




New Case Rates and Test Positivity for Connecticut, Fairfield County, and Ridgefield








New Cases, New Tests, and Test Positivity for Ridgefield






New Case Rates vs Vaccination Rates for Towns in Fairfield County






Latest Vaccination Rates for Towns in Fairfield County




Latest Vaccination Rates for Ridgefield Residents






Latest Vaccination Numbers for Ridgefield Residents





Ridgefield New Case Rates are HIGHER than one year ago (WHEN NO ONE WAS VACCINATED)

Contact tracing has shown that essentially all new cases are in the Ridgefield unvaccinated population. Hence, the unvaccinated population is keeping Ridgefield New Case Rates at a level higher than a year ago.



Breakthrough data confirms the significant impact of vaccination

77.3% of Age 5+ Population

22.7% of Age 5+ Population

(Data for Connecticut)

Vaccinated Universe

Daily New Case Rate = 24.7 (per 100,000 vaccinated people)



Unvaccinated Universe

Daily New Case Rate = 134.8 (per 100,000 unvaccinated people)

Relative to vaccinated people, unvaccinated people are

- 5.5 times more likely to get COVID-19
- 15 times more likely to be hospitalized
- 20 times more likely to die from COVID-19

The latest Connecticut unvaccinated Daily New Case Rate (134.8) is much higher than it was exactly one year ago (69.1) WHEN EVERYONE WAS UNVACCINATED
