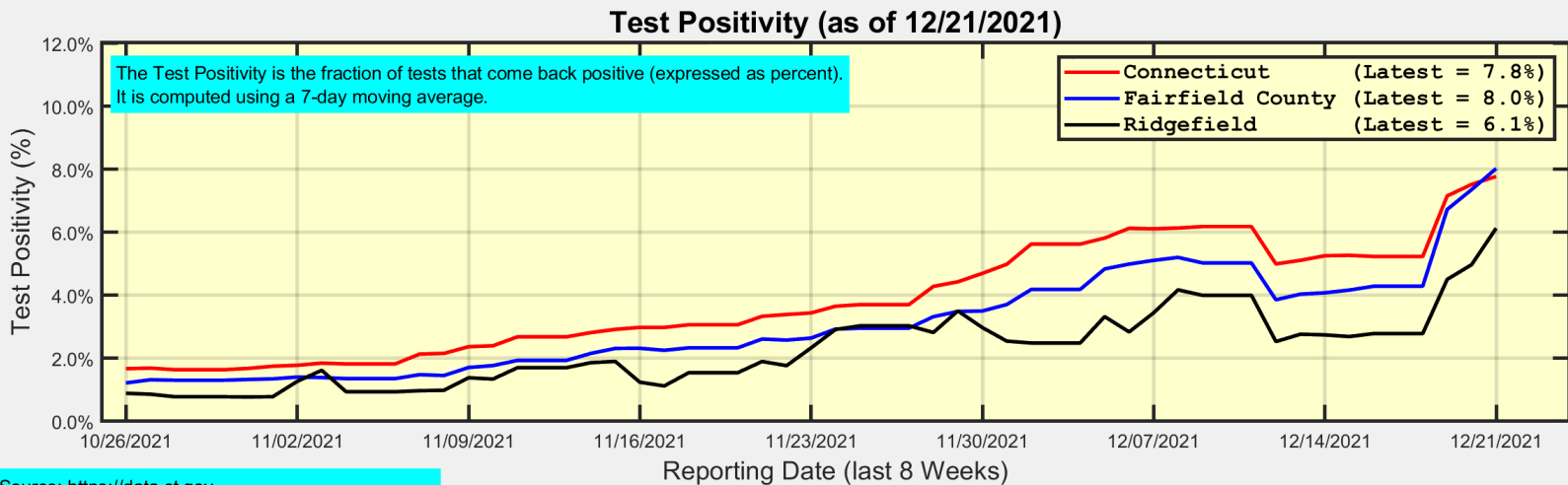
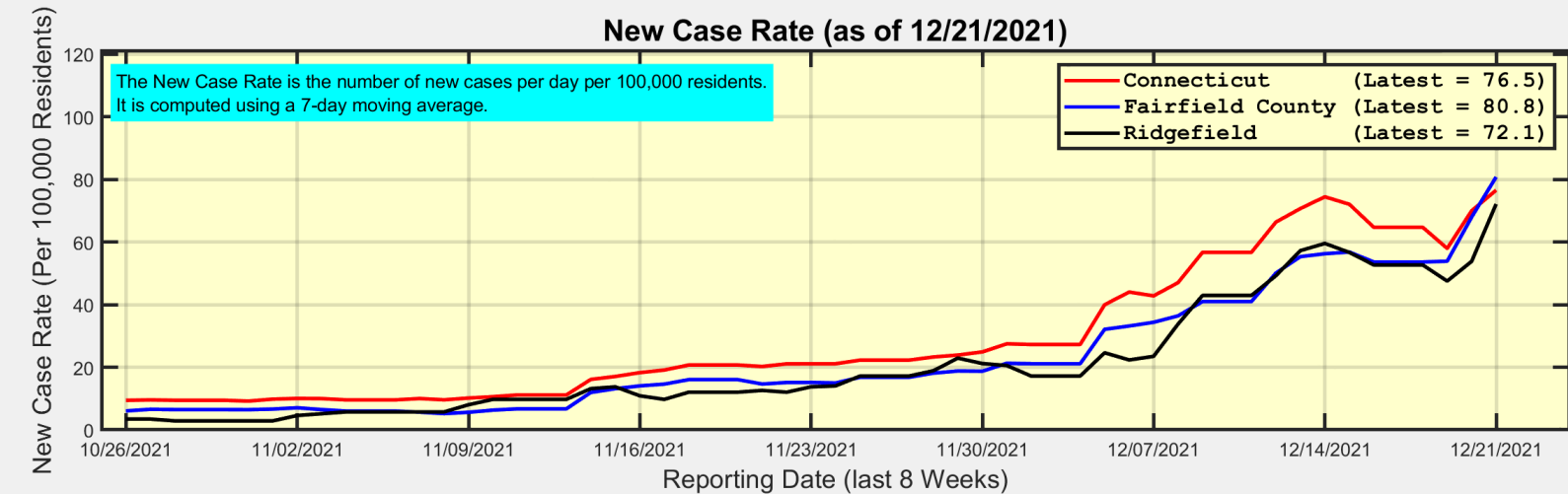

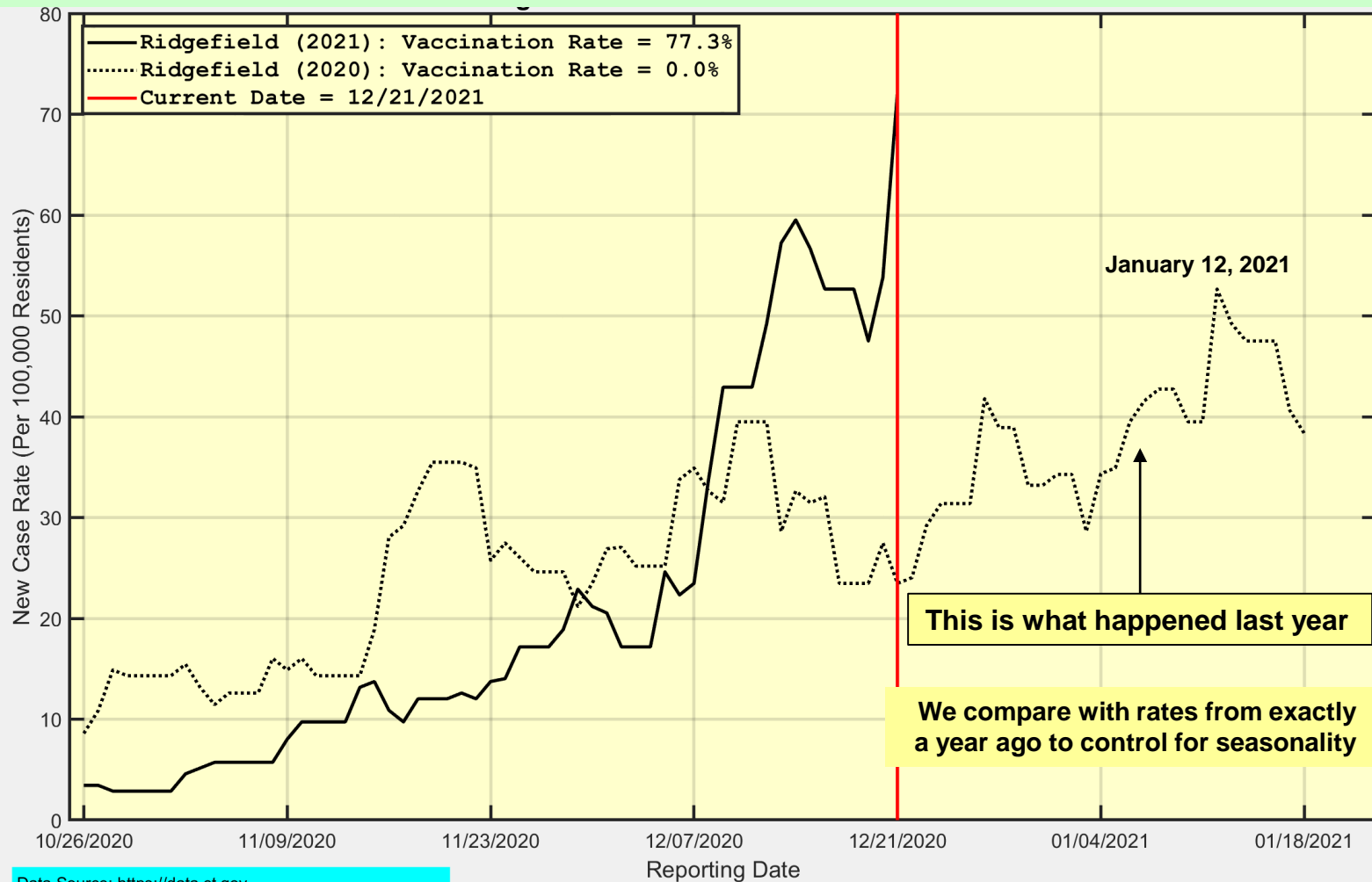


## Ridgefield New Case Rates are HIGHER than one year ago (WHEN NO ONE WAS VACCINATED)

Connecticut DPH data has shown that over 90% of recent new cases are in the Ridgefield unvaccinated population.

Hence, the unvaccinated population is keeping Ridgefield New Case Rates at a level higher than a year ago.

One reason for the higher 2021 case rates is the higher transmissibility of Delta (& Omicron) relative to the 2020 variants.

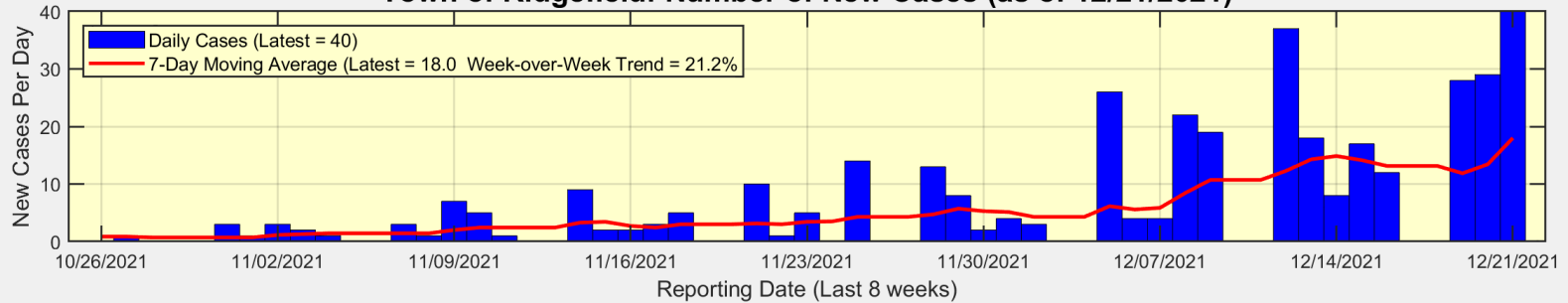

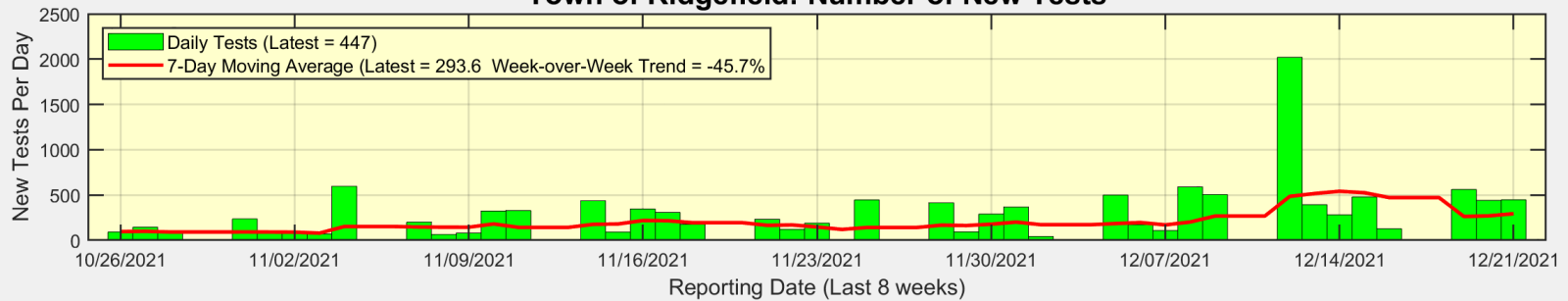

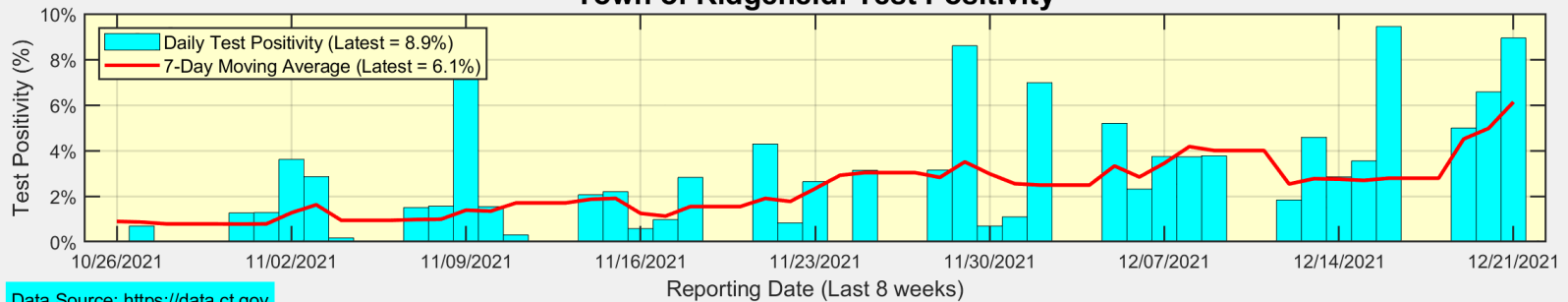
**Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Cases (as of 12/21/2021)**



**Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Tests**



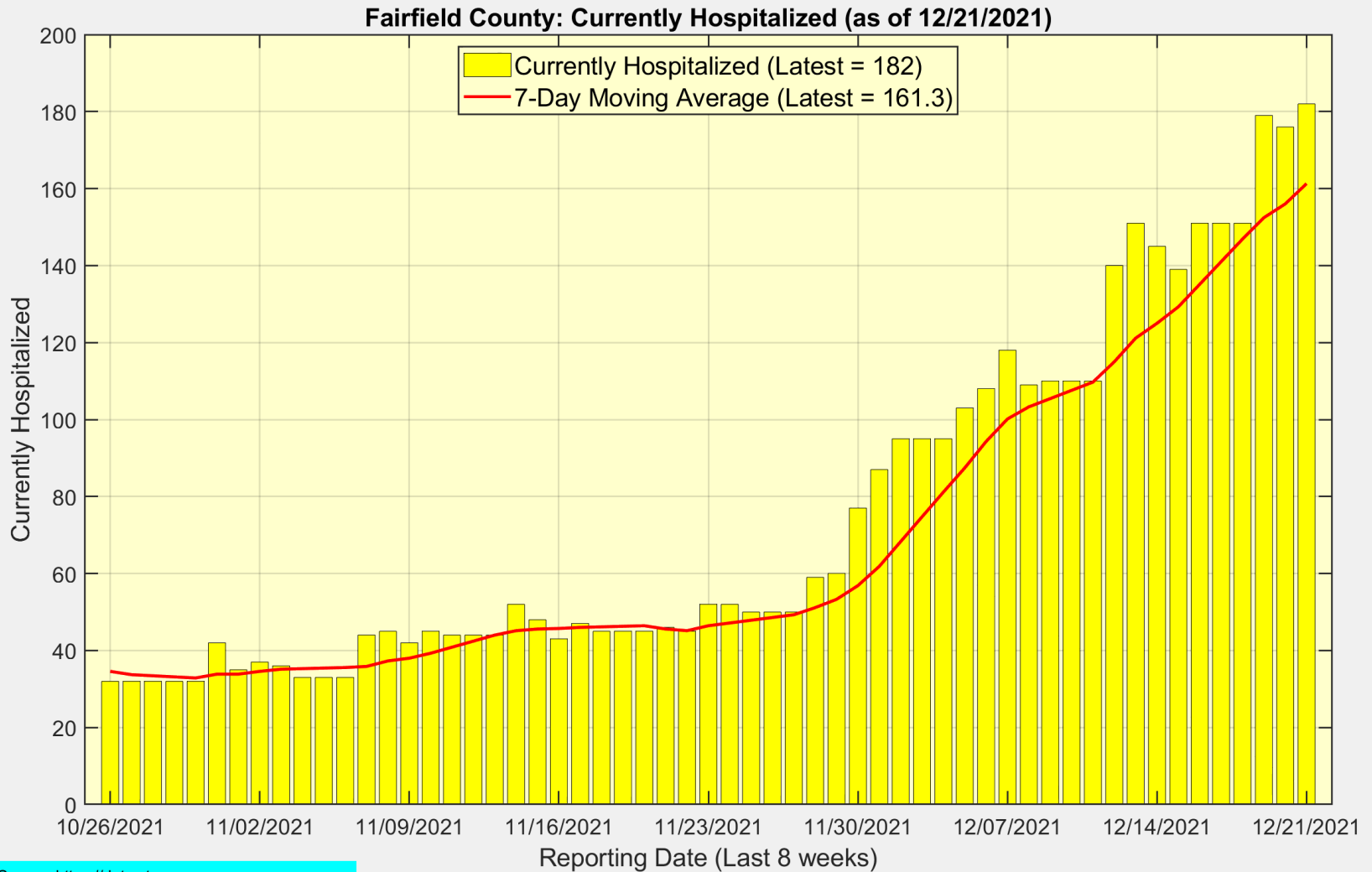
**Town of Ridgefield: Test Positivity**

# Currently Hospitalized in Fairfield County

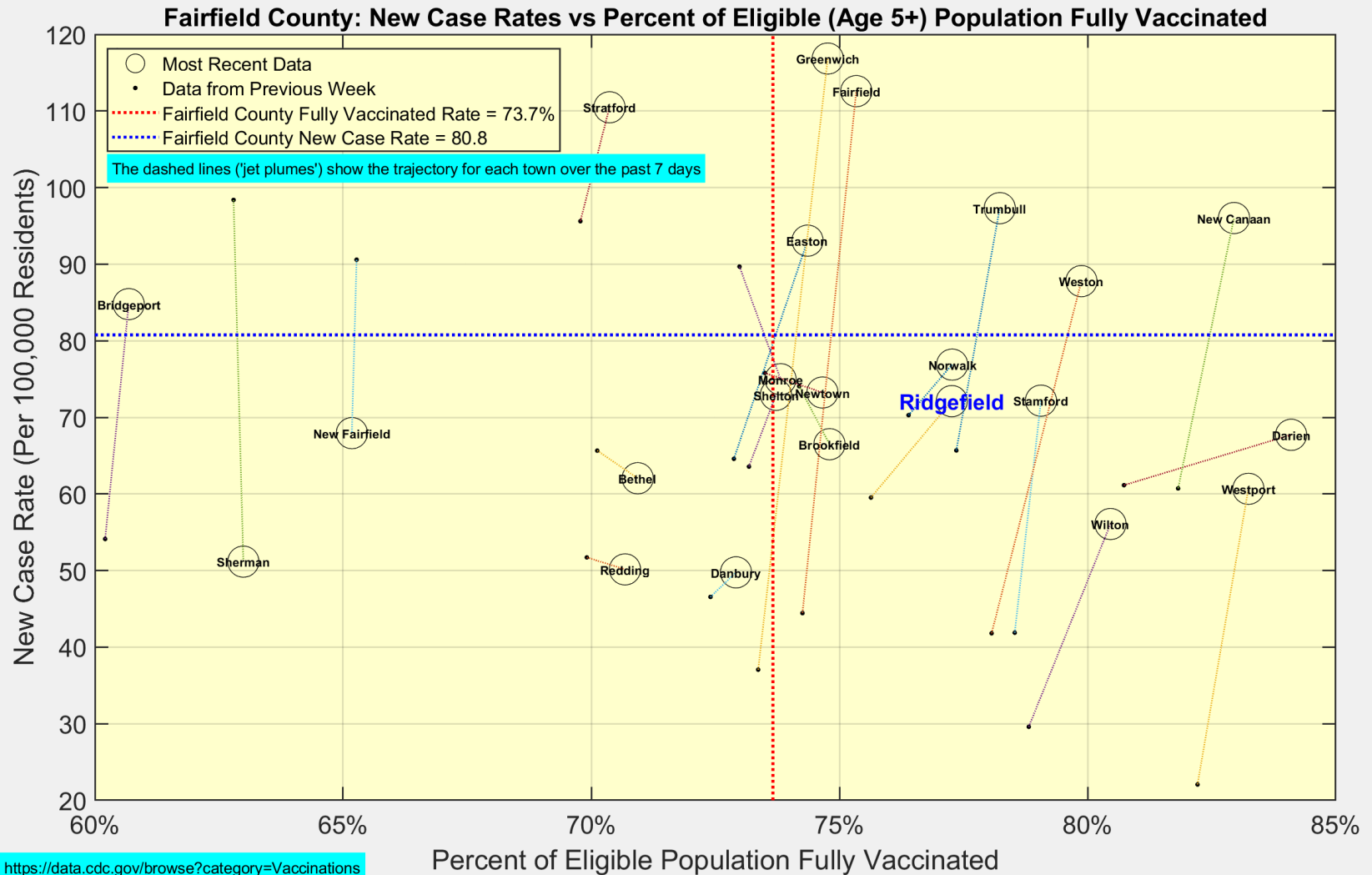

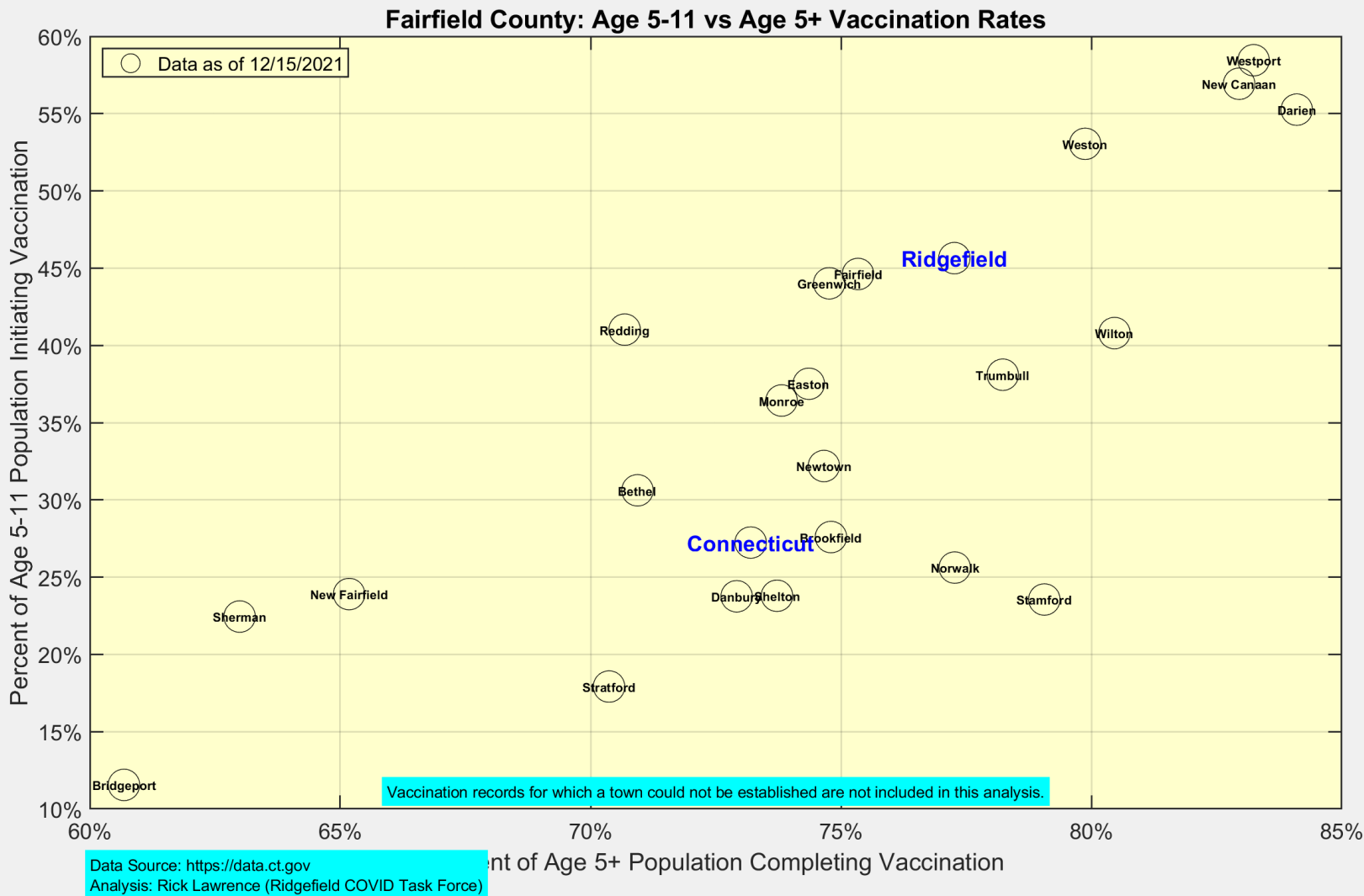

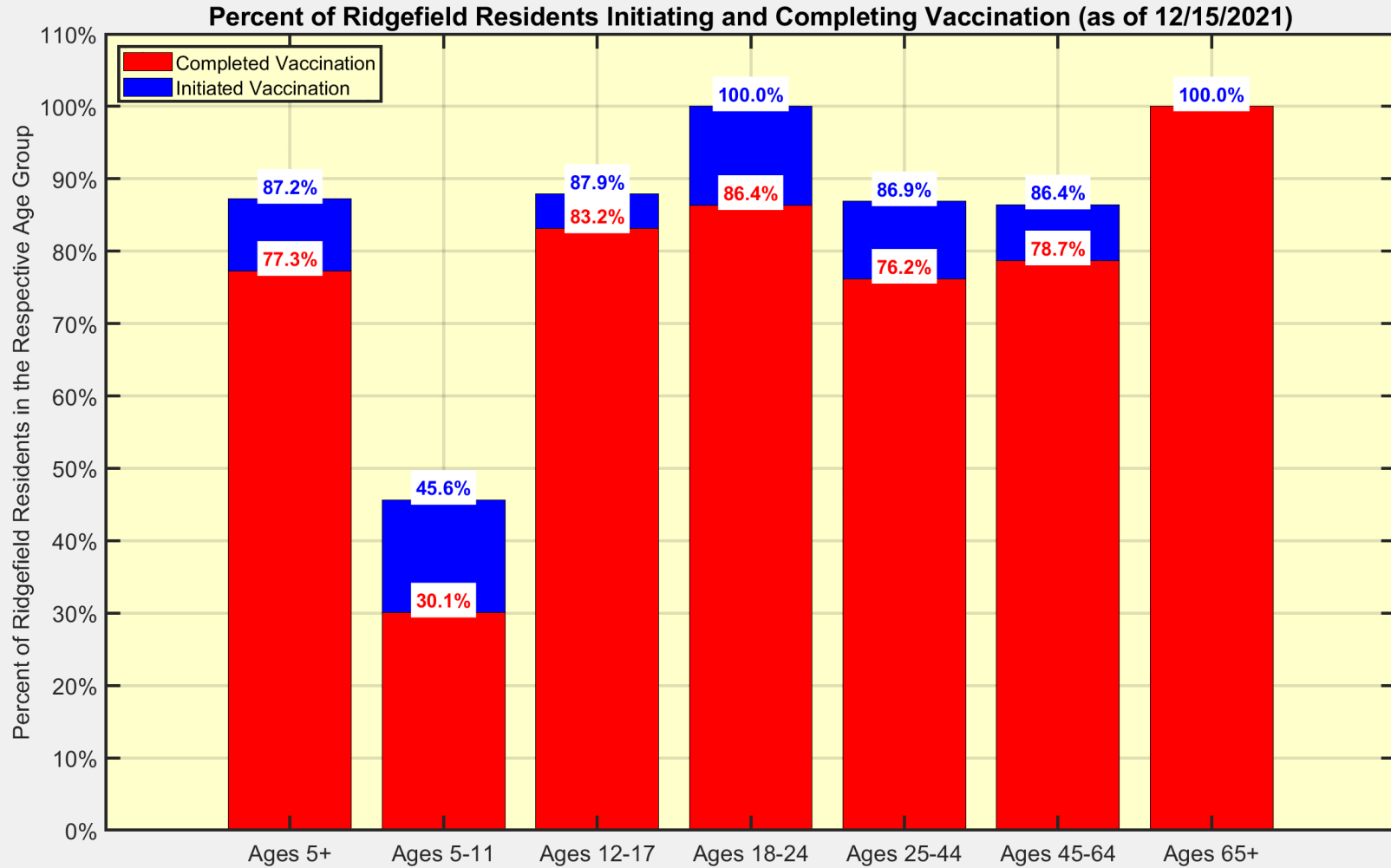




# Latest Vaccination Rates for Towns in Fairfield County



# Latest Vaccination Rates for Ridgefield Residents



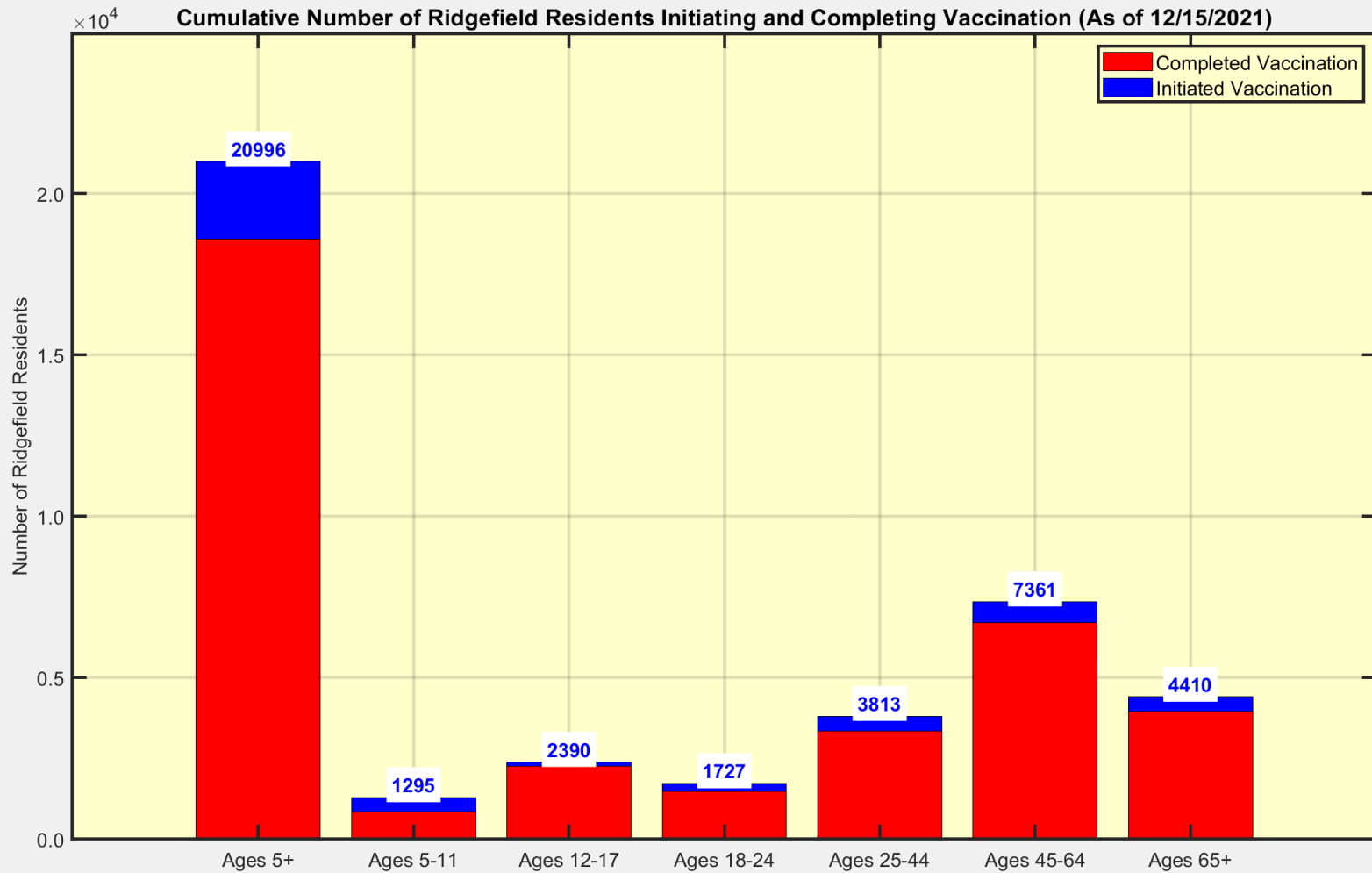

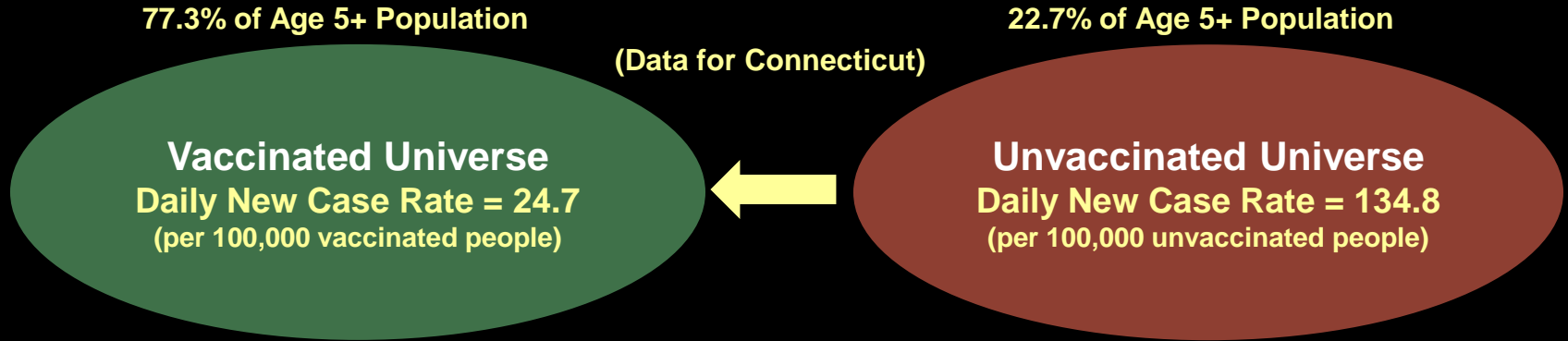

## Breakthrough data confirms the significant impact of vaccination



**Relative to vaccinated people, unvaccinated people are**

- 5.5 times more likely to get COVID-19
- 15 times more likely to be hospitalized
- 20 times more likely to die from COVID-19
