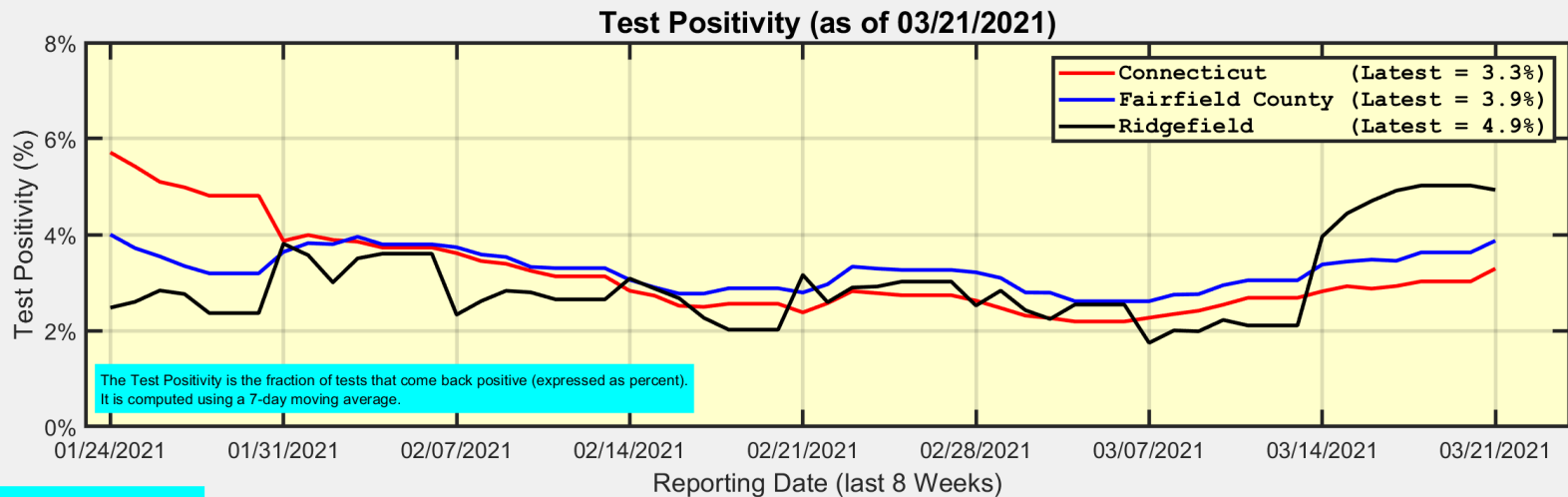
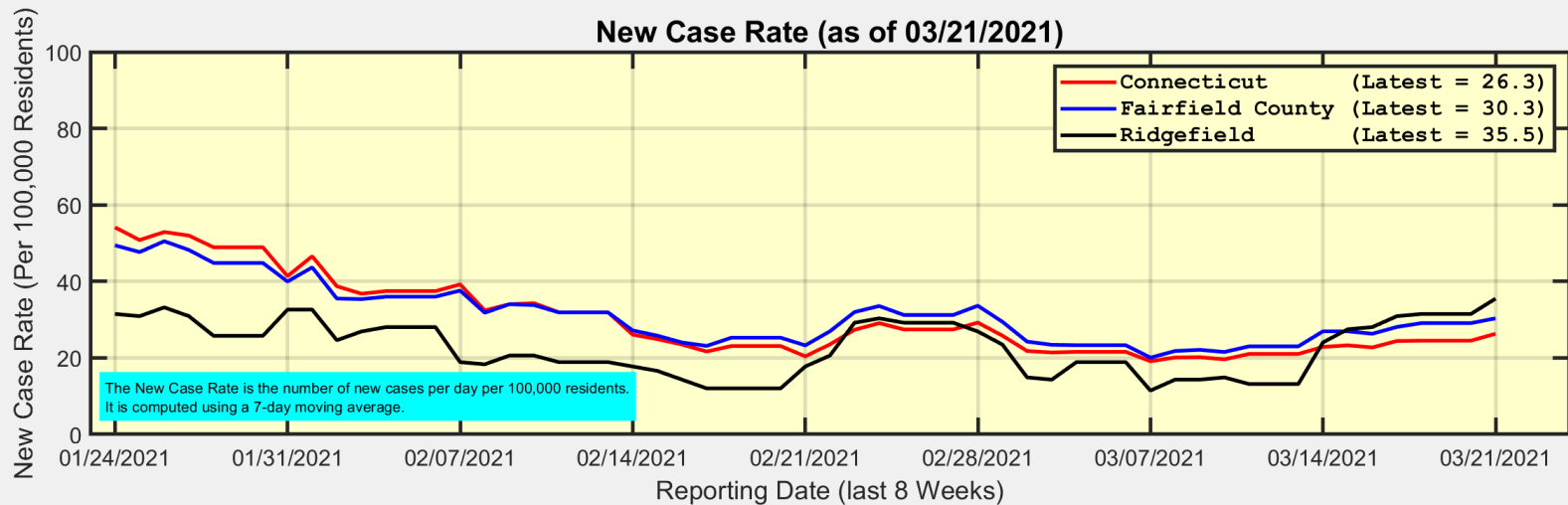

New Case Rates and Test Positivity for Connecticut, Fairfield County, and Ridgefield



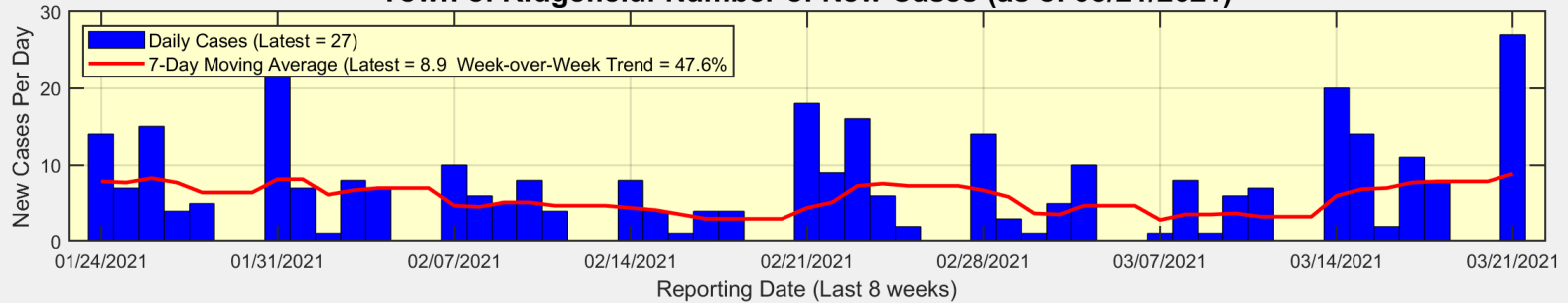

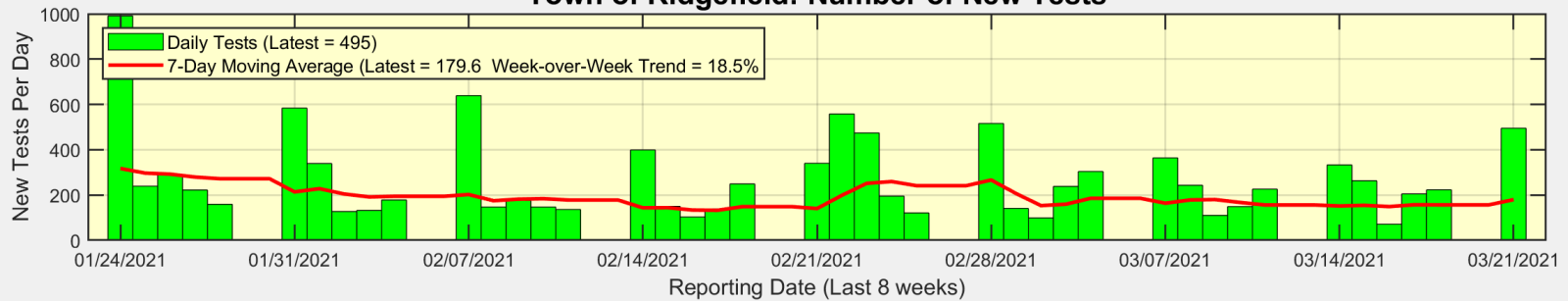

New Cases, New Tests, and Test Positivity for Ridgefield

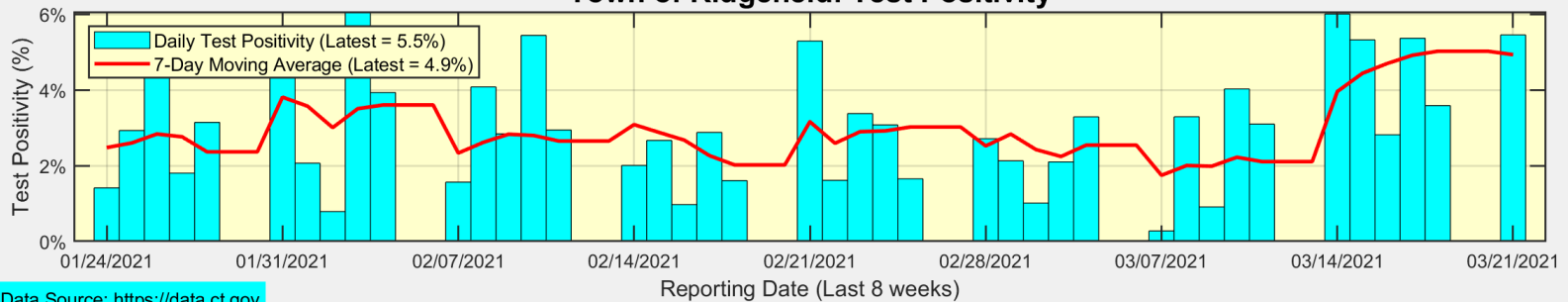
Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Cases (as of 03/21/2021)

Town of Ridgefield: Test Positivity

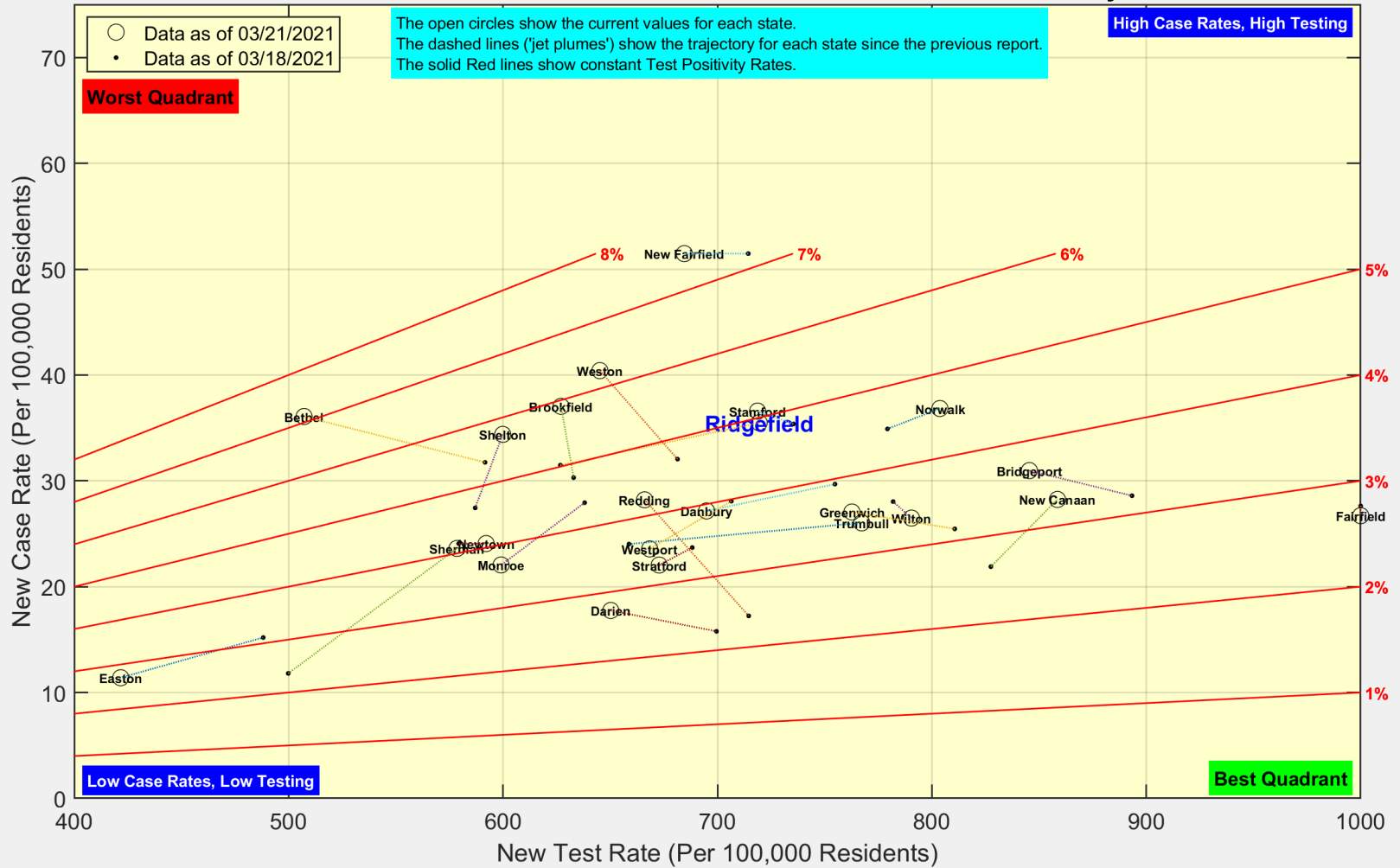

New Case Rate vs New Test Rate for all Towns in Fairfield County

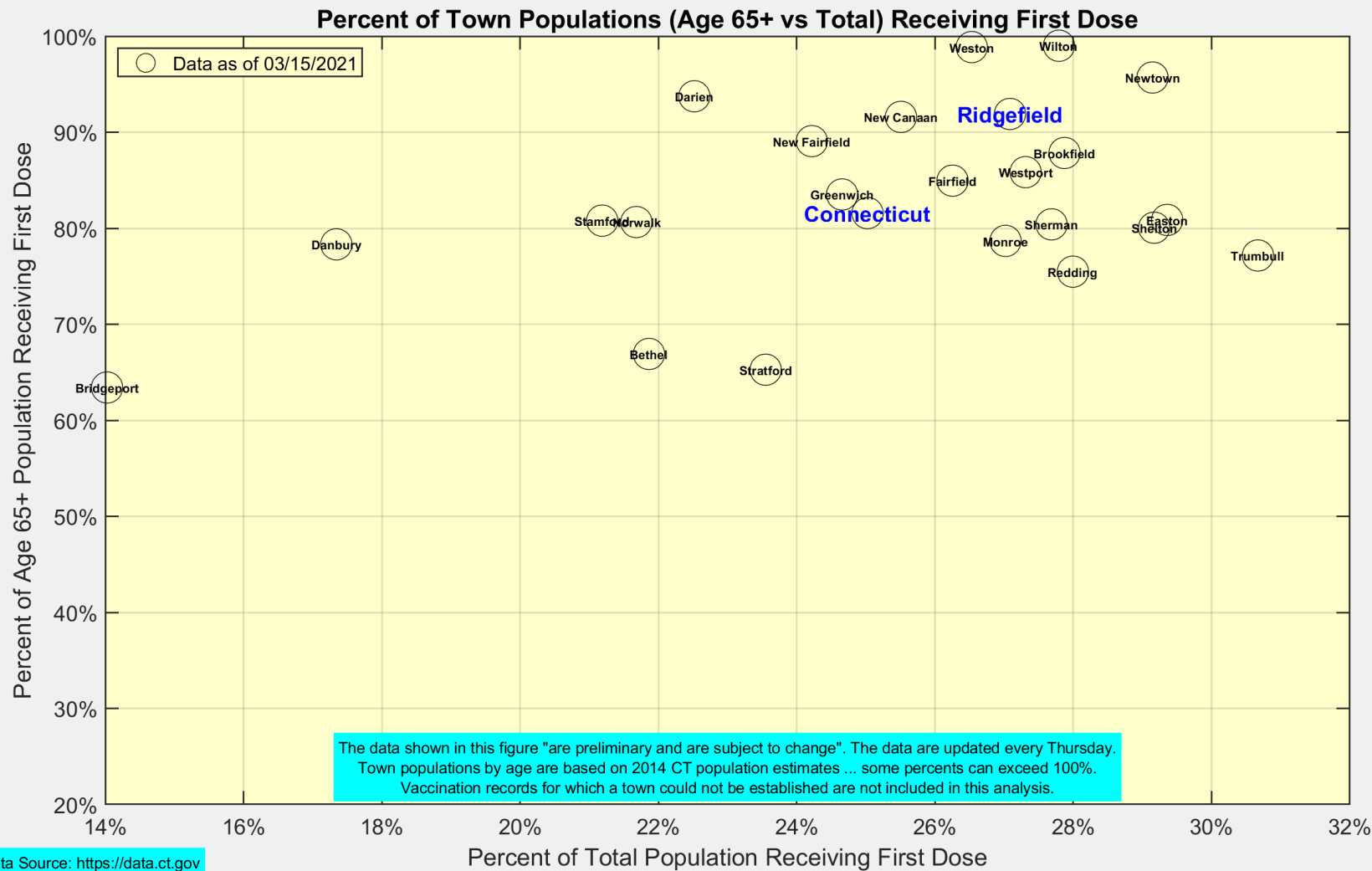
