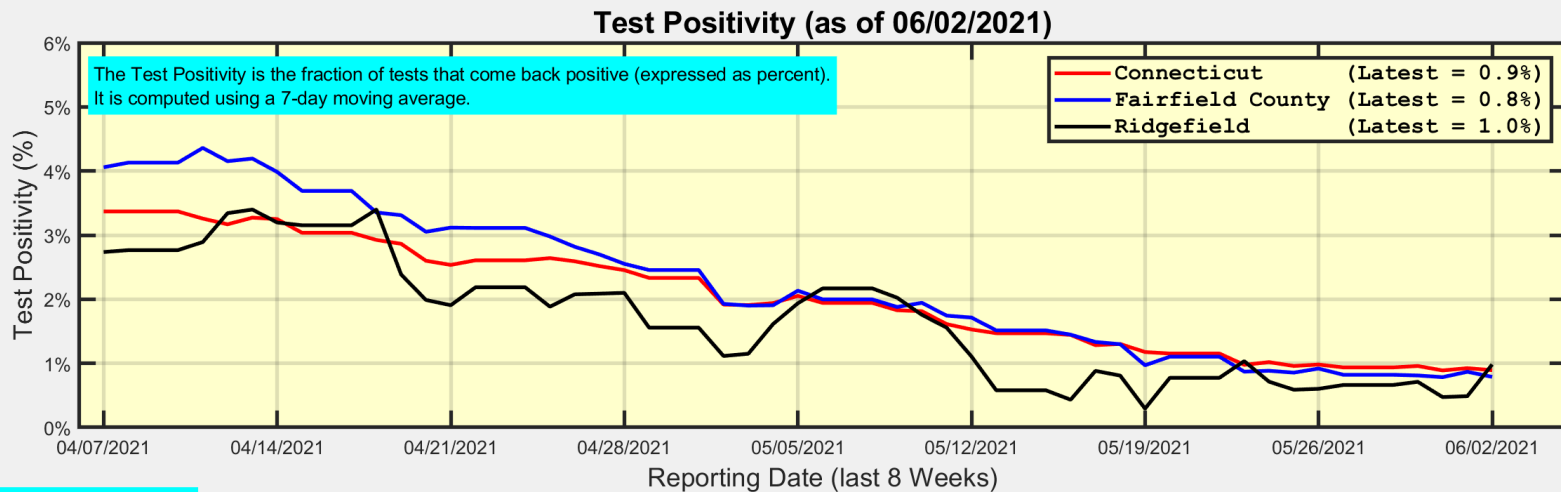
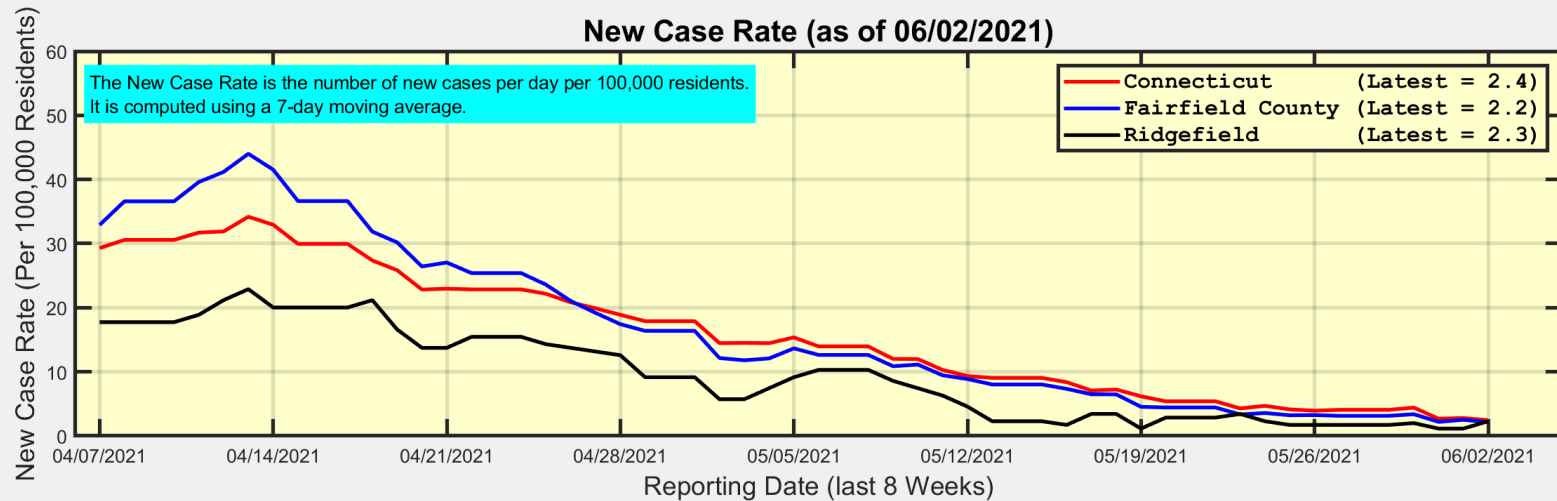

# New Case Rates and Test Positivity for Connecticut, Fairfield County, and Ridgefield

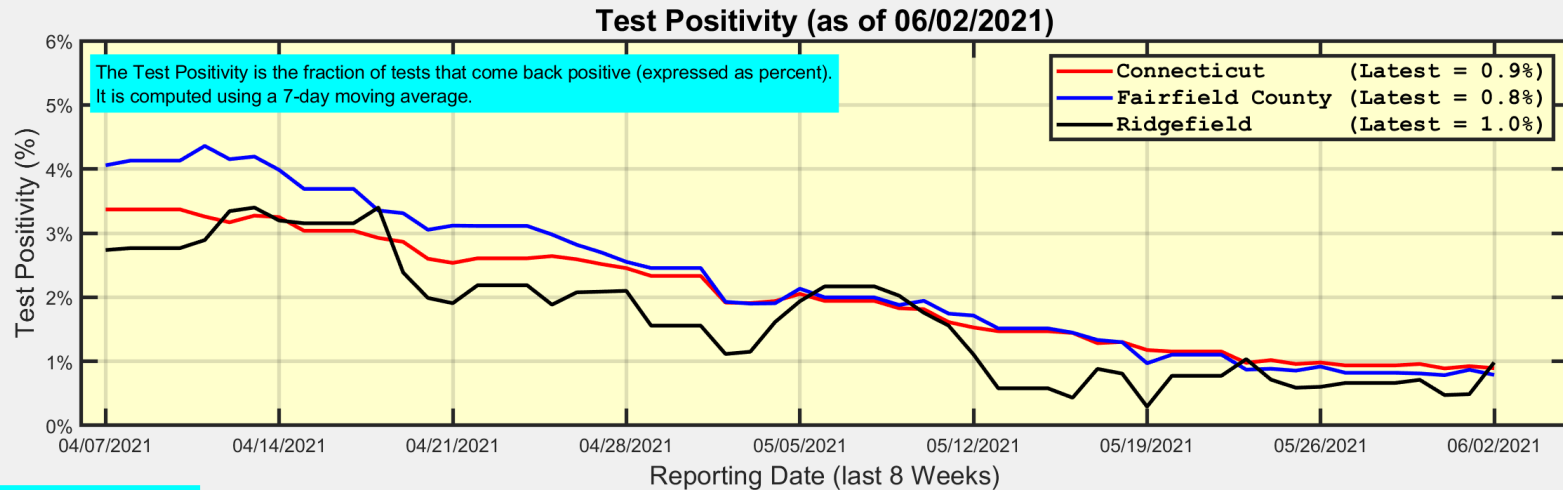
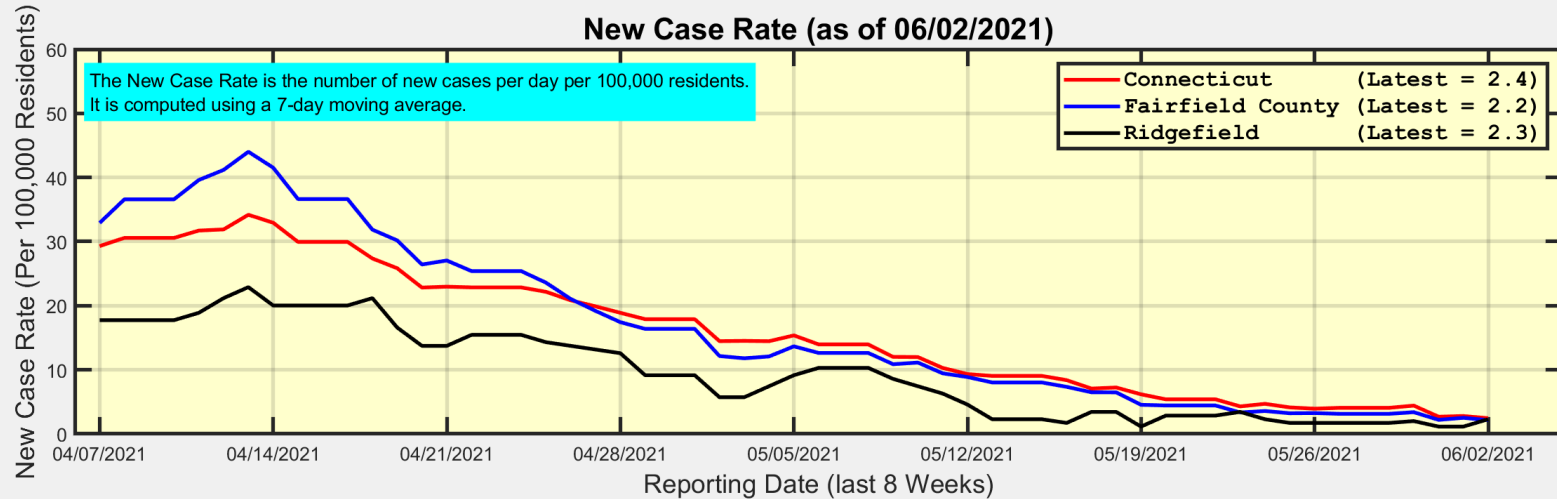

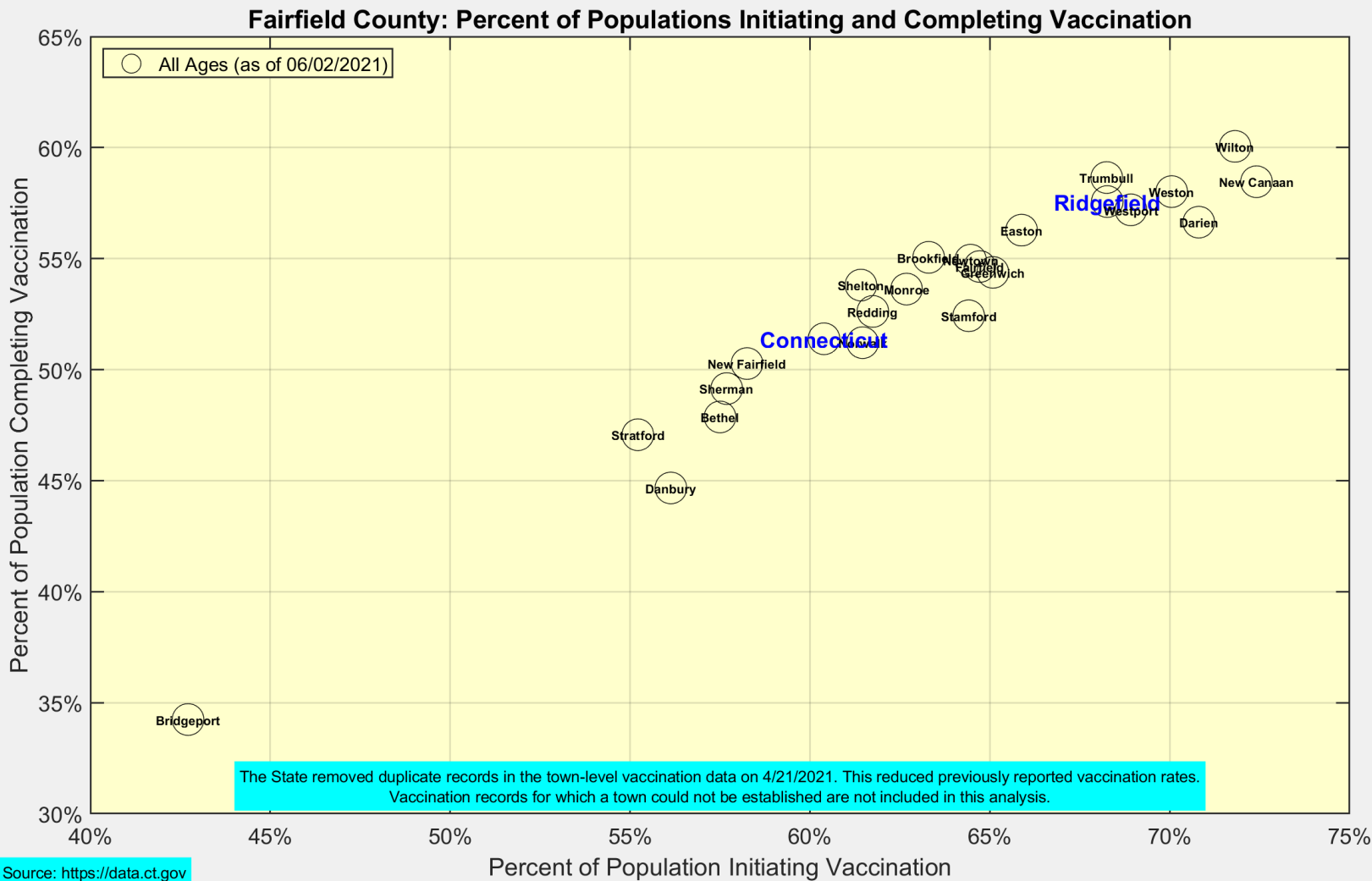
# New Cases, New Tests, and Test Positivity for Ridgefield



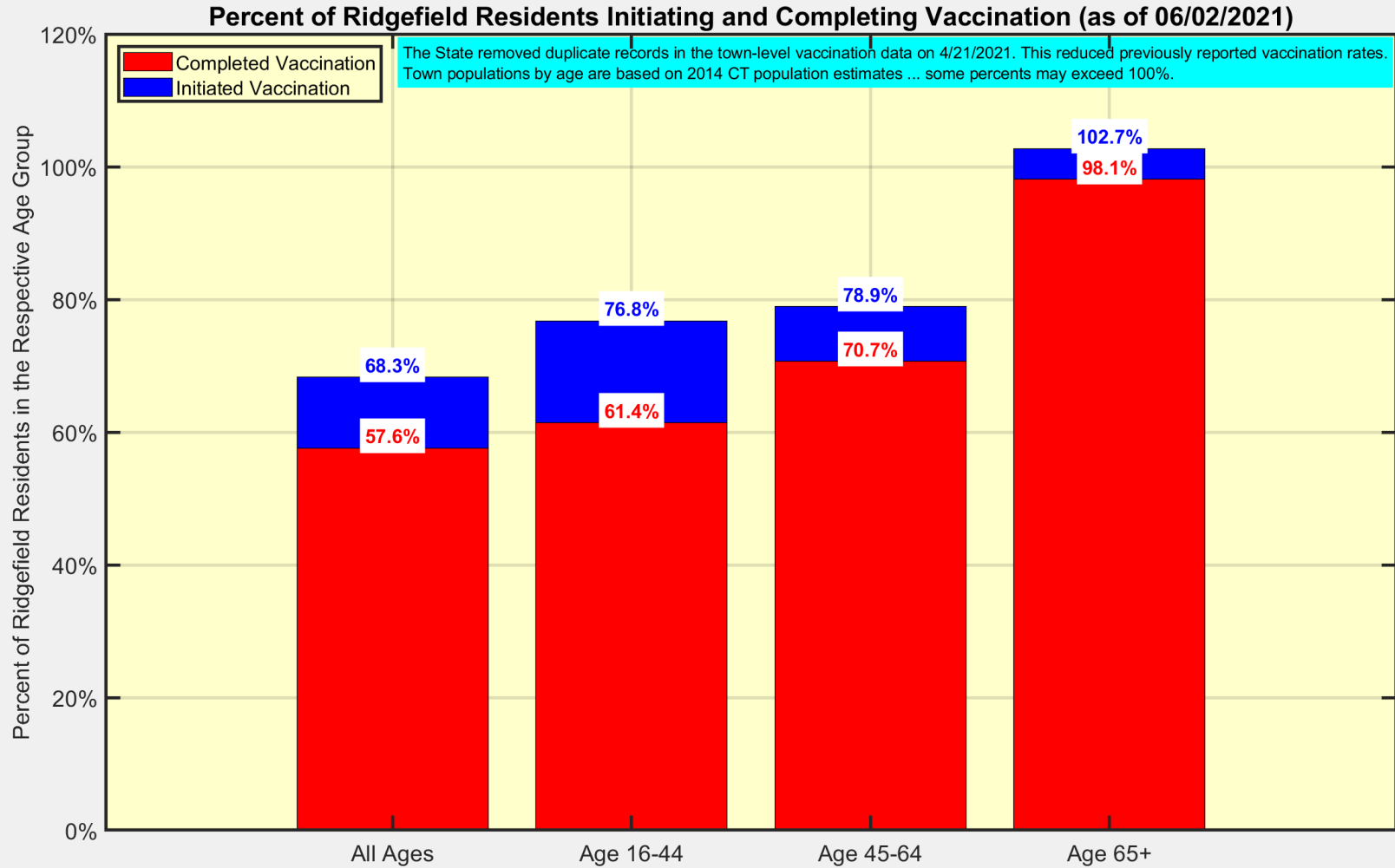

# Latest Vaccination Rates for Ridgefield Residents

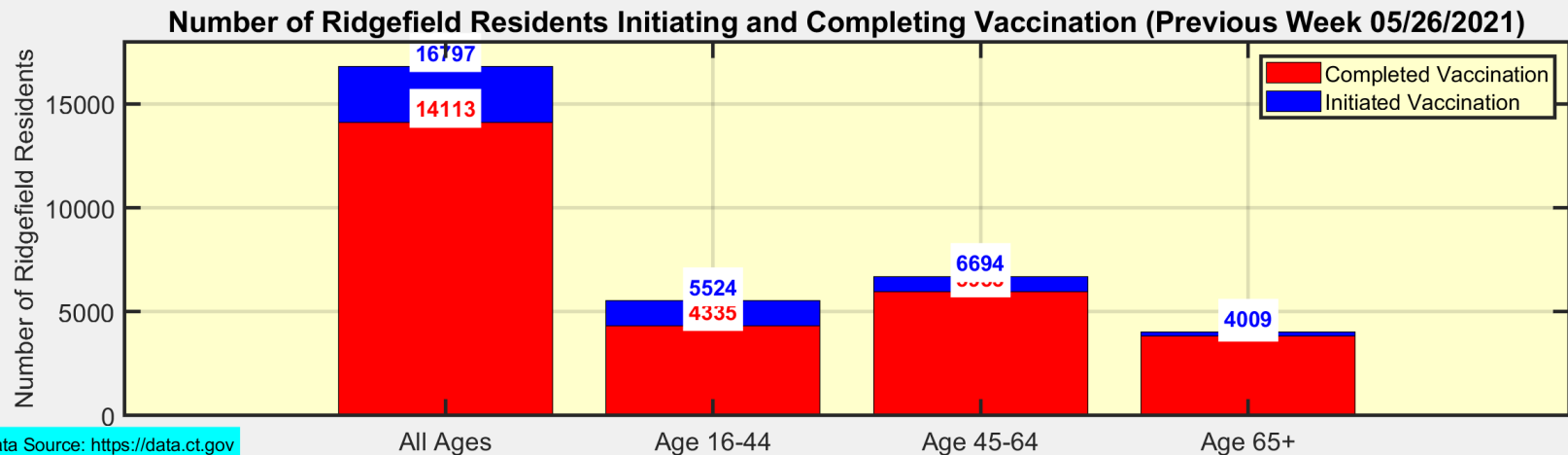
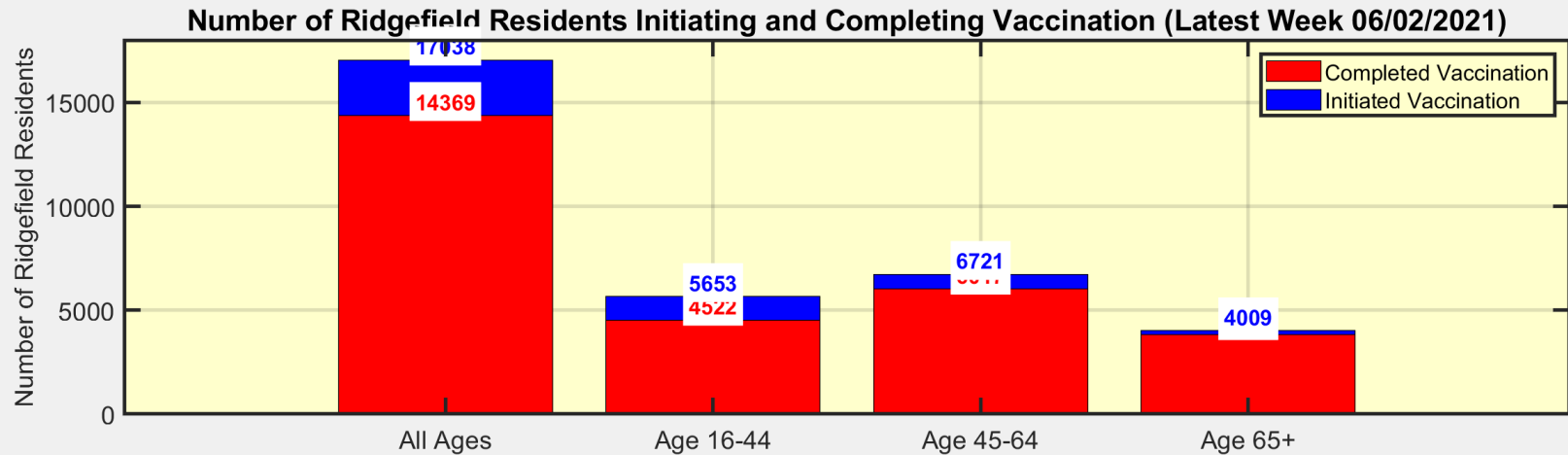
