






#### New Case Rates and Test Positivity for Connecticut, Fairfield County, and Ridgefield






#### New Cases, New Tests, and Test Positivity for Ridgefield






# **Fairfield County: New Case Rate**






# **Fairfield County: Currently Hospitalized**






# **Fairfield County: Number of Deaths**






#### **School-Age Vaccination Rates for Towns in Fairfield County**
