## NOW THAT YOU HAVE YOUR VACCINATION APPOINTMENT-WHAT NEXT?

- Bring: your ID proving your eligibility to receive the vaccine in the current phase; your insurance card; and your confirmation email (print it or take a picture of it).
- First dose recipients -- make sure you are not signing up for a second-dose-only clinic
- If this is your second dose, bring: your first dose card along with your insurance card and your ID
