





#### New Cases, New Tests, and Test Positivity for Ridgefield








## Fairfield County: New Case Rate






# **Fairfield County: Currently Hospitalized**






# **Fairfield County: Number of Deaths**






### **School-Age Vaccination Rates for Towns in Fairfield County**


