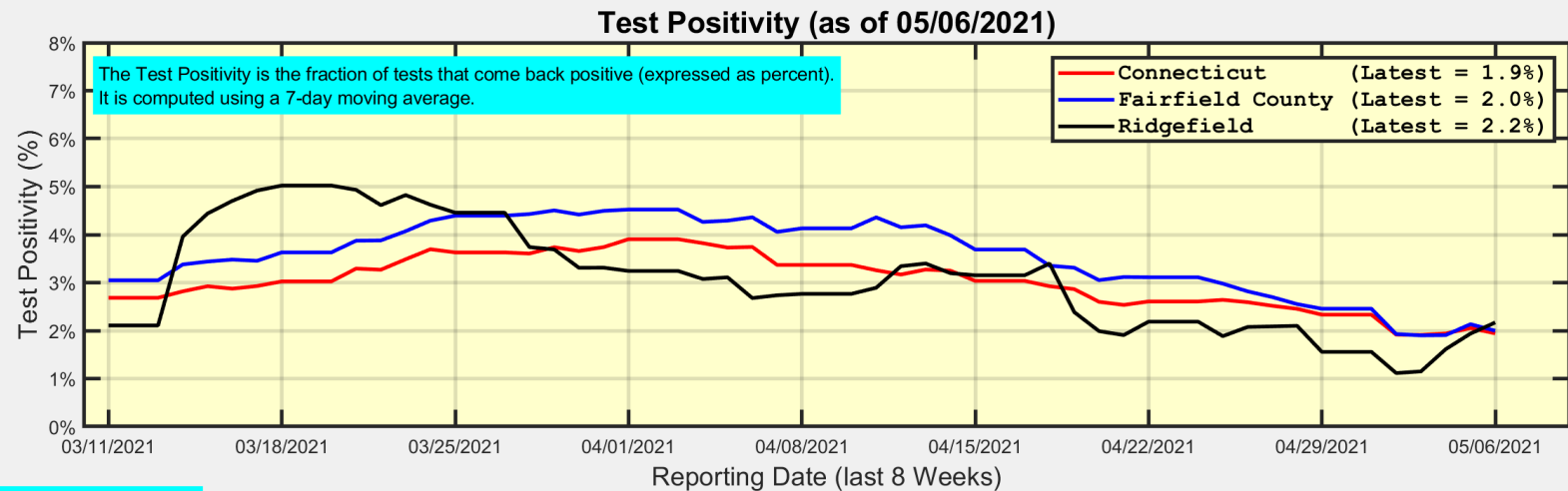
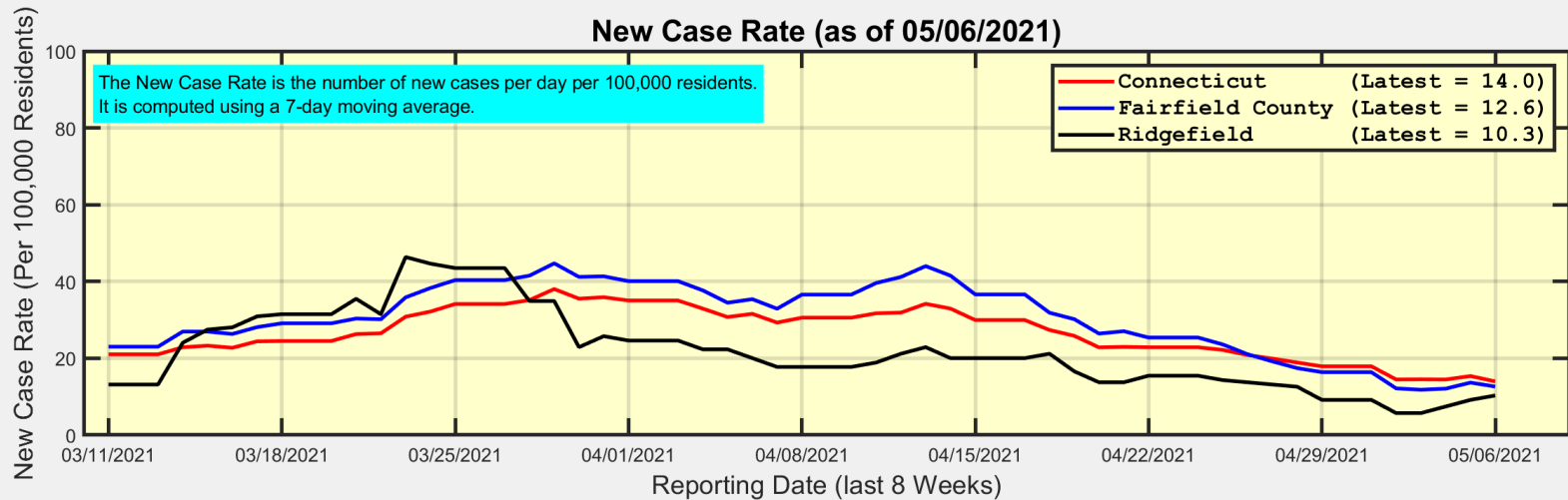

New Case Rates and Test Positivity for Connecticut, Fairfield County, and Ridgefield

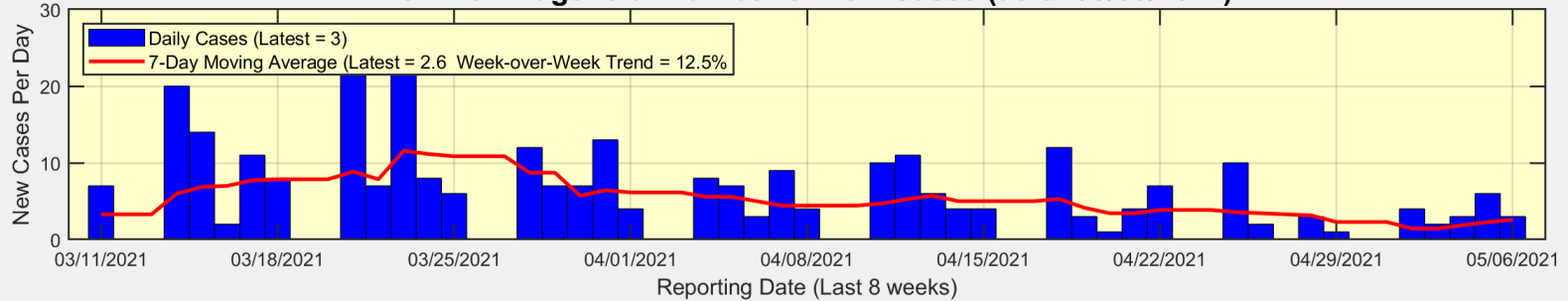

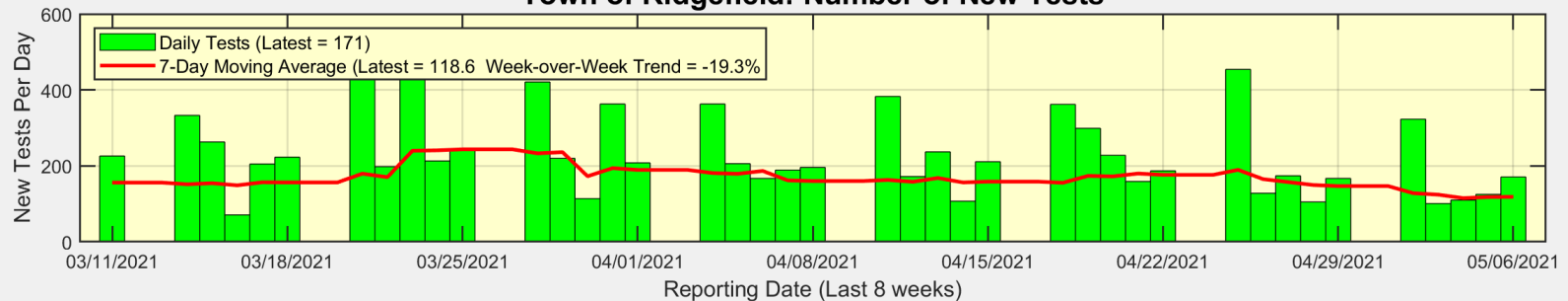

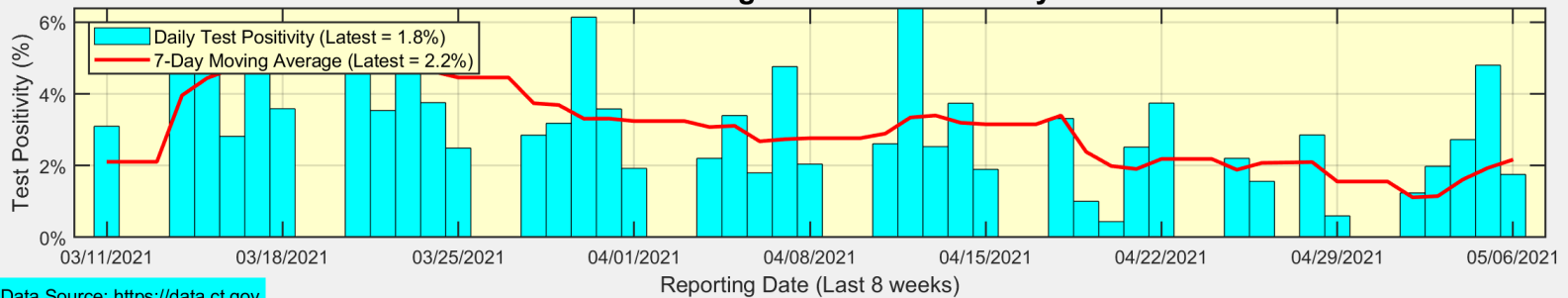
Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Cases (as of 05/06/2021)



Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Tests



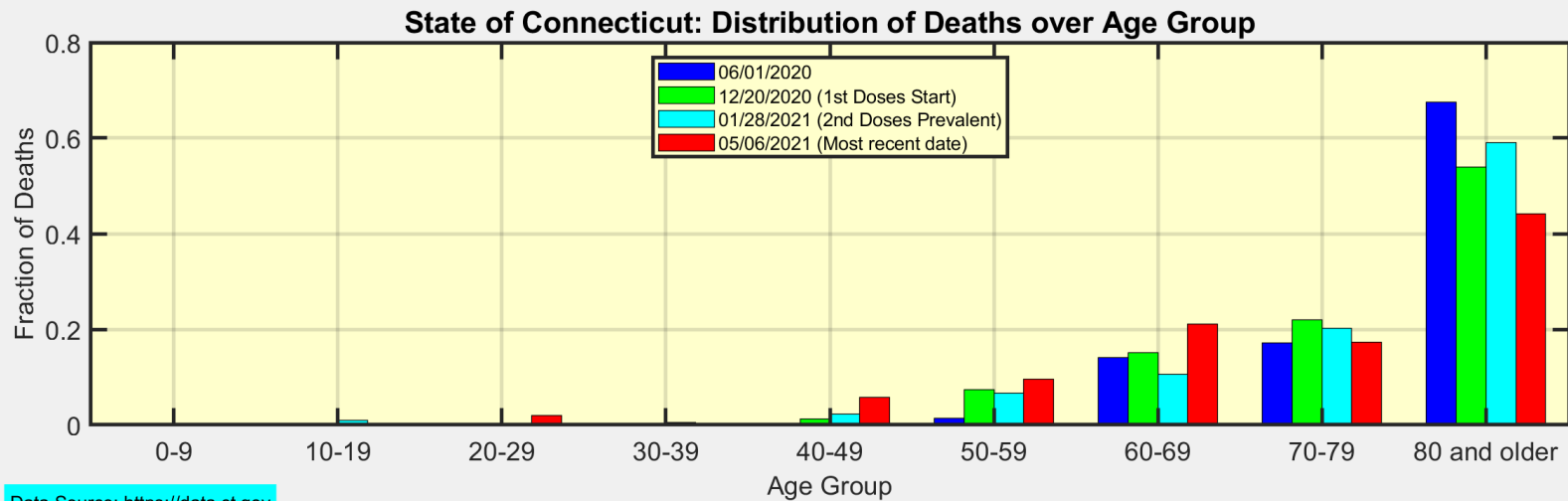
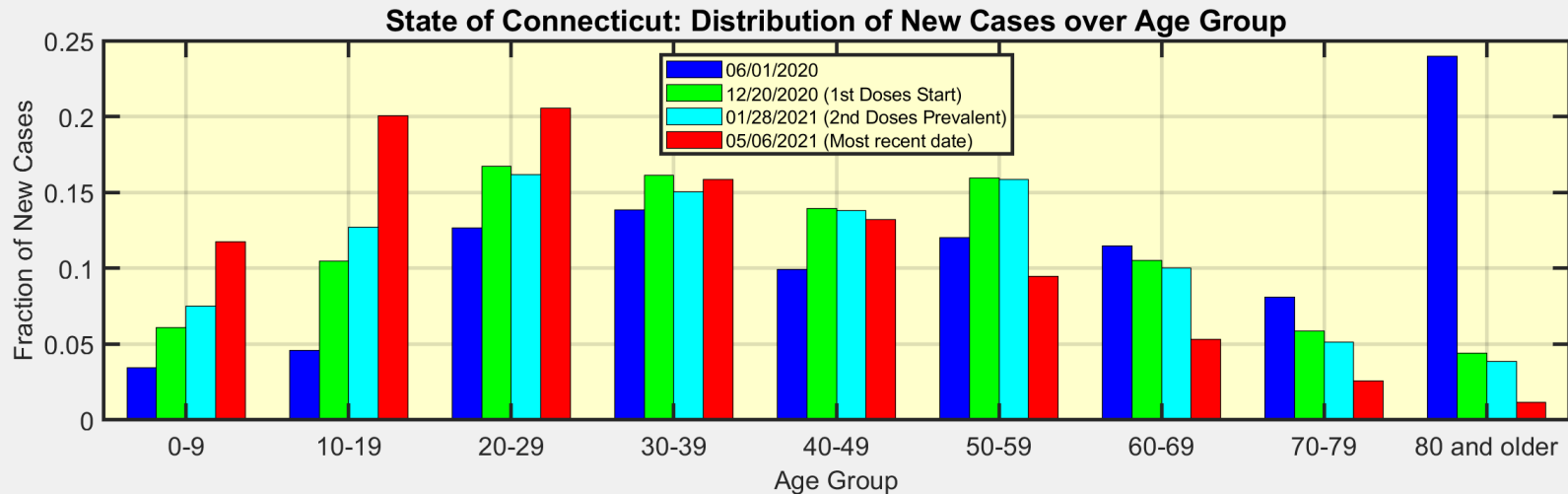

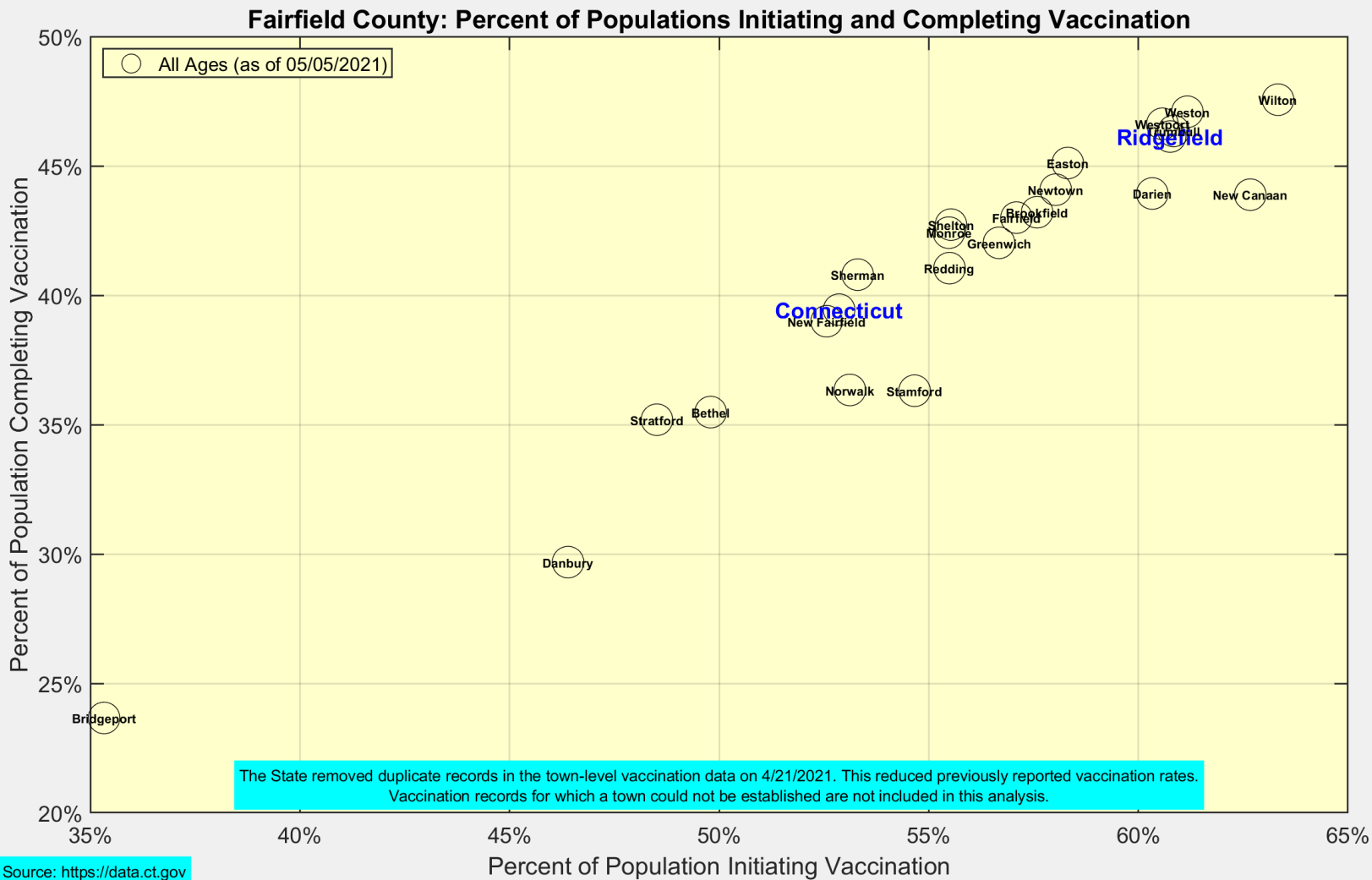
We are seeing more cases in ages 10-39 as ages 60+ become fully vaccinated



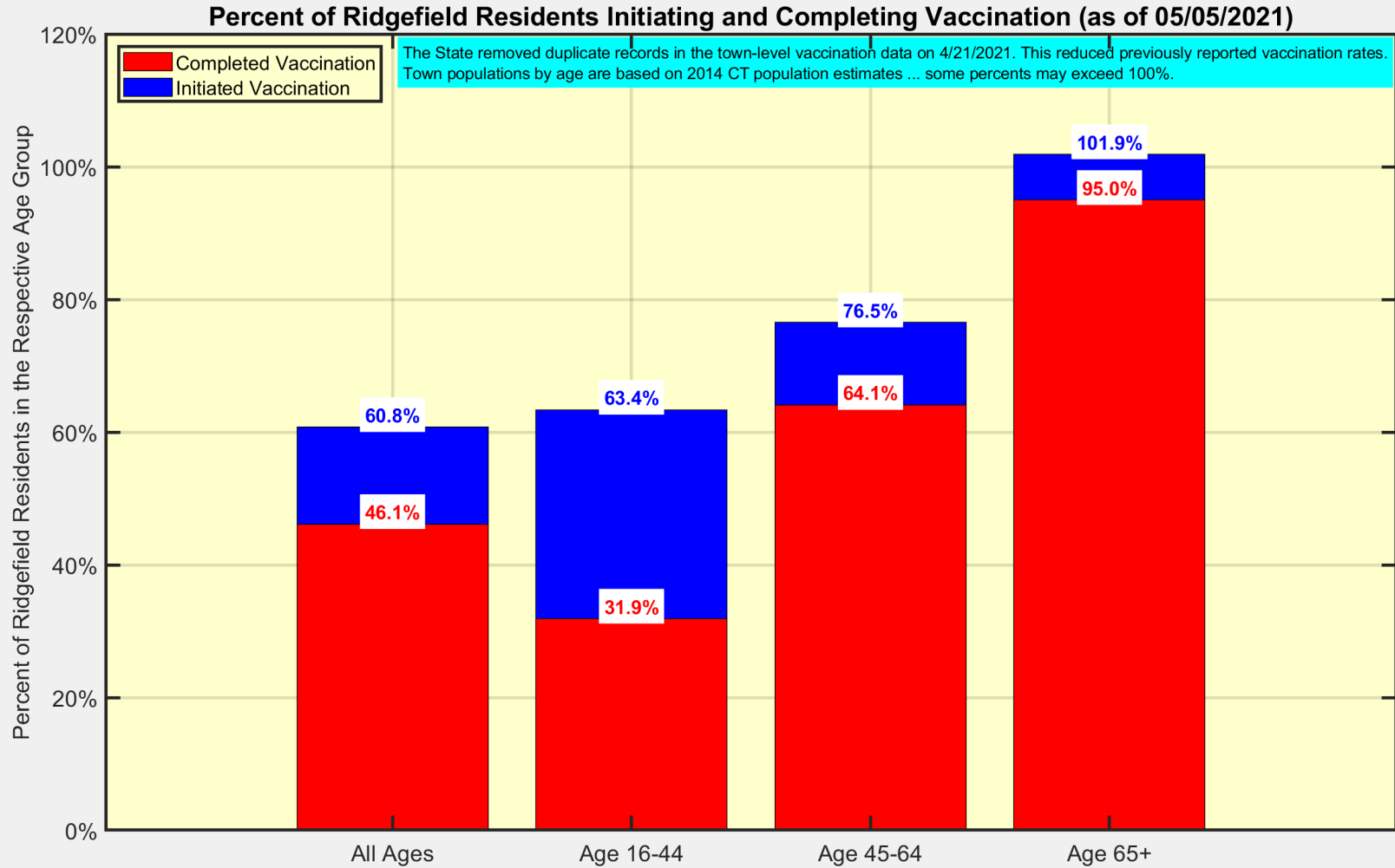

Latest Vaccination Rates for Ridgefield Residents

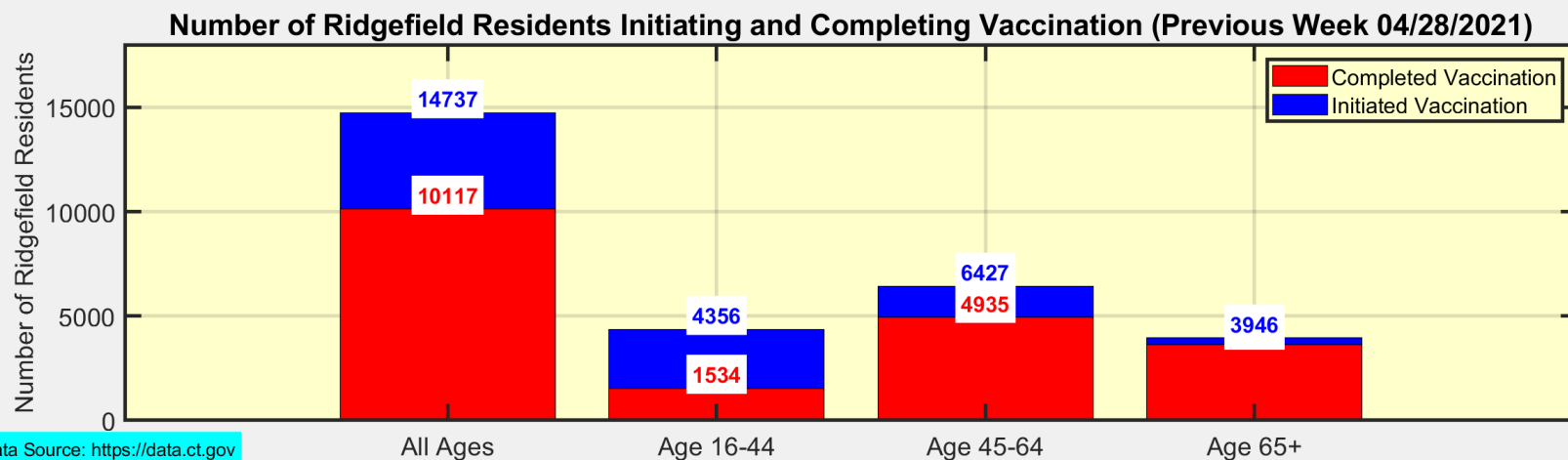
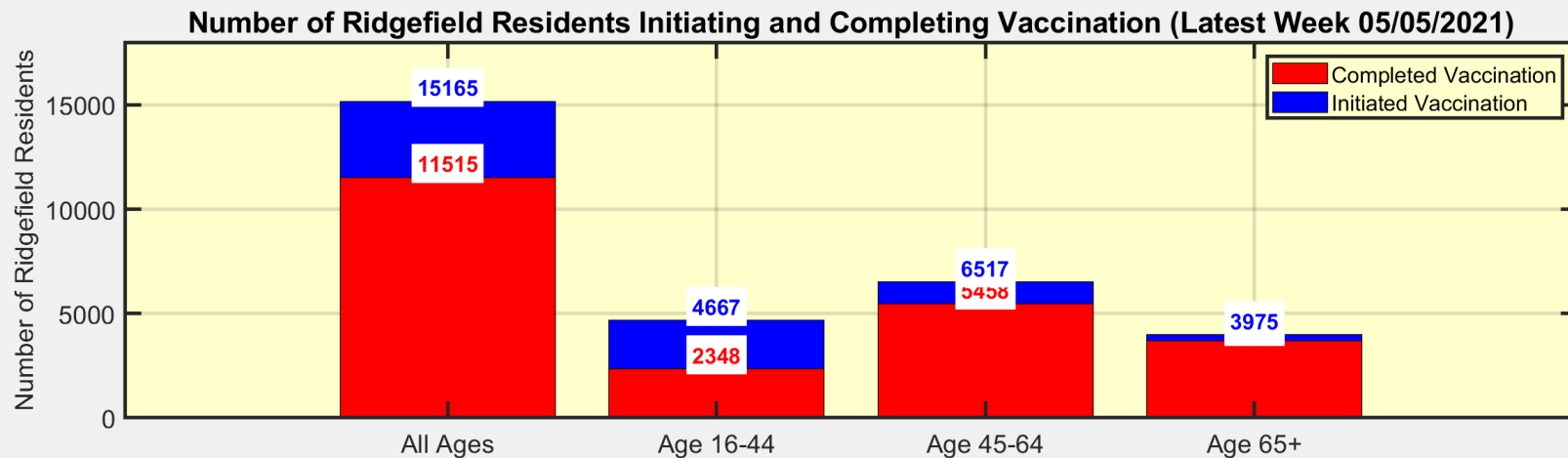
