




There were 5 new cases reported for Ridgefield on Thursday



The New Case Rate in Ridgefield decreased to 25.7







This heat map shows the progression of New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County





These are the distributions of New Cases and Deaths over age group for the State of Connecticut








Introduction to Scatter Plots of New Case Rates vs New Test Rates


- 1. The dashed lines can be thought of as 'jet plumes' showing the trajectory of each state (or town) since the previous report.
