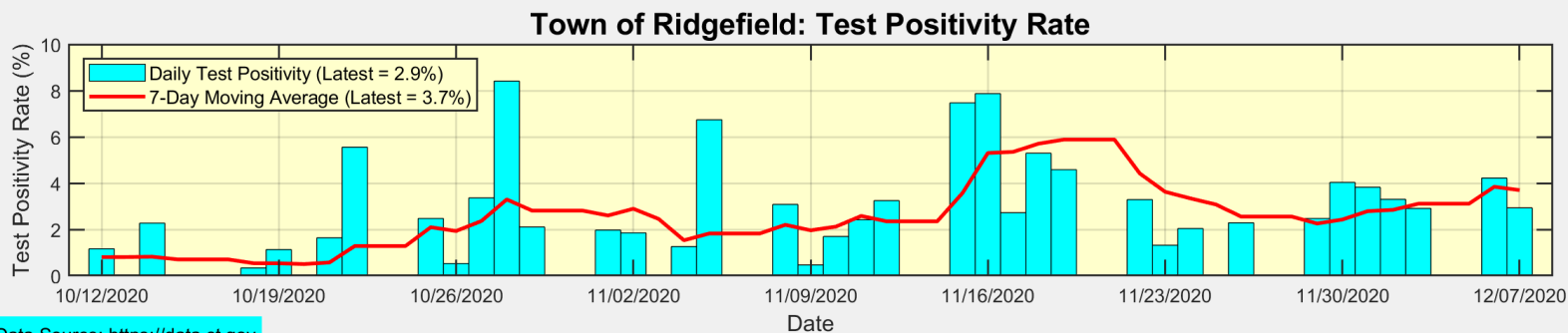
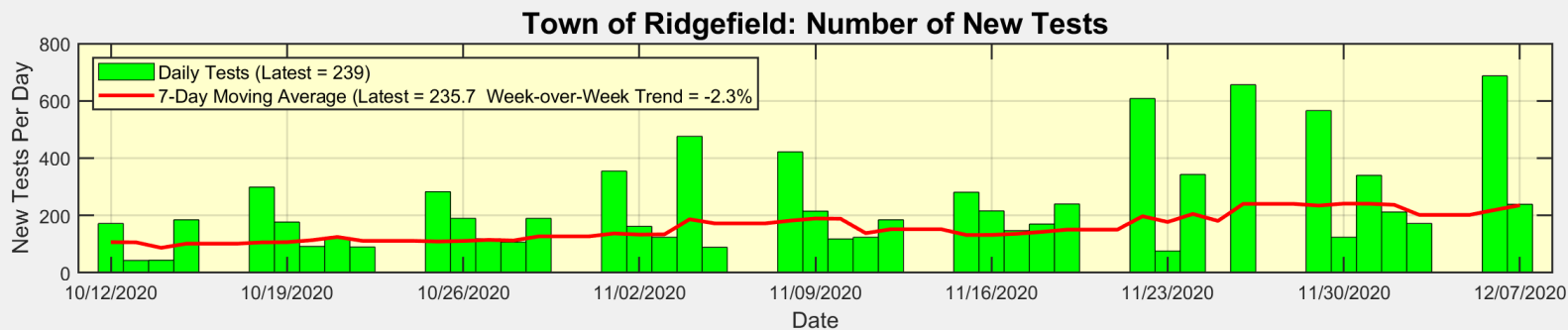
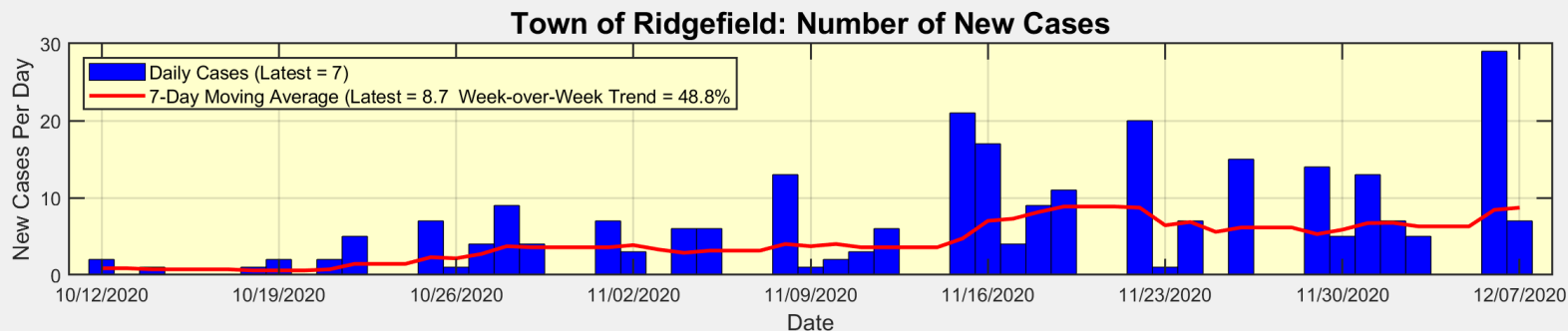
## Ridgefield Summary

Tuesday, December 8, 2020

- There were 7 new cases in Ridgefield on Monday
  - The 7-day moving average of daily new cases is 8.7
- This translates to a New Case Rate of 34.8 new cases per 100,000 residents
  - The Fairfield County New Case Rate is 85.1 new cases per 100,000 residents
  - Ridgefield remains at the State **Red** Alert Level (because our New Case Rate is over 15)
- The Test Positivity Rate for Ridgefield (averaged over 7 days) is 3.7%
  - The Test Positivity Rate for Fairfield County is 7.3%
- Our data science confirms CDC and other studies
  - ***Wearing a Mask Reduces COVID Case Rates***



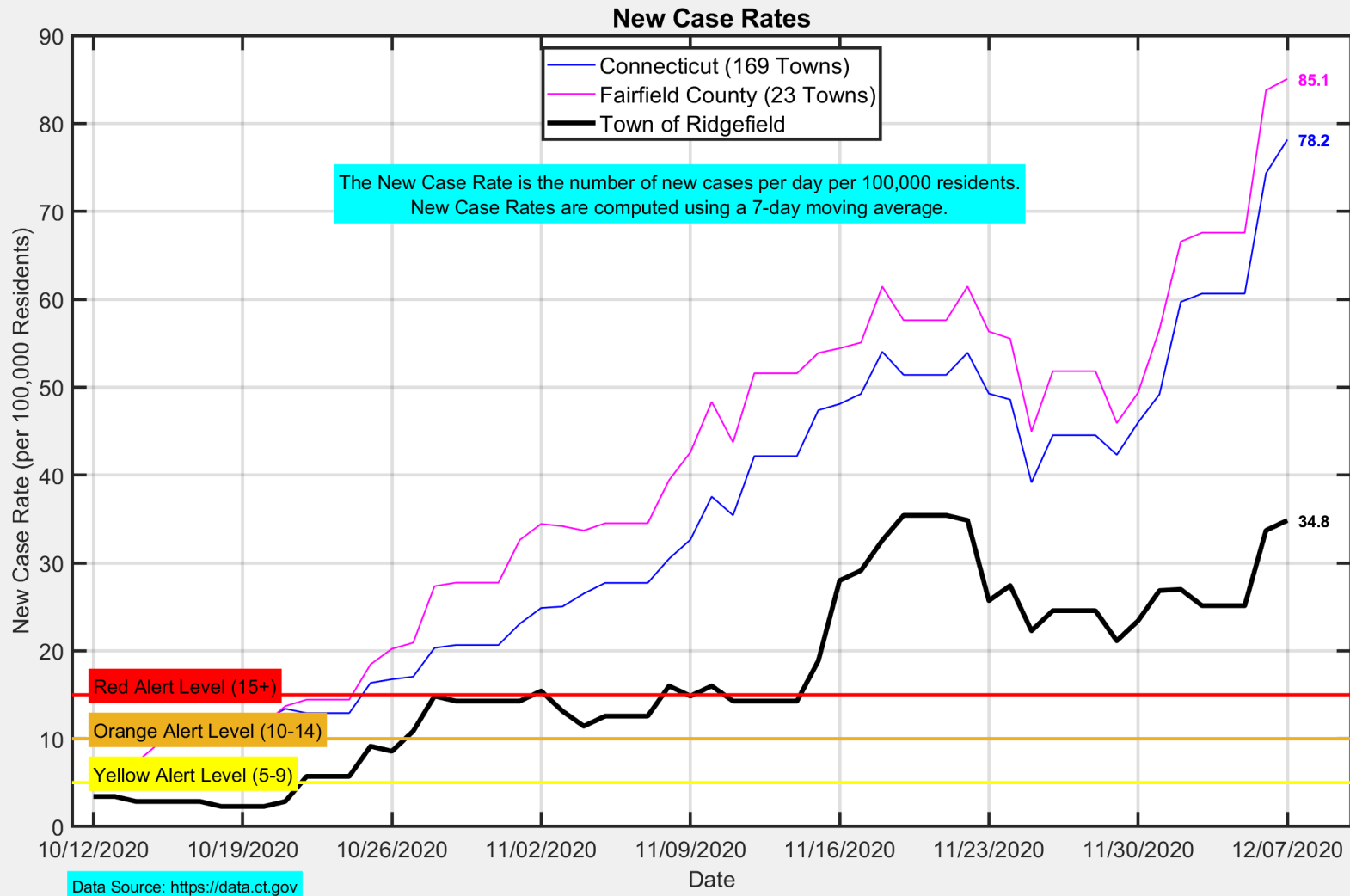
# There were 7 new cases reported in Ridgefield yesterday



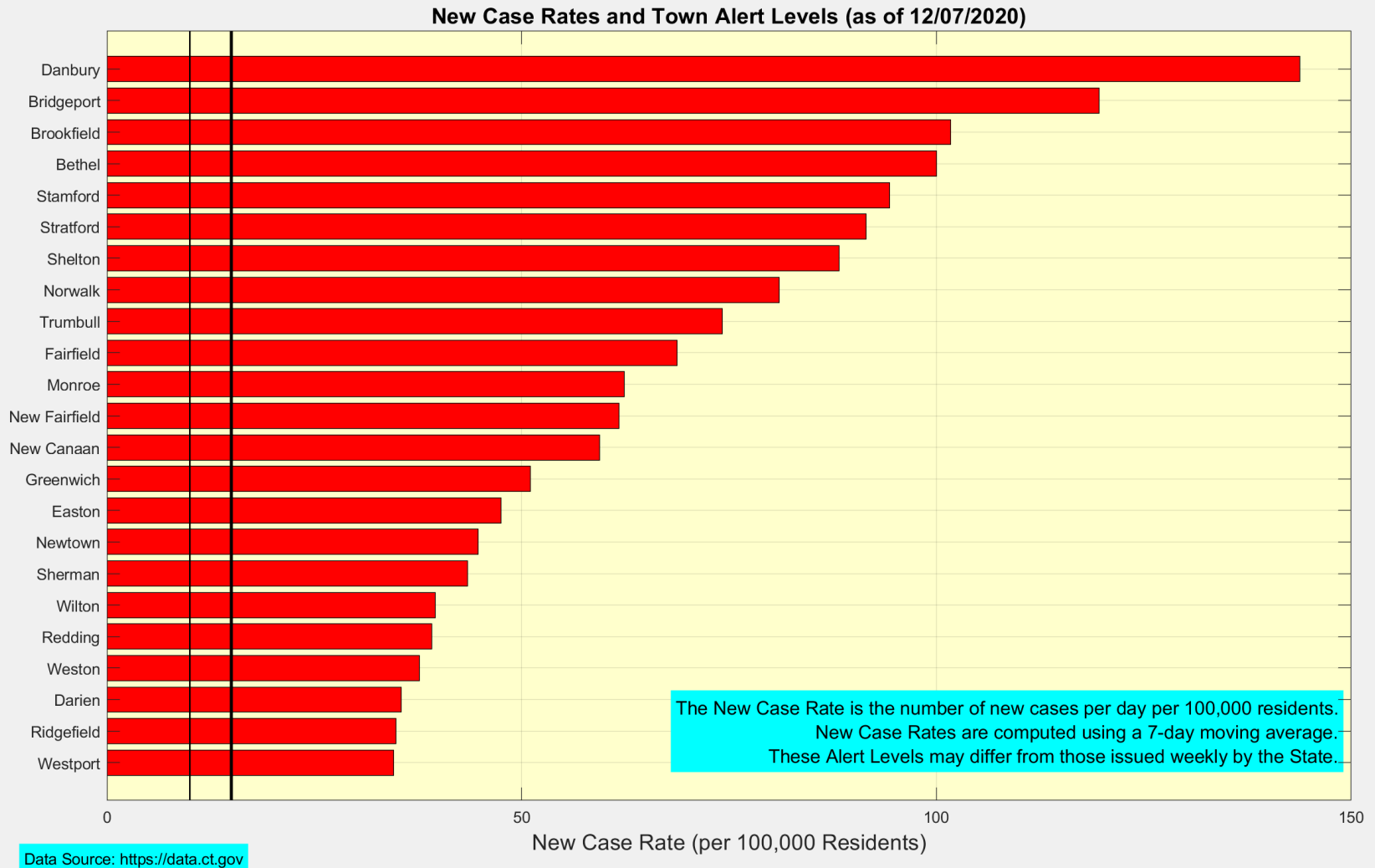

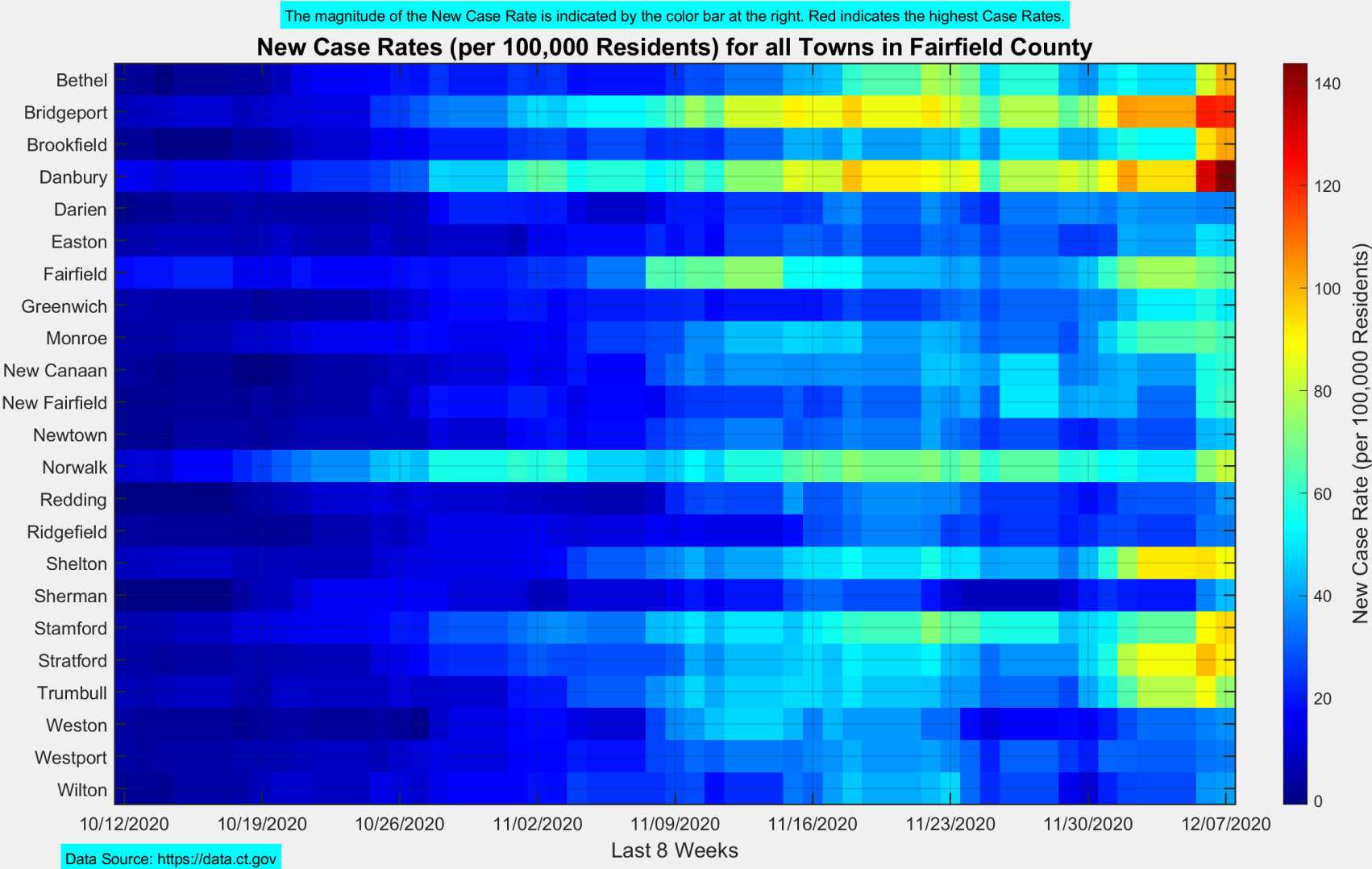
## The New Case Rate in Ridgefield increased slightly to 34.8



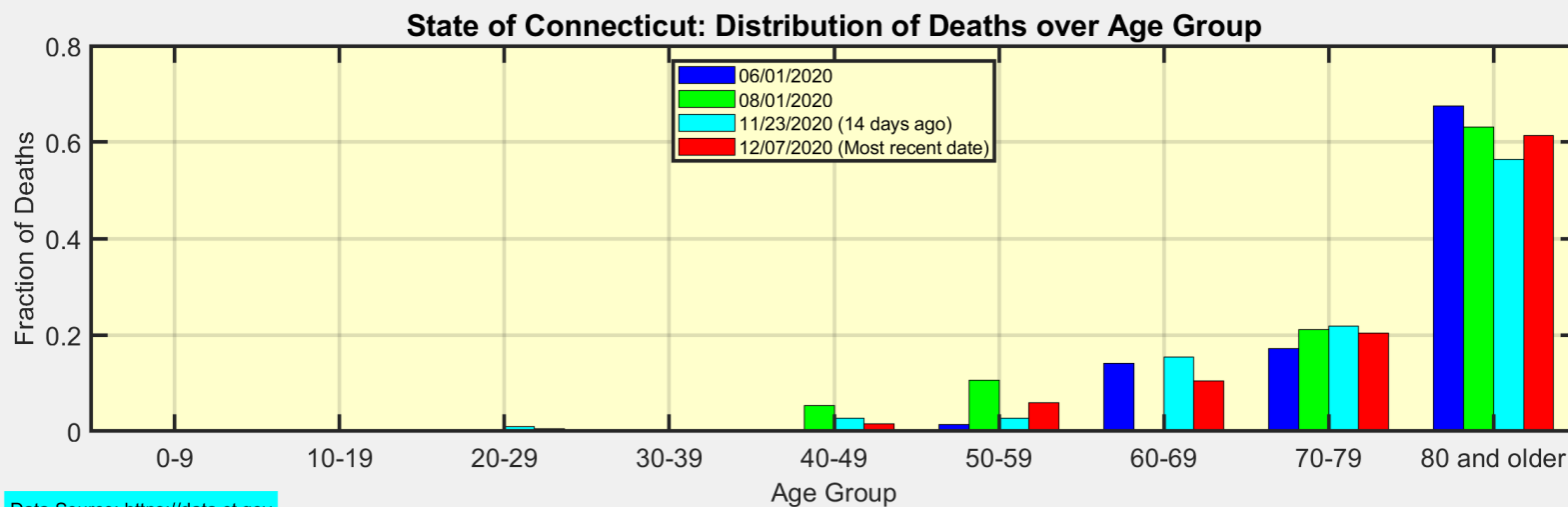
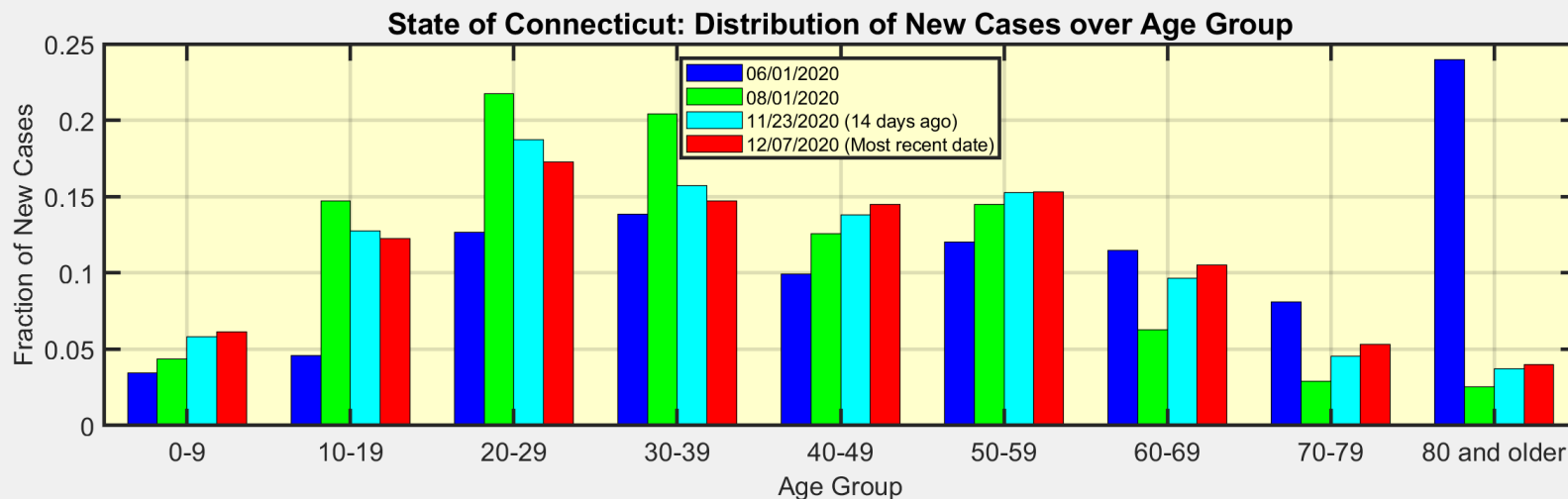
# Ridgefield continues to have one of the lower New Case Rates in Fairfield County



# This heat map shows the progression of New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County



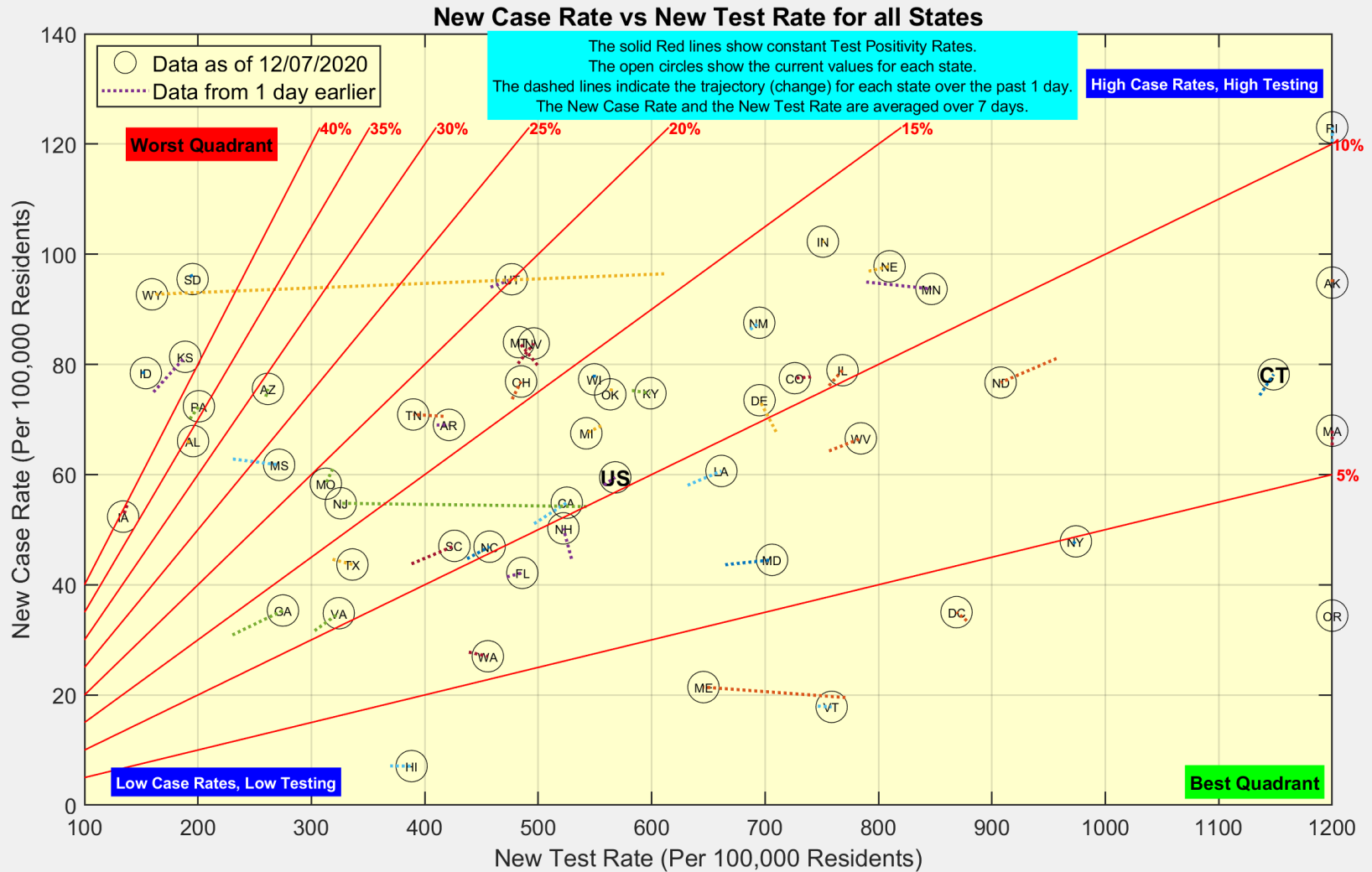
# These are the distributions of New Cases and Deaths over age group for the State of Connecticut

# Connecticut continues to do more testing than most states ... Test Positivity is increasing



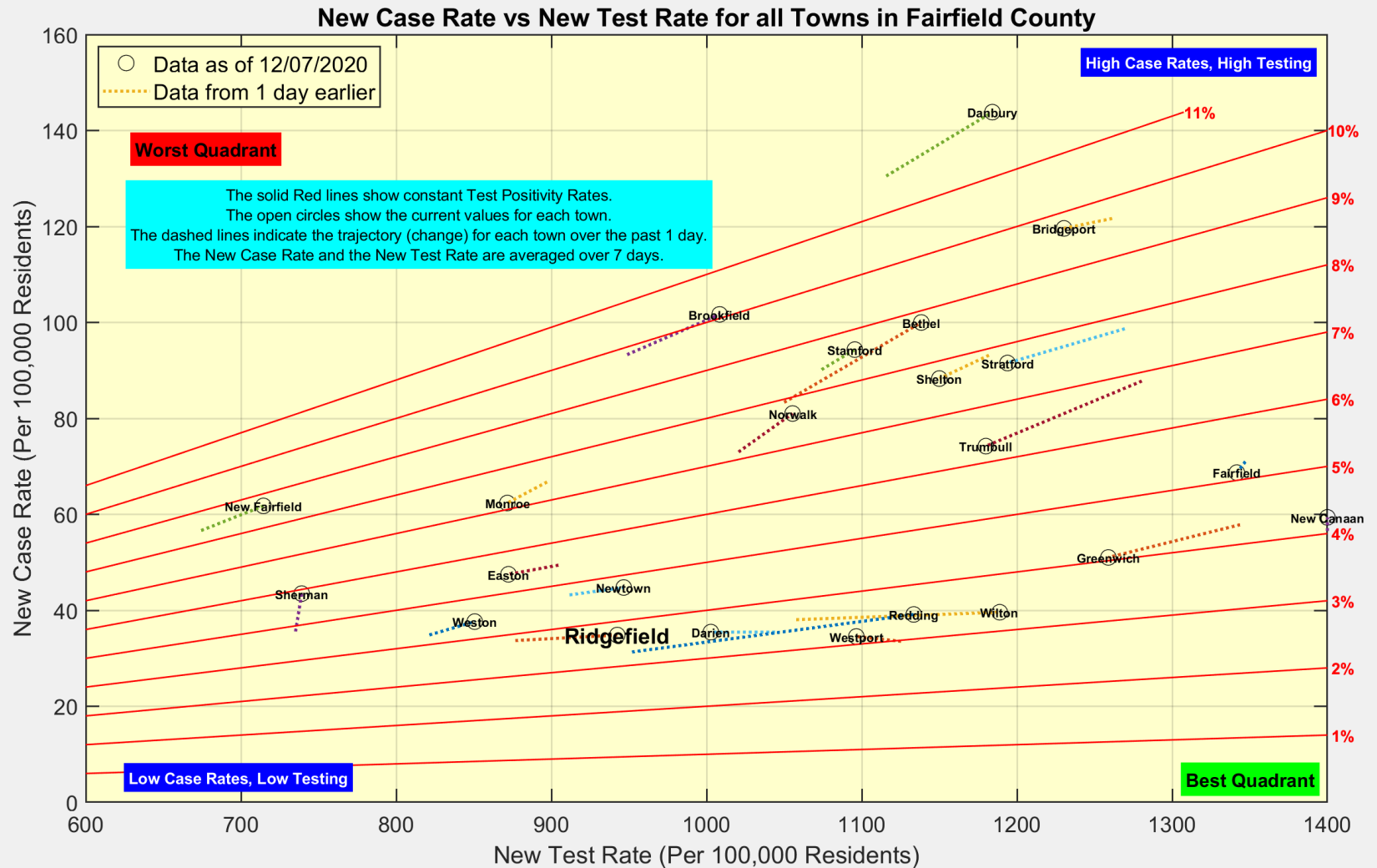
