




There were 11 new cases reported in Ridgefield on Thursday. Test Positivity is increasing.




New Case Rates increased from 32.6 to 35.4 per 100,000 residents.



These are the latest New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County.




This is the distribution of New Cases over age group for the entire State of Connecticut.




This heat map shows the progression of New Case Rates for all towns in Fairfield County.




Connecticut has higher Test Rates than most states, and New Cases are rising.
