*First and second doses of the COVID-19 Vaccine will be administered at Yanity Gym during the following dates and times. **Please note:** Week of February 8 appointments will be added to VAMS on a rolling basis as vaccine availability is confirmed. No walk-ins accepted.*

Wednesday: 2/10 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.  
Thursday: 2/11 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Please plan to bring: Confirmation of your appointment, Identification and Insurance Card. Due to the cold weather and the limited warm waiting areas, we ask that you arrive **no more than five minutes prior to your appointment.**

For those who qualify in Phase 1a or are 75 or older, please sign up through the VAMS system. A VAMS tutorial is located on the town web site ([ridgefieldct.org](http://ridgefieldct.org)). Click on the red COVID banner and then the pink tutorial button. When ready to apply for registration, click on the orange button. **Please pay close attention to the tips** (no dashes, no caps in your email address, individual email addresses for each person and reply **NO** when asked if you have registered. Your form is to request registration only.) All these tips are in the tutorial. You will also find answers to frequently asked questions on the COVID landing page.
