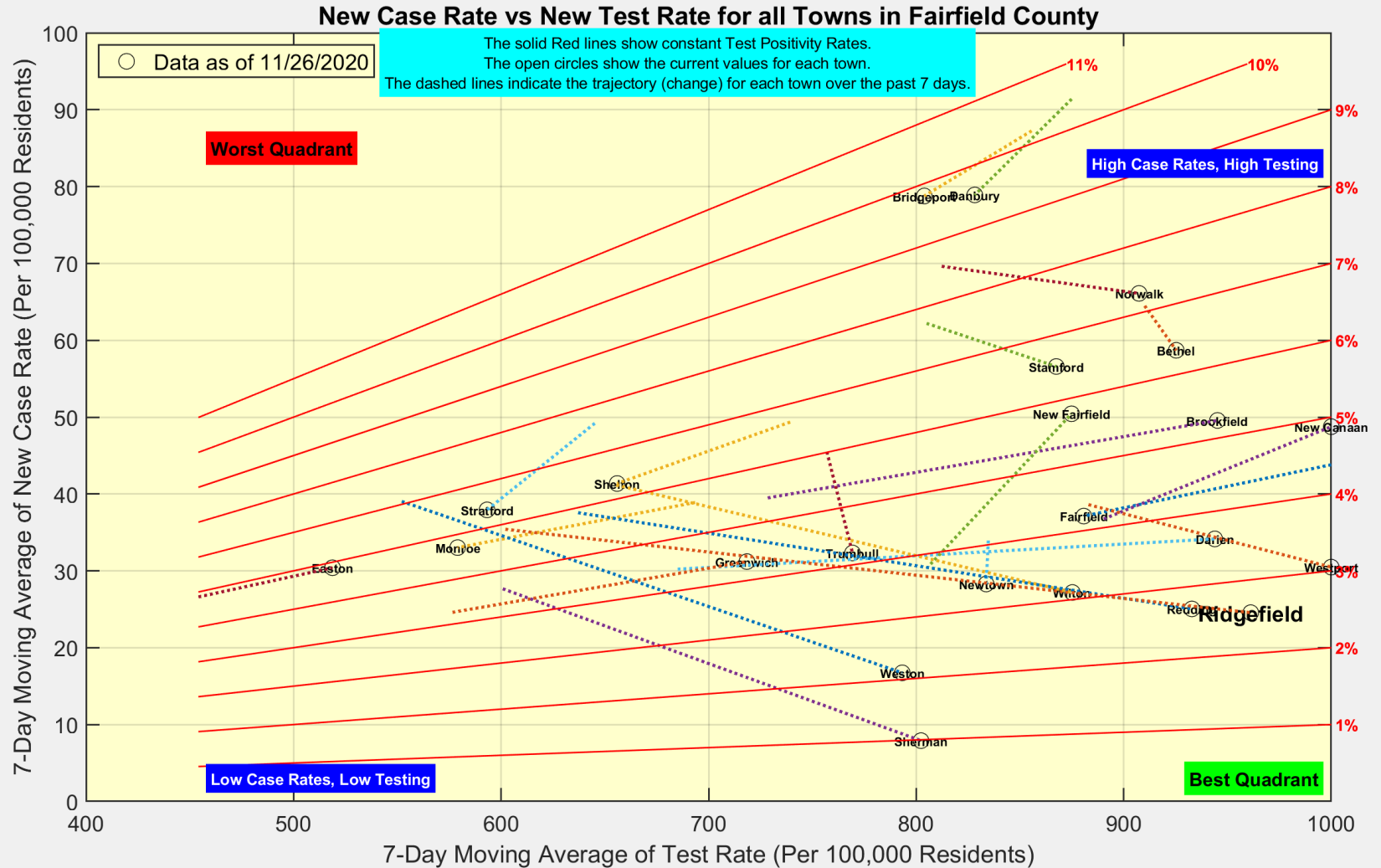
