




# There were 15 new cases reported in Ridgefield on Wednesday






# The New Case Rate in Ridgefield increased to 29.1





# Here are the latest New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County



This heat map shows the progression of New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County




# These are the distributions of New Cases and Deaths over age group for the State of Connecticut

# Connecticut increased testing significantly to over 1000 per 100K residents


