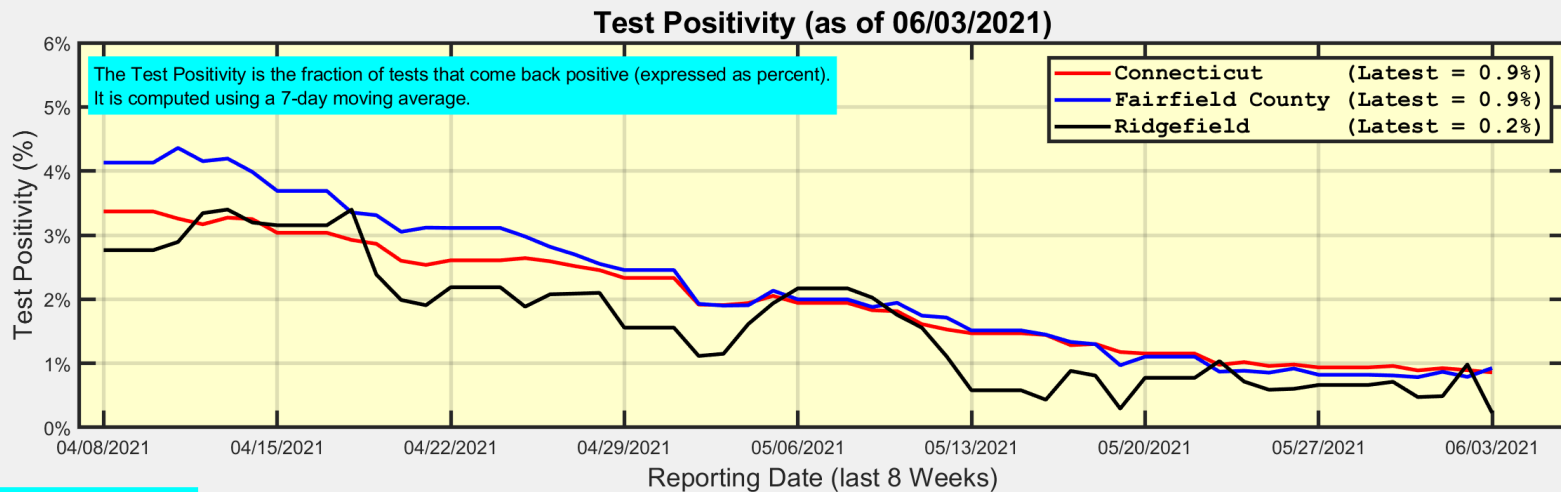
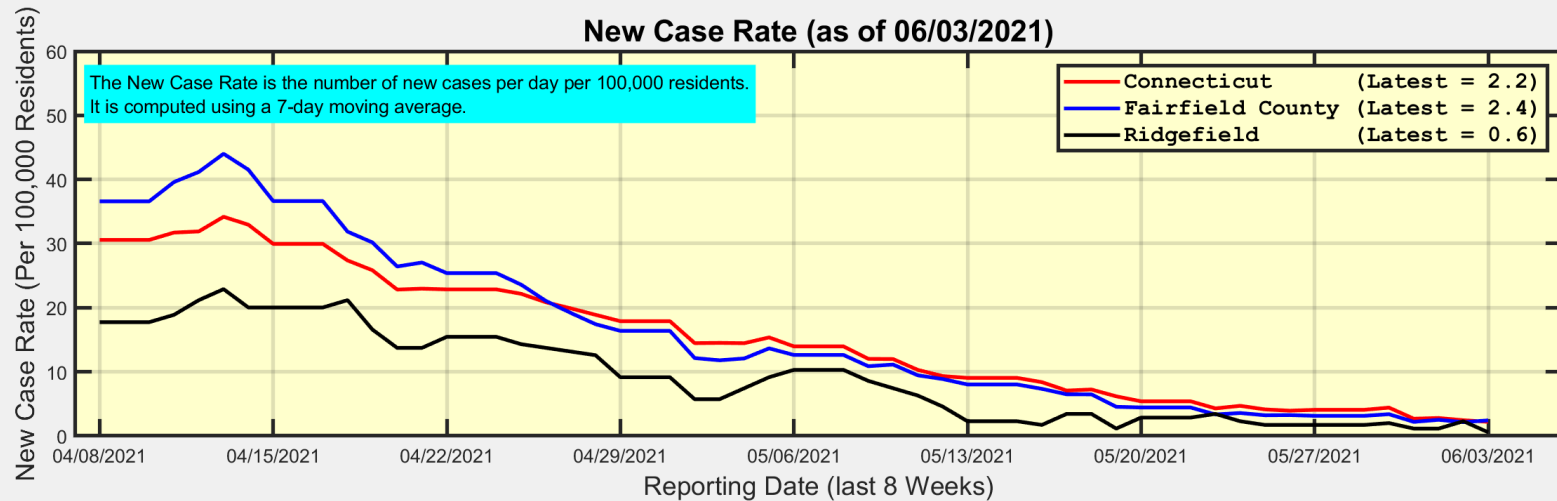

New Case Rates and Test Positivity for Connecticut, Fairfield County, and Ridgefield



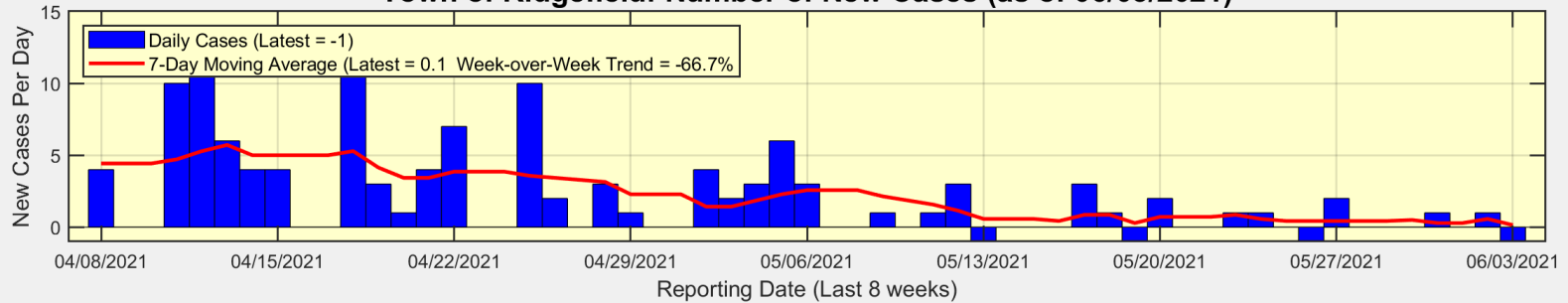

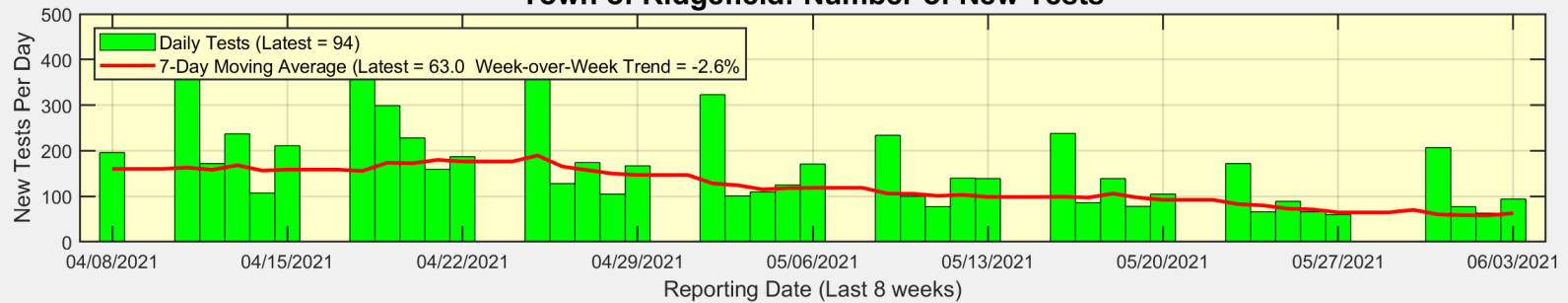

New Cases, New Tests, and Test Positivity for Ridgefield

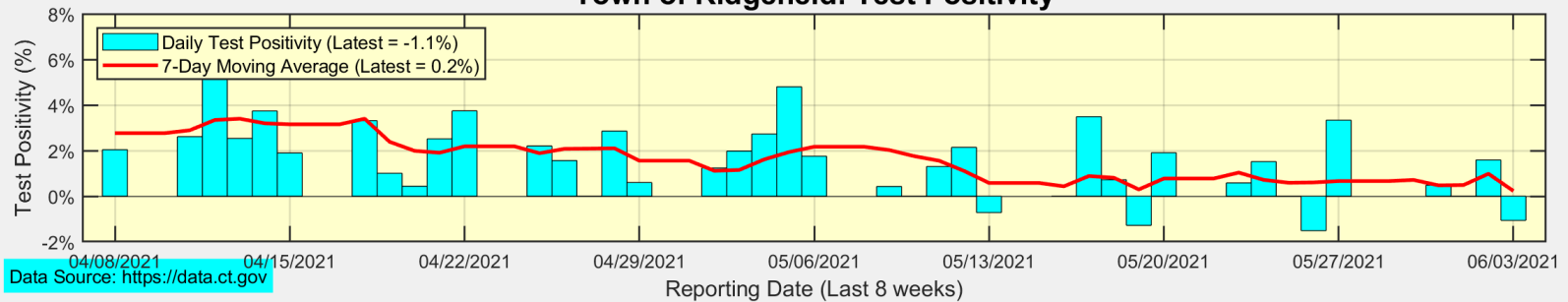
Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Cases (as of 06/03/2021)



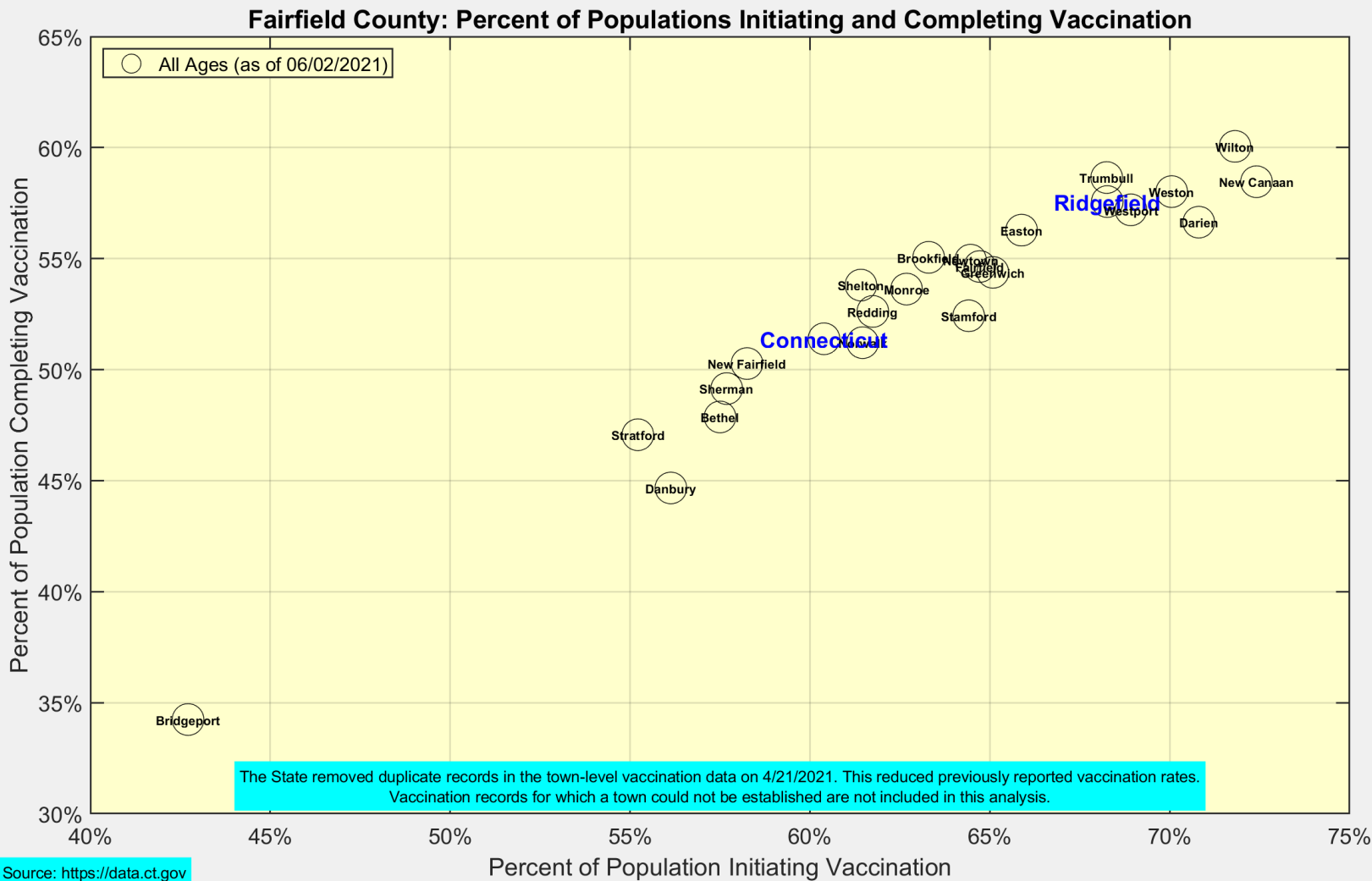
Town of Ridgefield: Number of New Tests



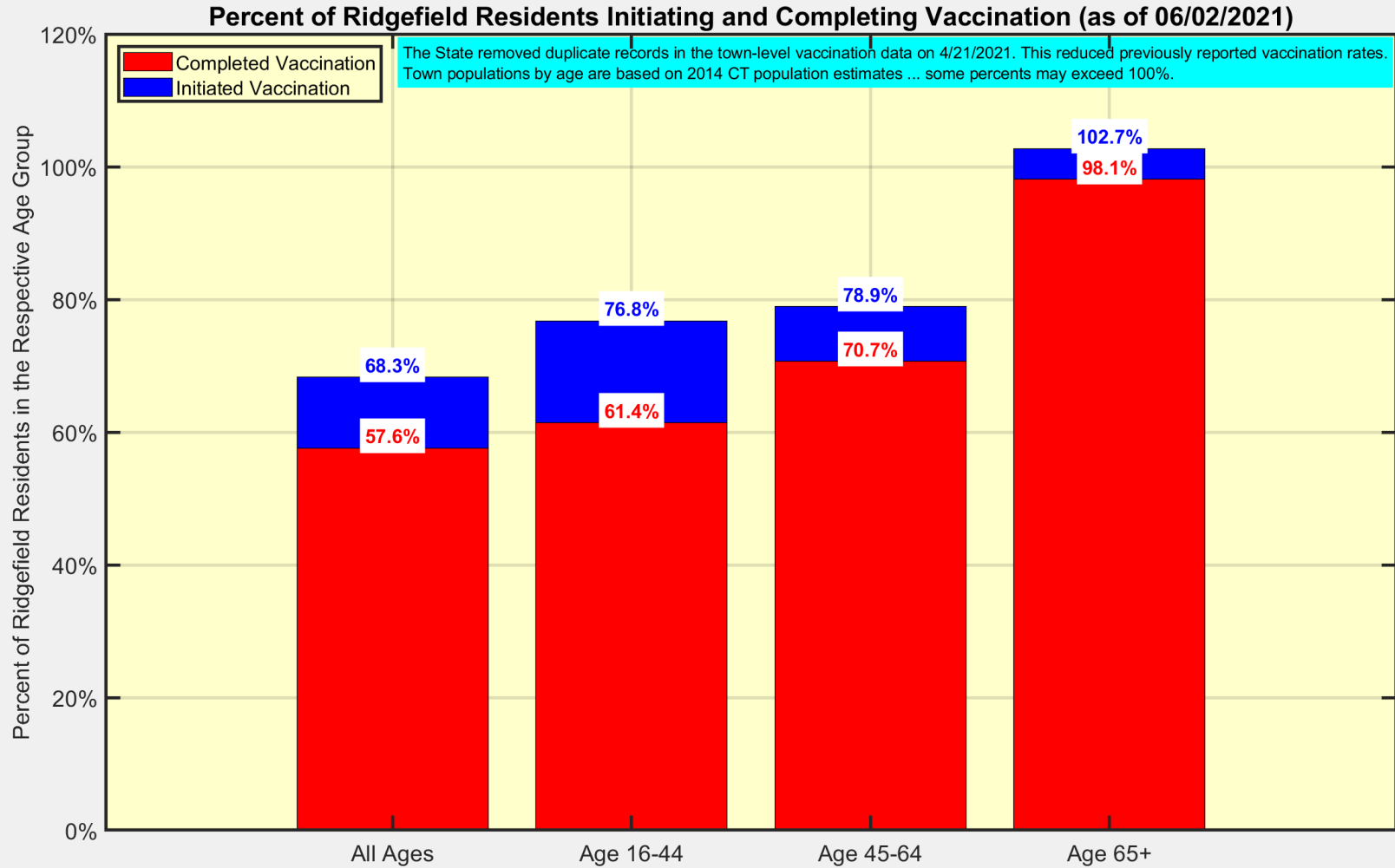
Town of Ridgefield: Test Positivity

Latest Vaccination Rates for Ridgefield Residents

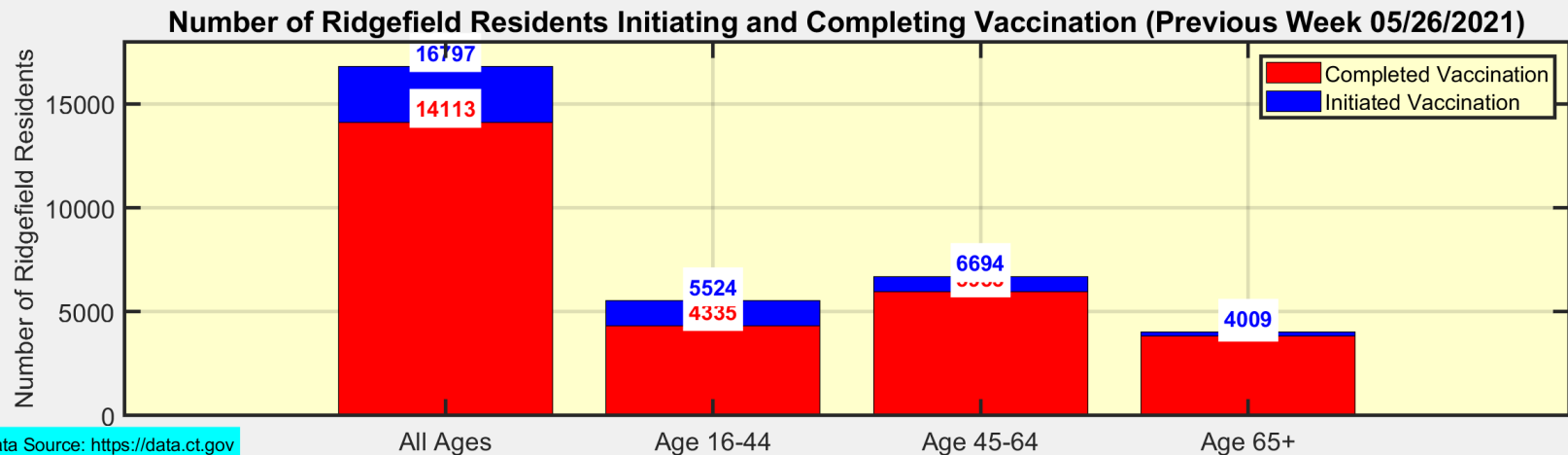
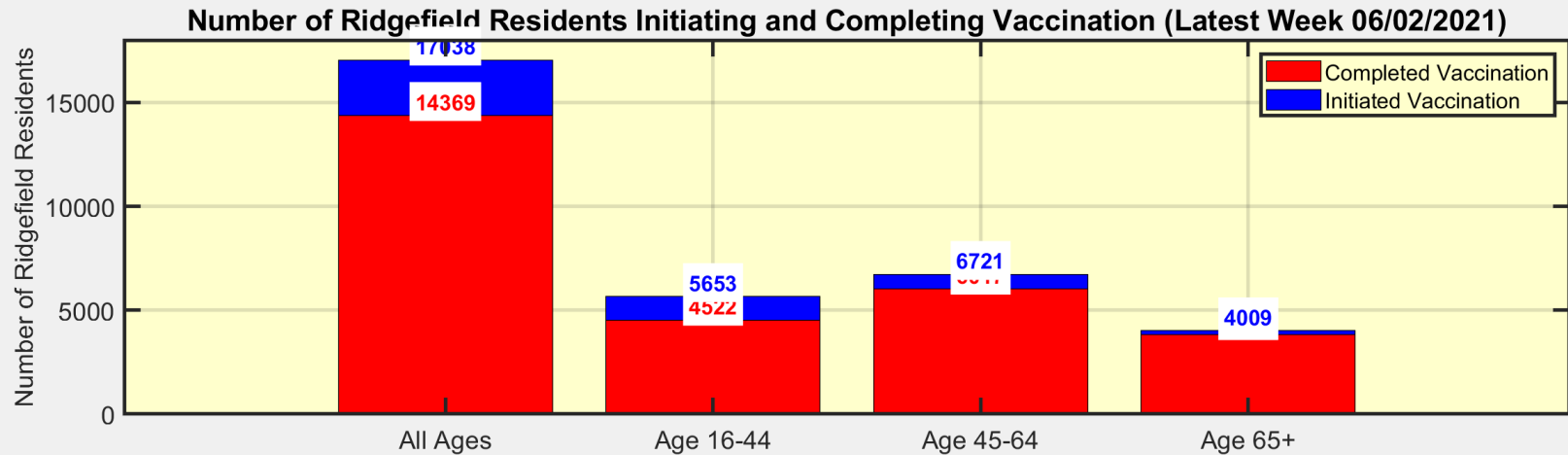
