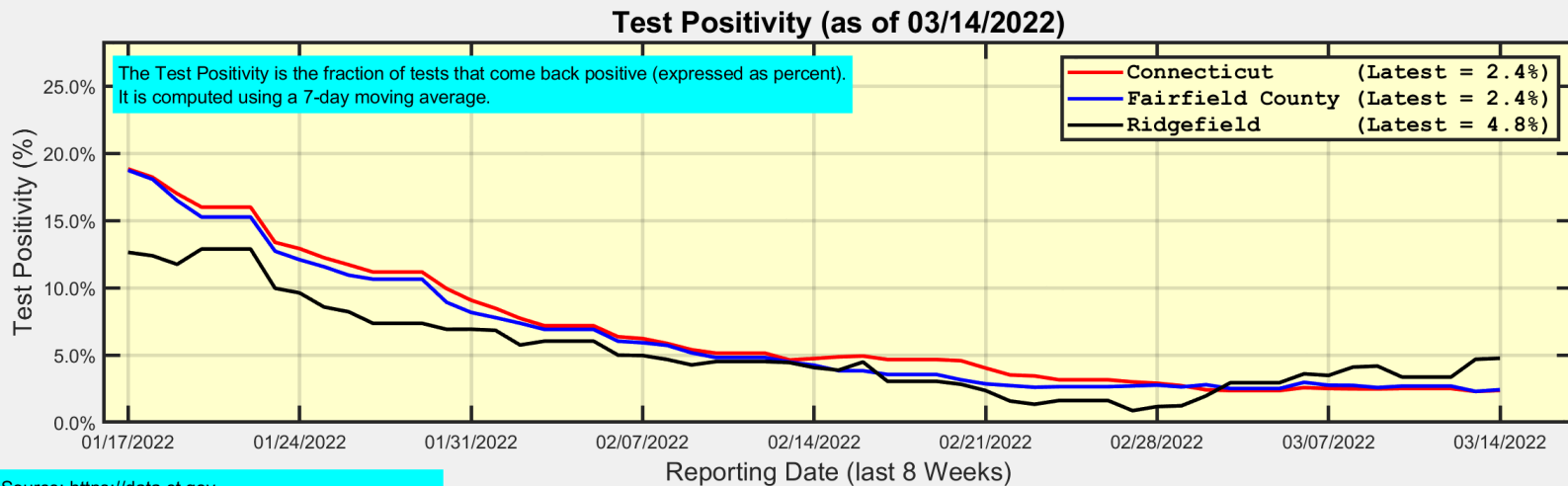
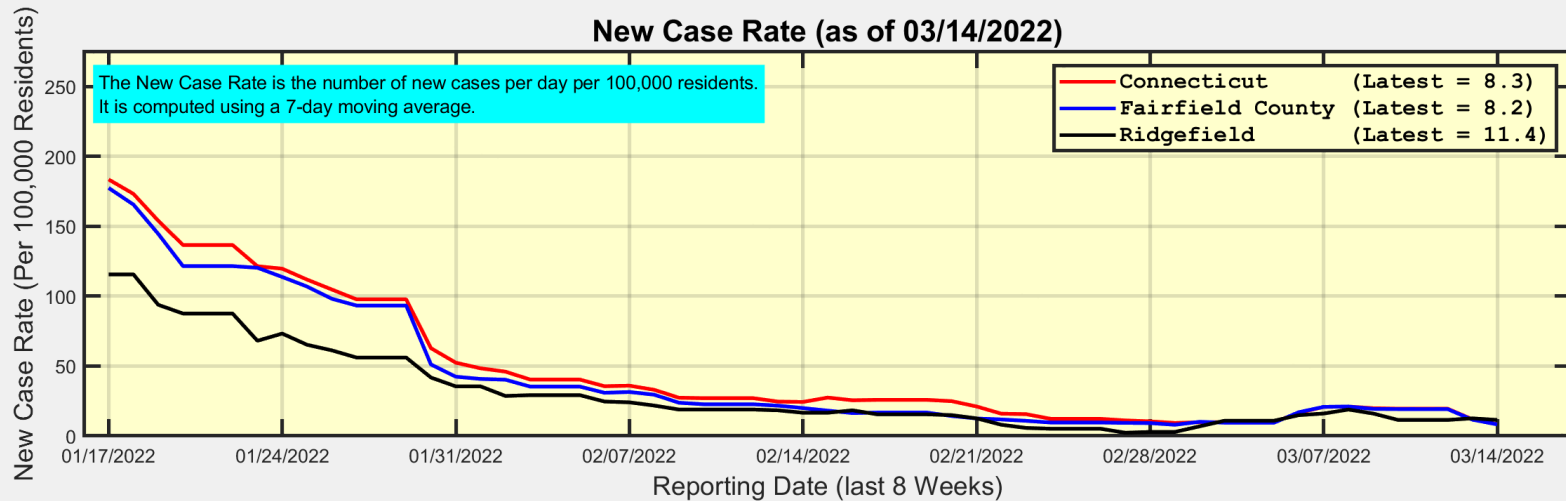

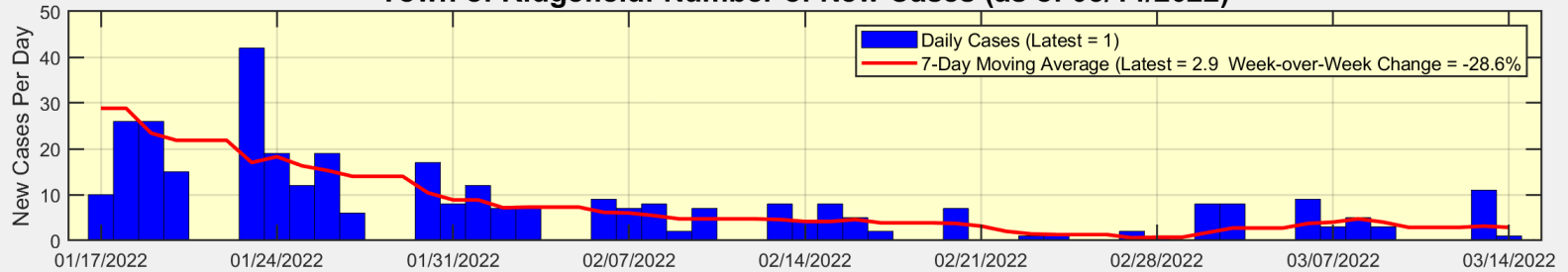

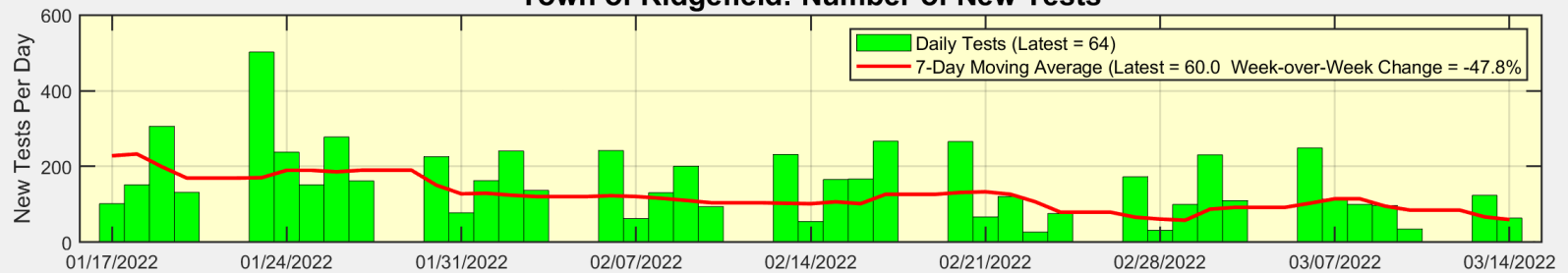

New Cases, New Tests, and Test Positivity for Ridgefield

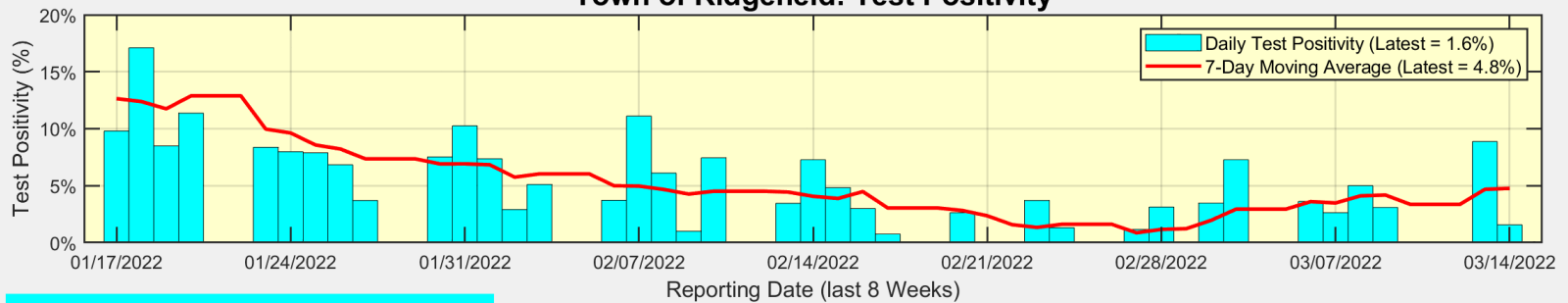
Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Cases (as of 03/14/2022)

Town of Ridgefield: Test Positivity

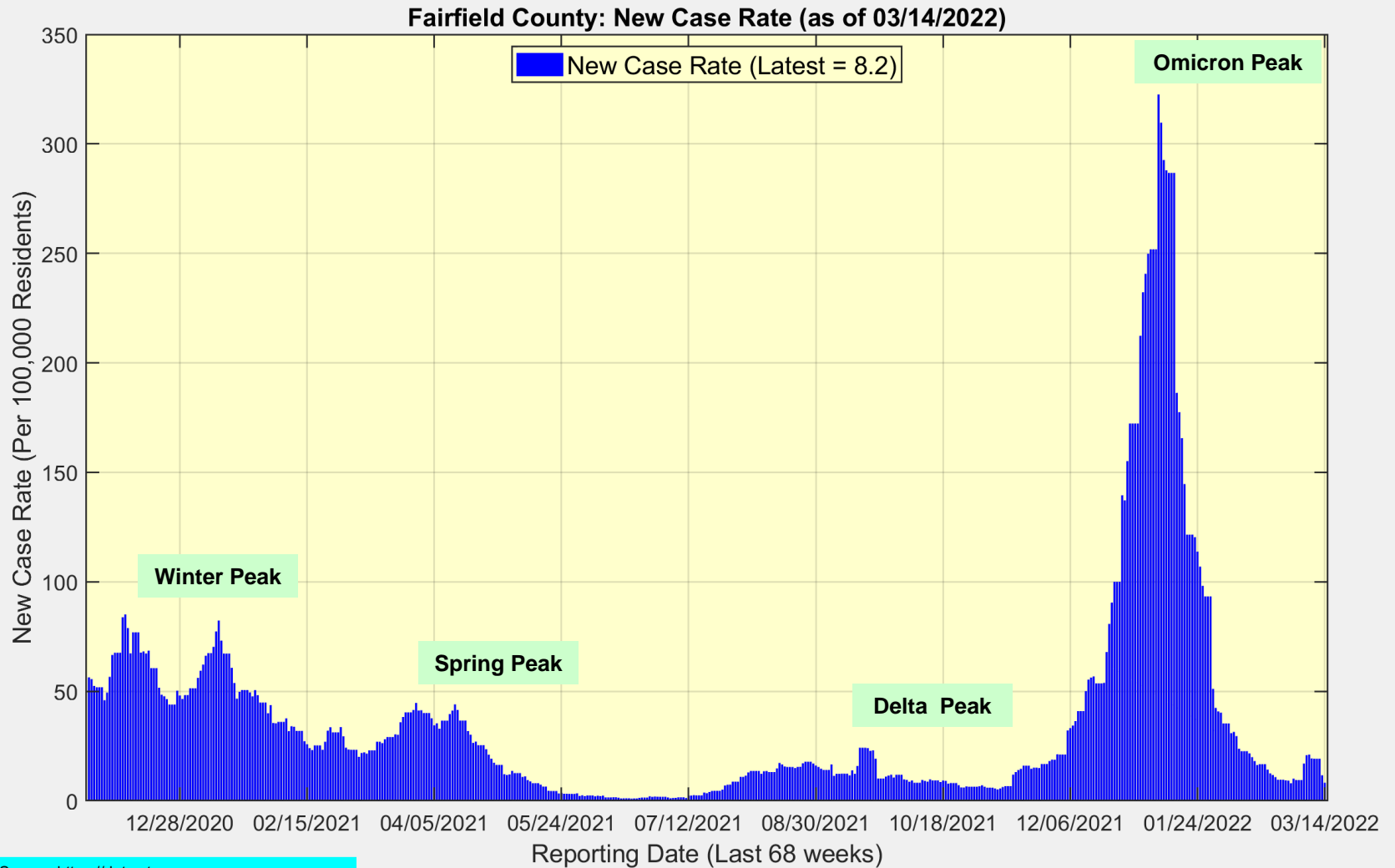

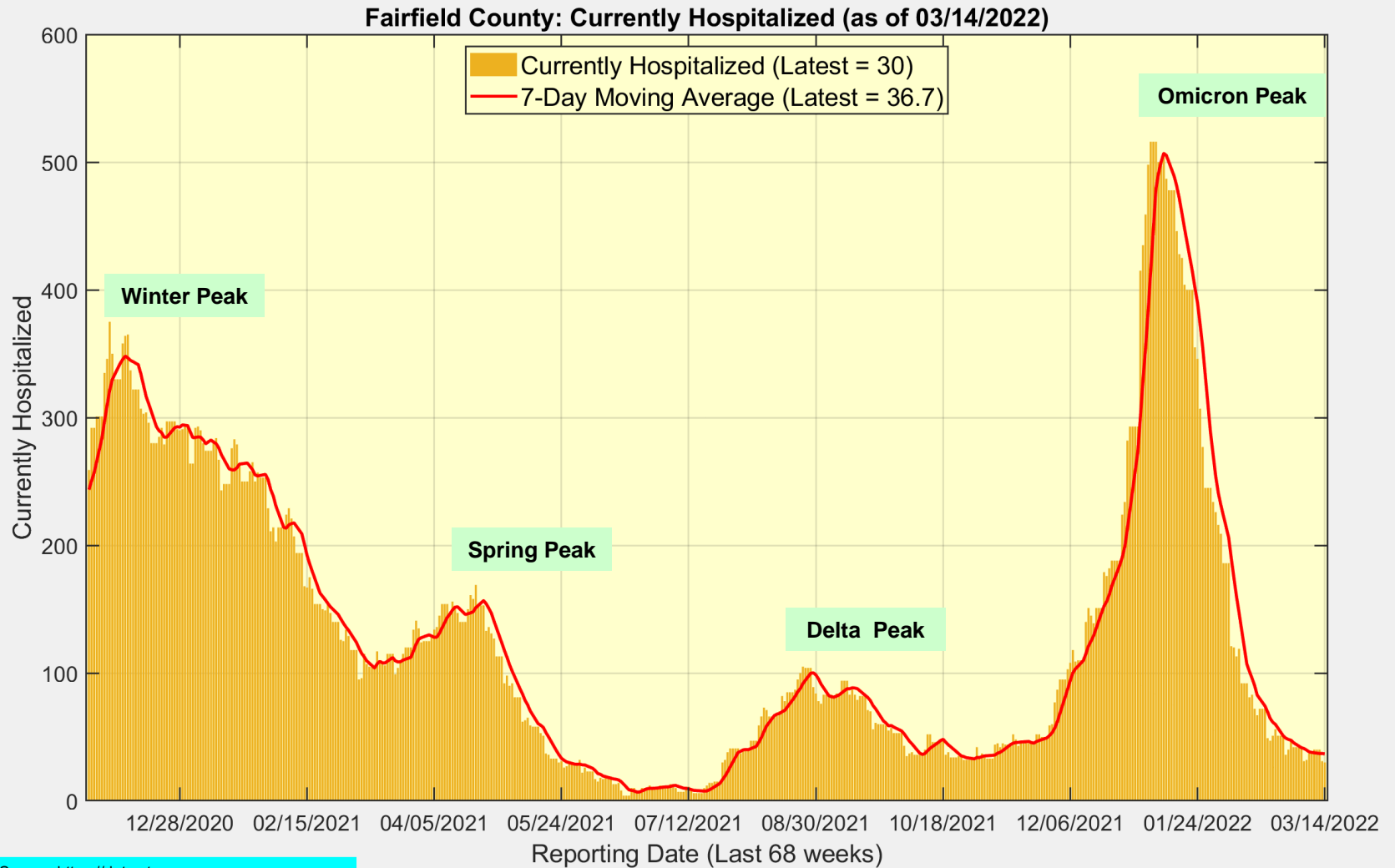

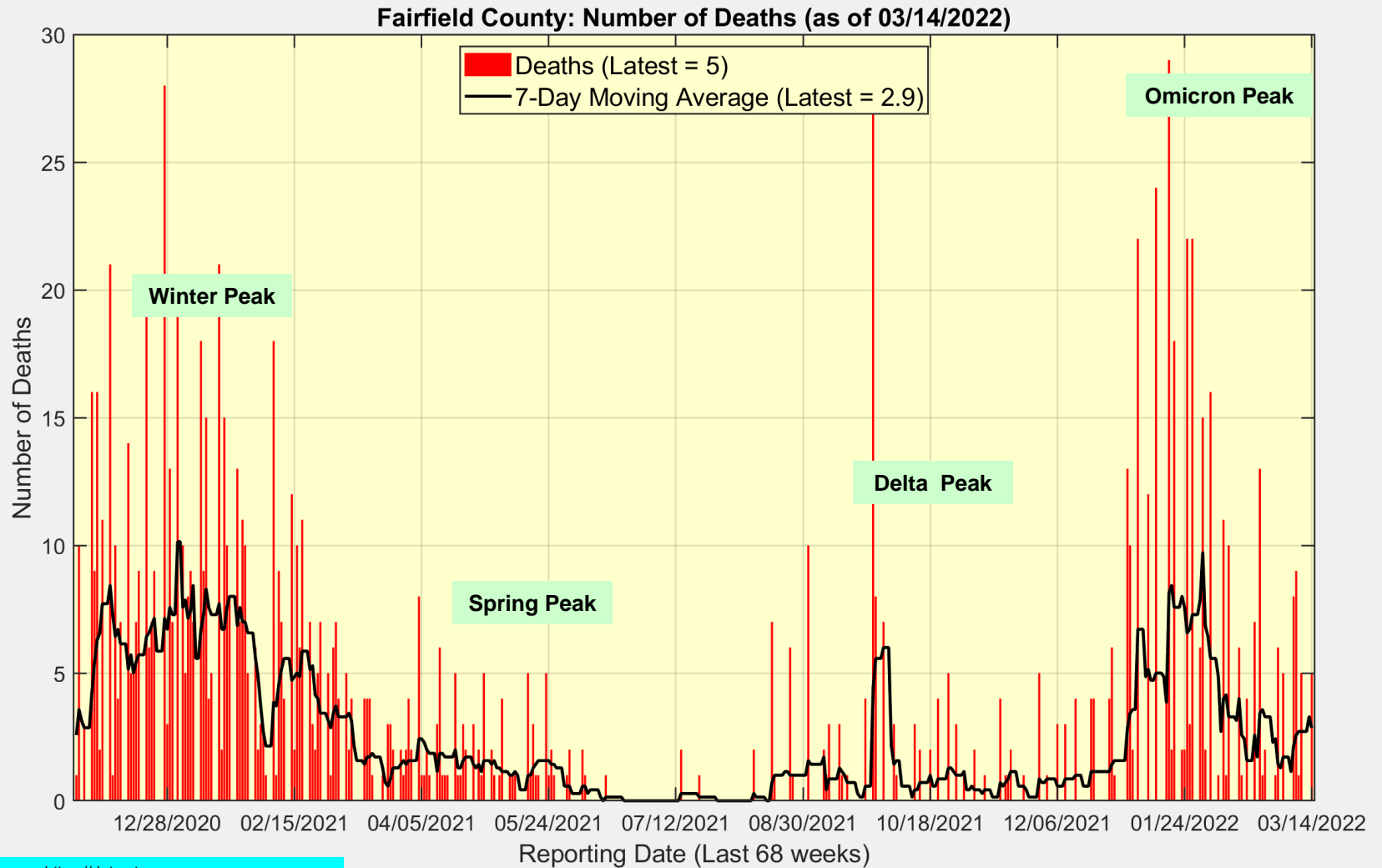
Fairfield County: New Case Rate

Fairfield County: Number of Deaths

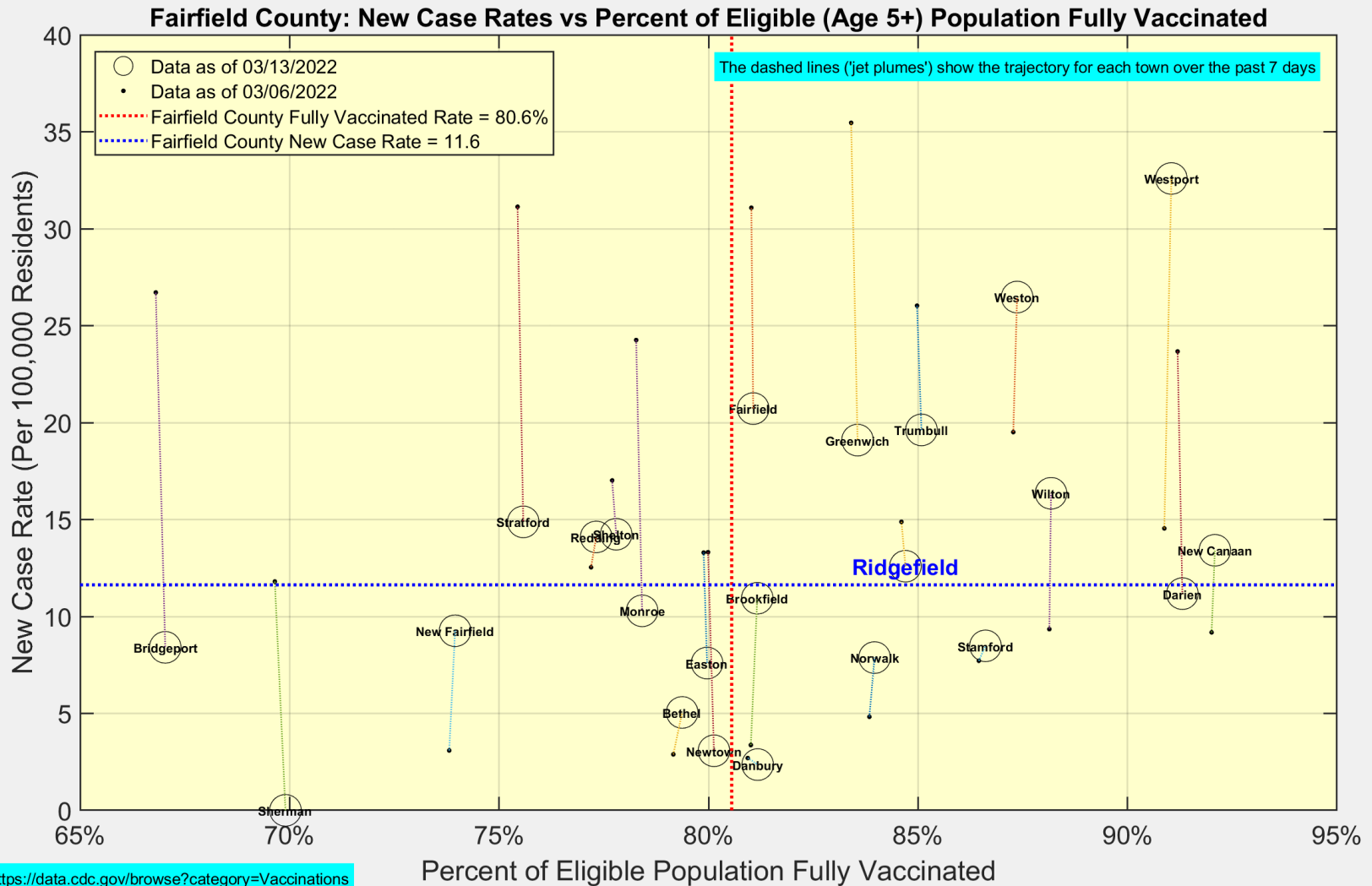

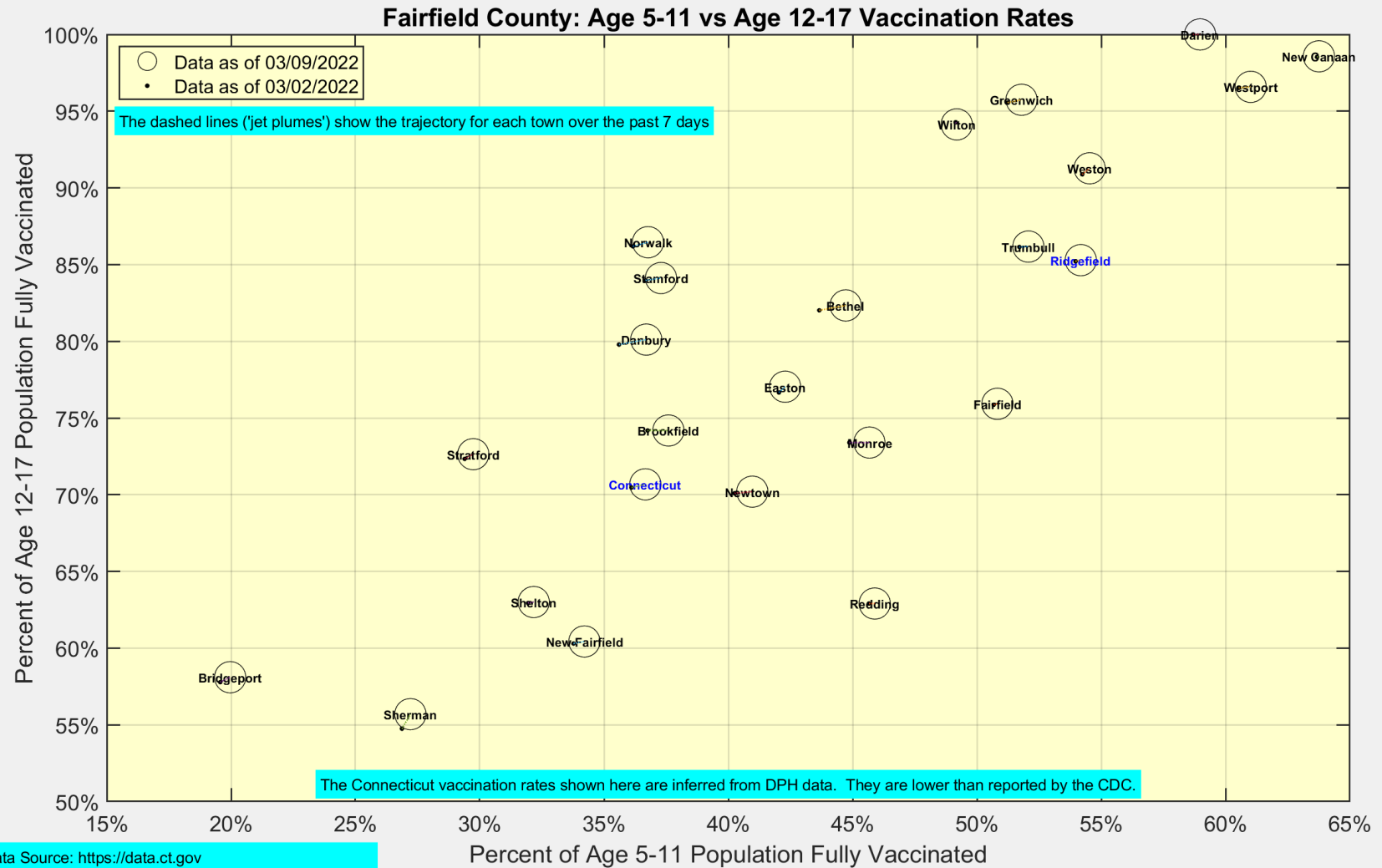

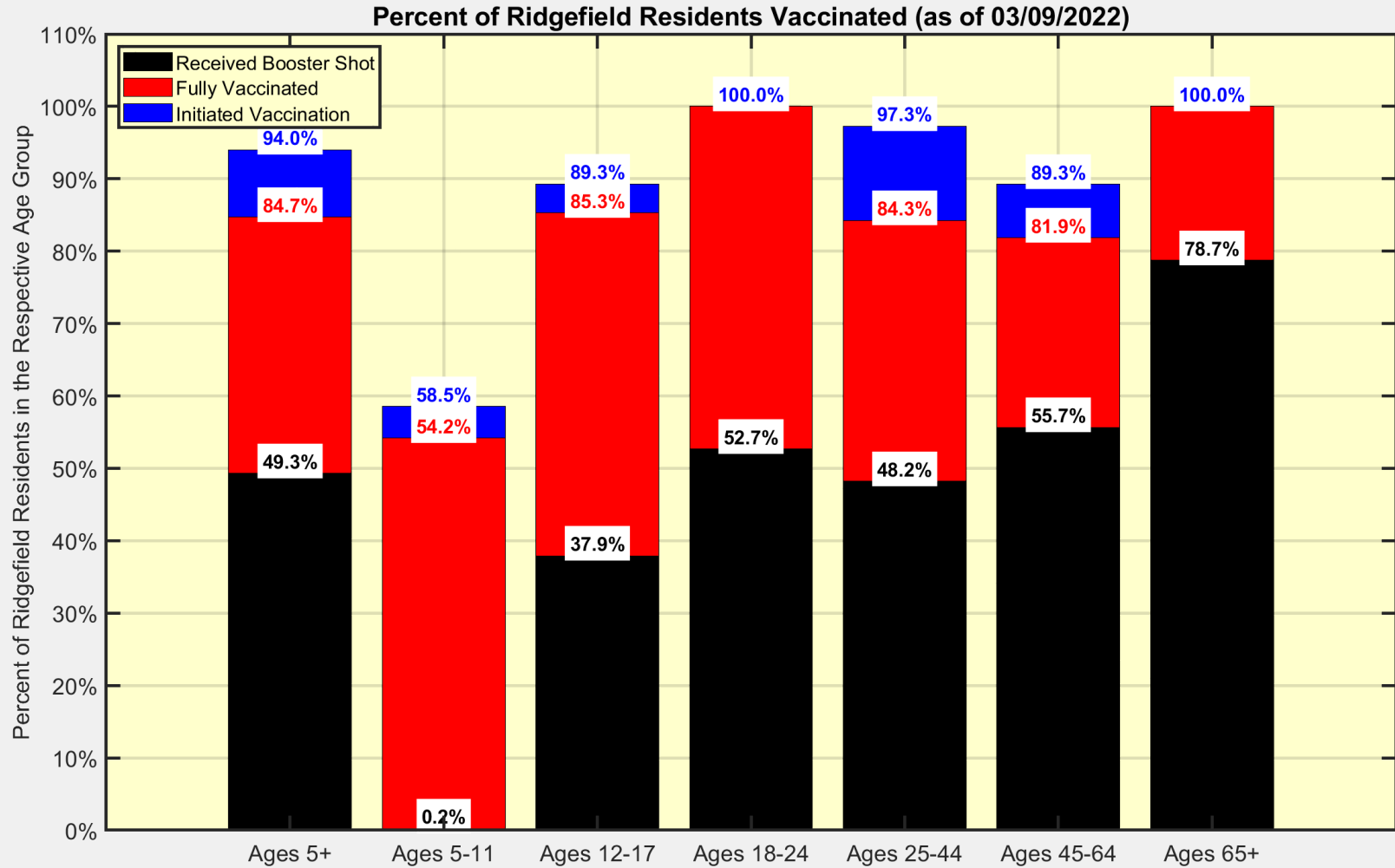

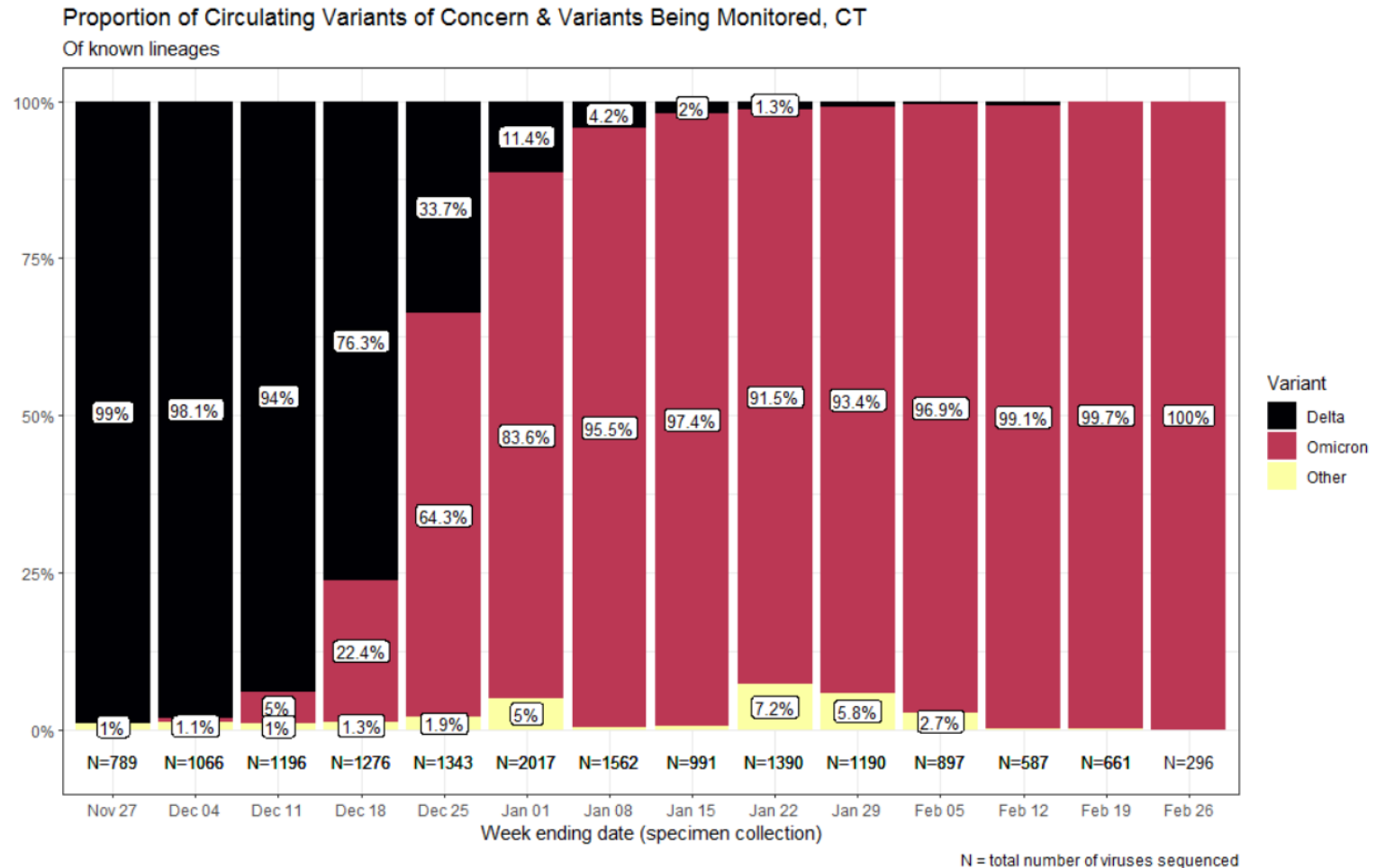
