




There were 8 new cases reported for Ridgefield over the past 3 days






The New Case Rate in Ridgefield has decreased to 17.7





Here are the latest New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County




New Case Rate (Per 100,000 Residents) as of 02/14/2021


We estimate that Ridgefield has vaccinated 80% of the population over the age of 75

- 3 Connecticut ranks **#18** in administered doses as percent of delivered doses.





People Vaccinated in Each State as Percent of Population




People Vaccinated in Each State (as of 02/14/2021) As Percent of Population






People who have received First and Second Doses (Cumulative)



Connecticut: People With First and Second Doses (Cumulative as Percent of Population)







