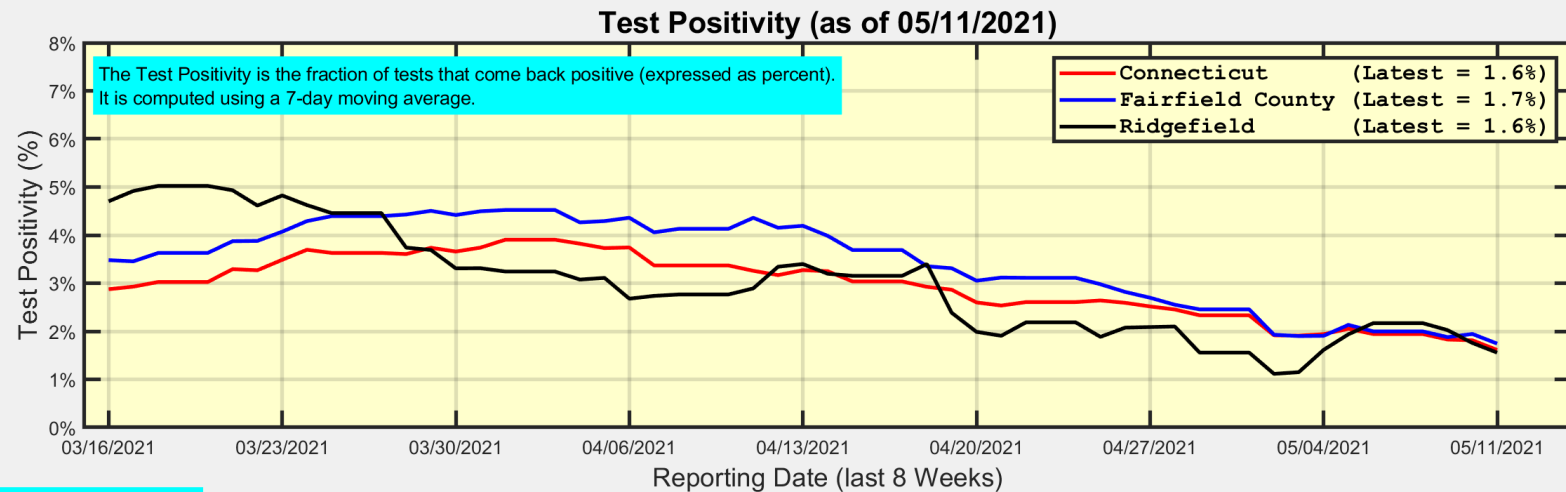
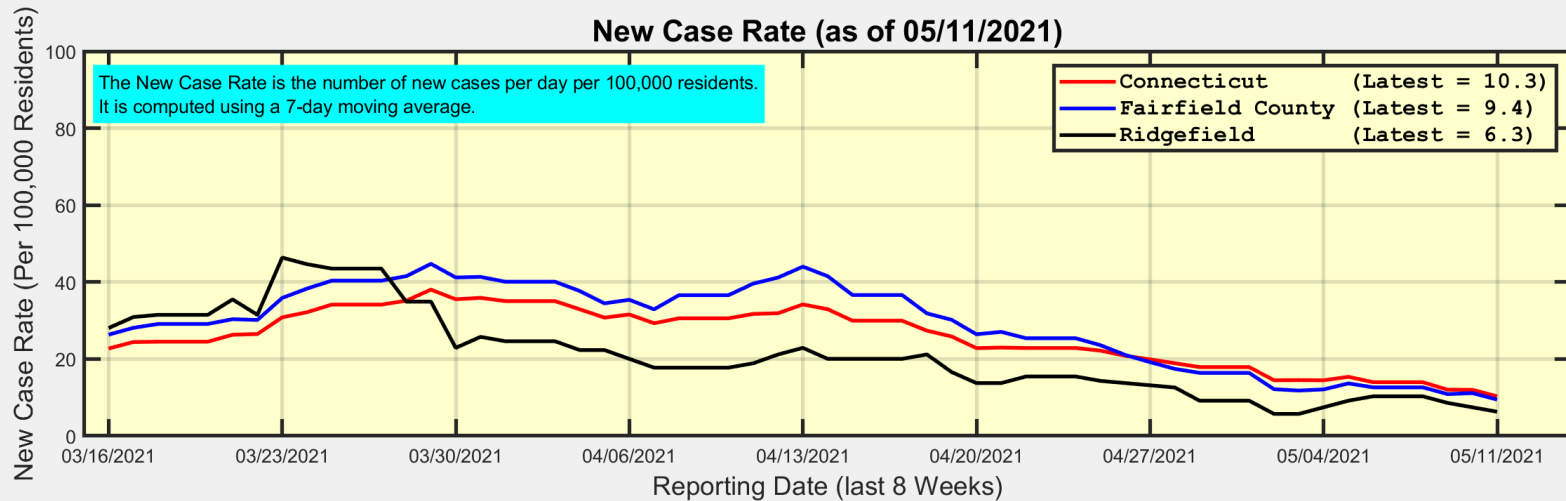

# New Case Rates and Test Positivity for Connecticut, Fairfield County, and Ridgefield



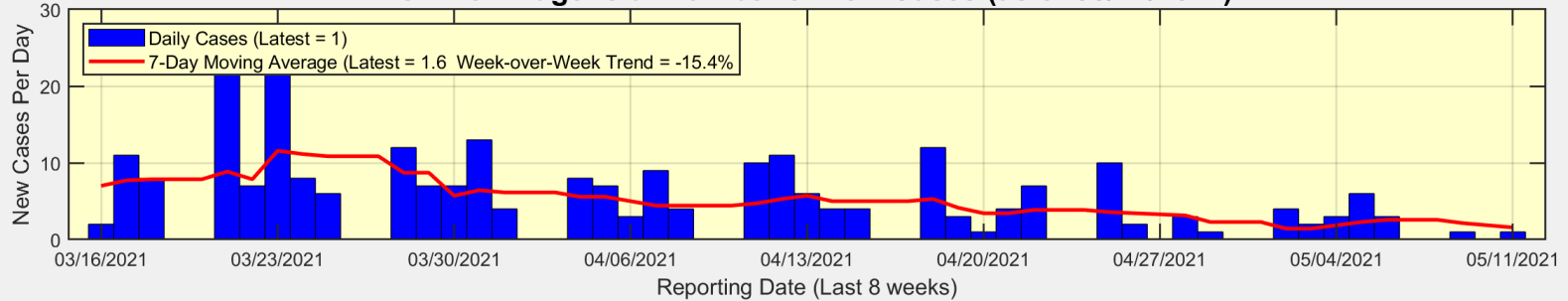

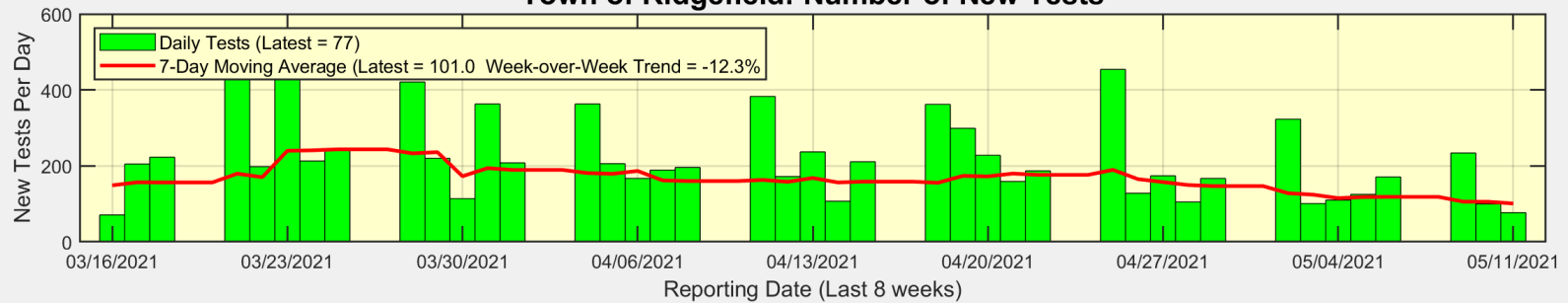

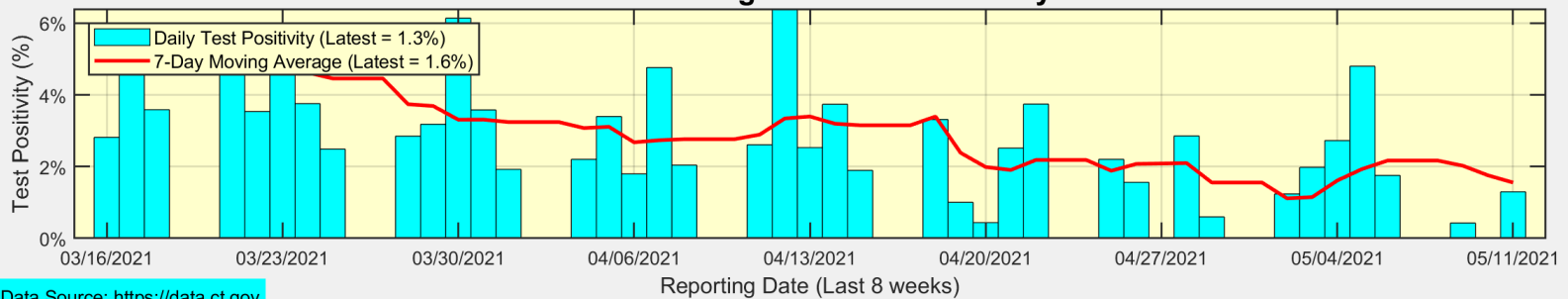
**Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Cases (as of 05/11/2021)**



**Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Tests**



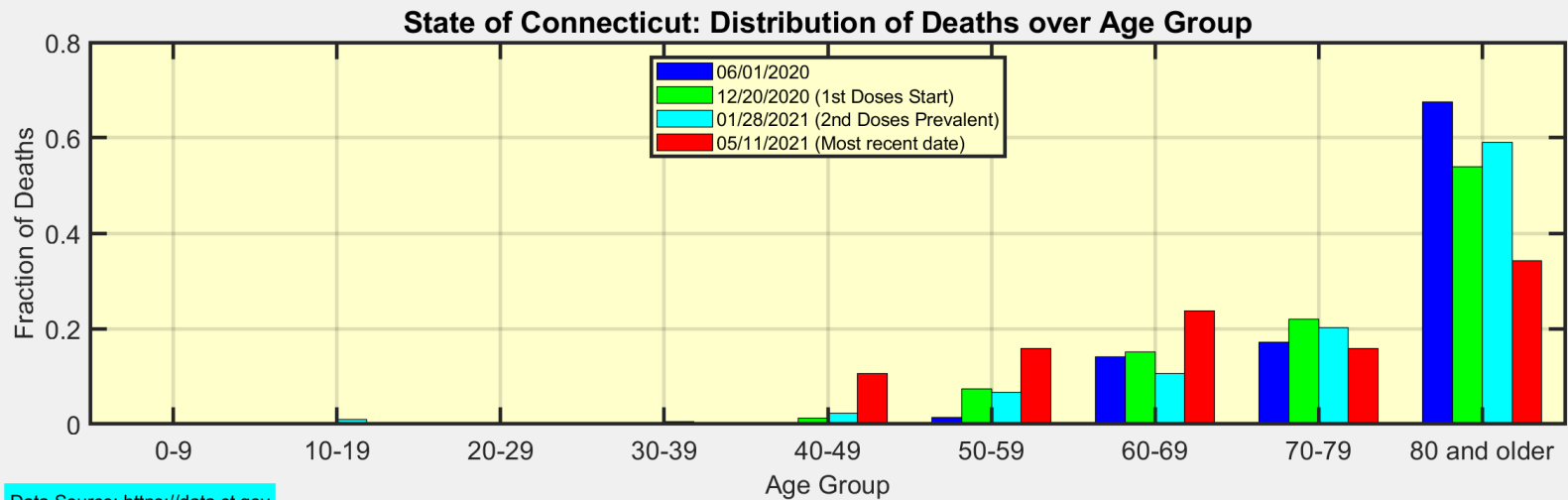
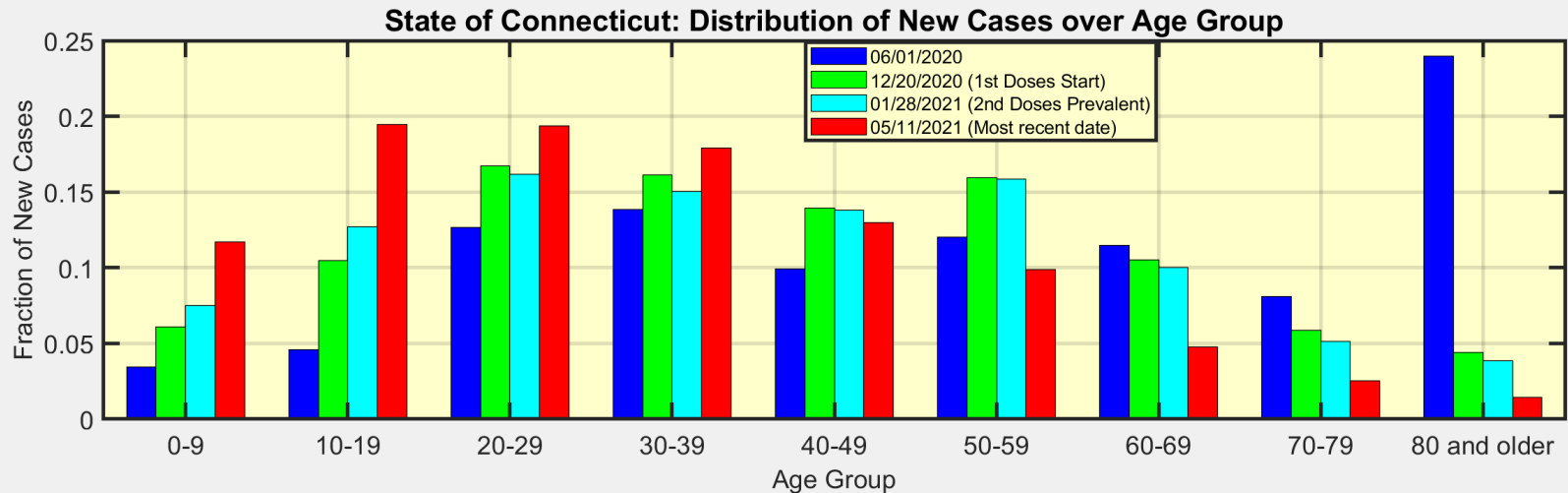

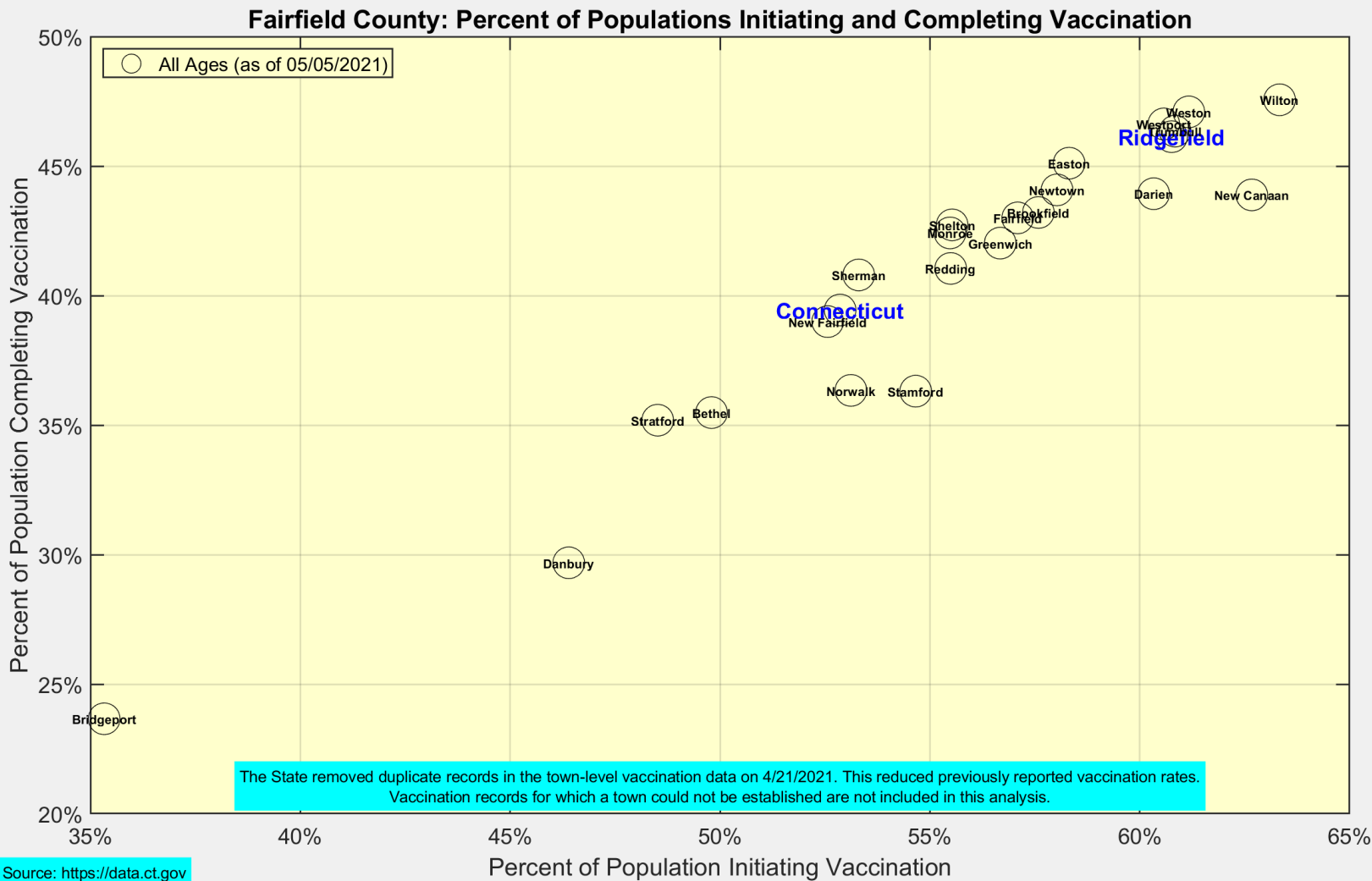
# We are seeing more cases in ages 10-39 as ages 60+ become fully vaccinated



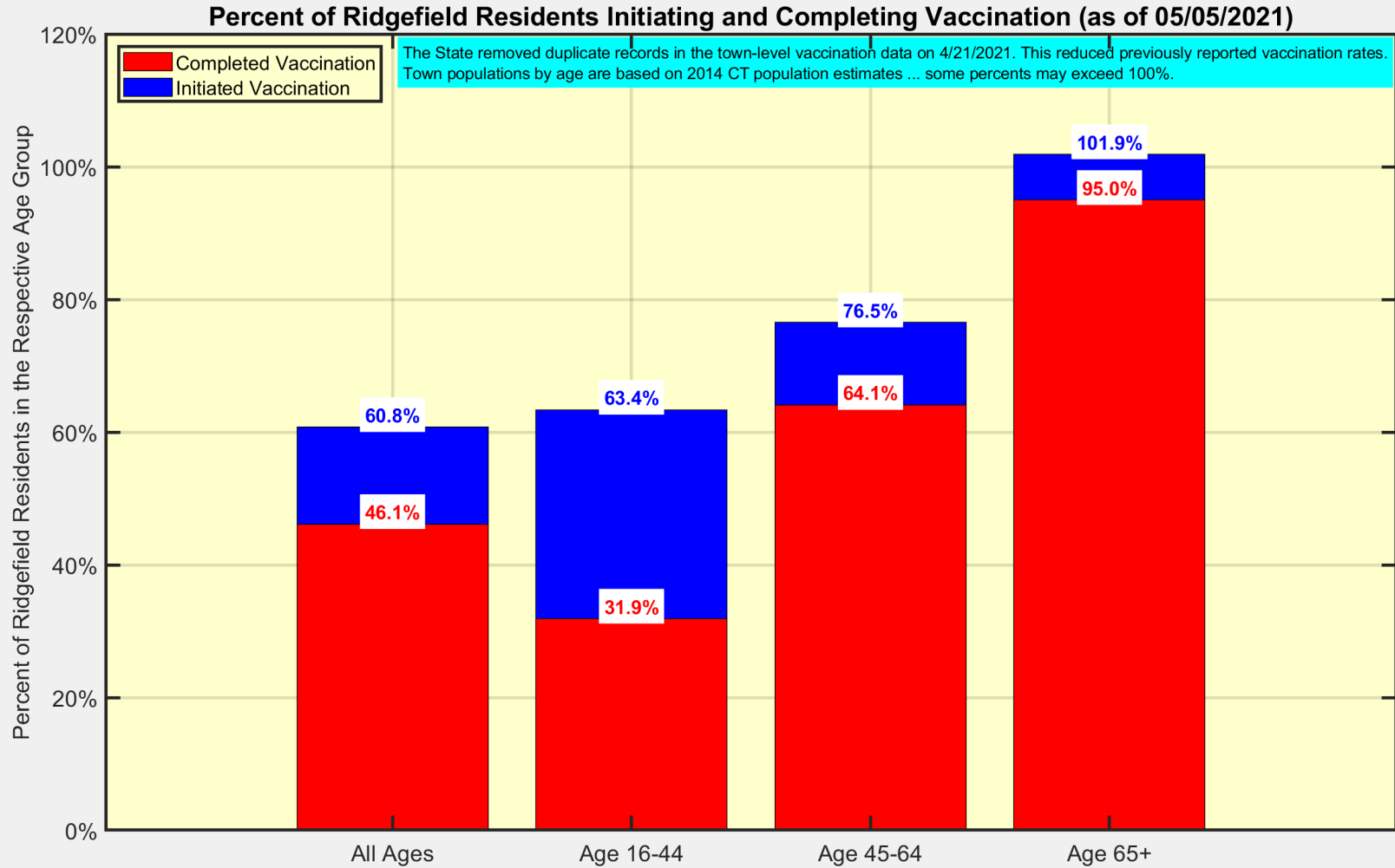

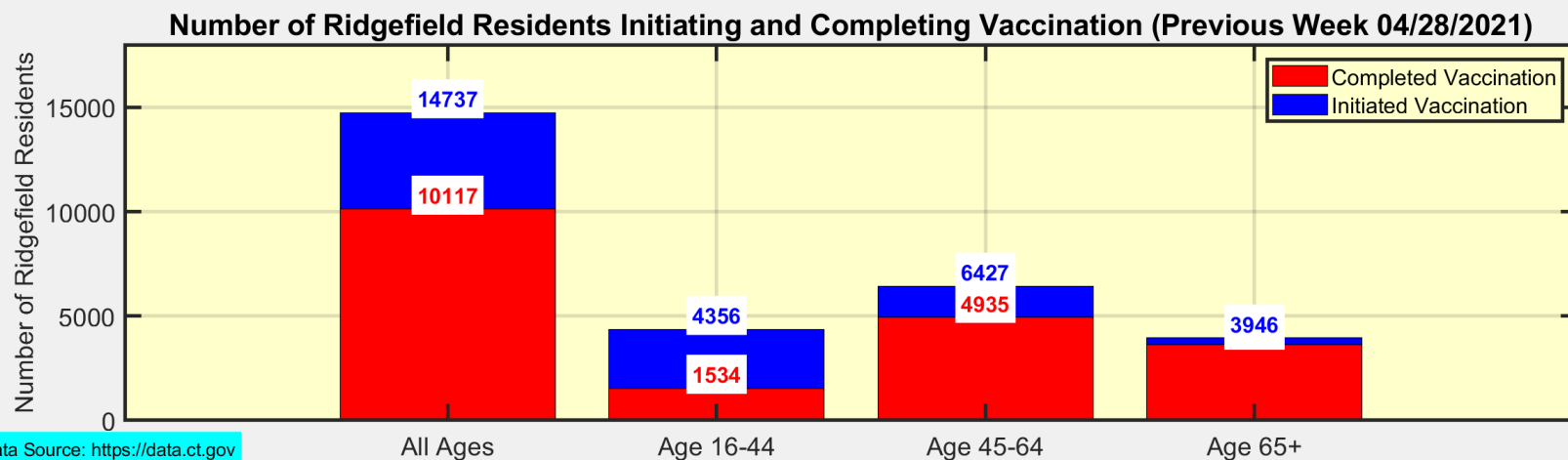
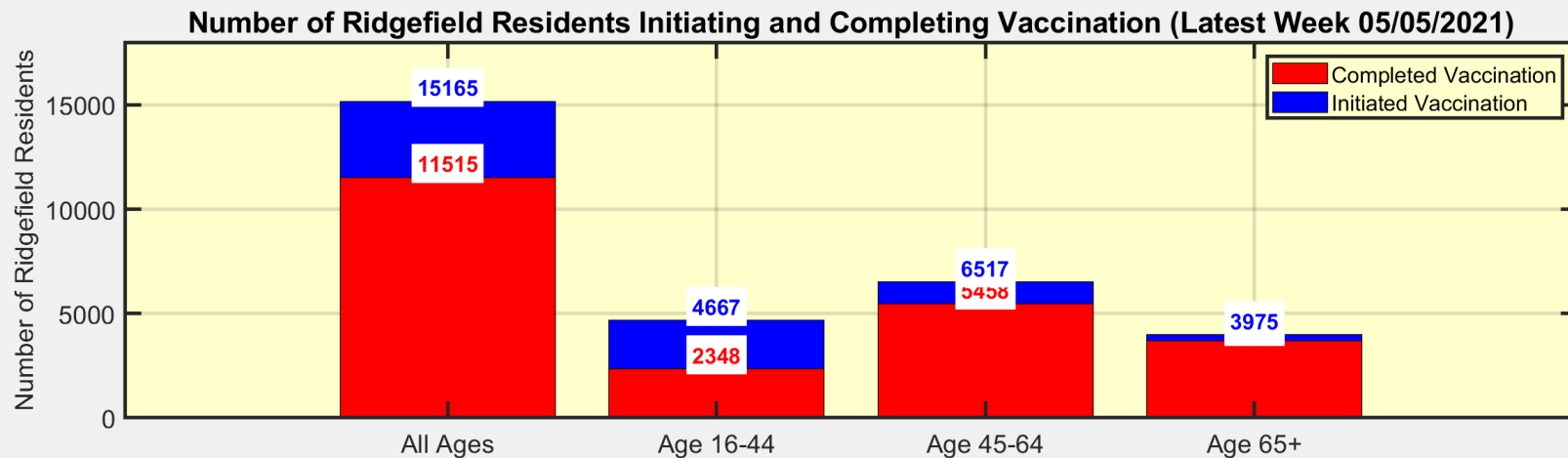
