




New Case Rates and Test Positivity for Connecticut, Fairfield County, and Ridgefield





Fairfield County: New Case Rates






Fairfield County: Currently Hospitalized



Latest Vaccination Rates for Ridgefield Residents






Latest Data for Connecticut shows Omicron continues to be dominant

Existing vaccines continue to provide significant protection from Hospitalization & Death

80.8% of Age 5+ Population

(Data for Connecticut)

19.2% of Age 5+ Population

Vaccinated Universe

Daily New Case Rate = 41.2 (per 100,000 vaccinated people)

Unvaccinated Universe

Daily New Case Rate = 131.8 (per 100,000 unvaccinated people)

Relative to fully vaccinated people, unvaccinated people are

- > 3.2 times more likely to get COVID-19
- > 7.1 times more likely to be hospitalized
- 15 times more likely to die from COVID-19

Fully vaccinated includes people with and without a Booster shot.

The level of protection is likely much higher for the Boosted population.
