








The New Case Rate in Ridgefield increased to 29.1




Here are the latest New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County







This heat map shows the progression of New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County






These are the distributions of New Cases and Deaths over age group for the State of Connecticut








Connecticut increased testing significantly to over 1000 per 100K residents
