

Ridgefield, CT: April 16, 2021: The Good News about Domestic Travel: Fully vaccinated travelers have less stringent guidelines than those who have not been vaccinated. Connecticut reports that fully vaccinated travelers with an FDA-authorized vaccine):

- Are less likely to get and spread COVID-19
- Do not need to get tested before or after travel unless their destination requires it
- Should continue to follow CDC recommendations for safe travel including wearing a mask, staying six feet from others, avoid crowds and wash your hands often.

Travelers who are not vaccinated should follow CT and CDC guidelines which require quarantining and/or testing upon return to Connecticut. These recommendations are not made to restrict you, but to keep you and your community safe: Review CDC guidance for post-travel quarantine and testing

Travelers should review <u>CDC's travel guidance</u> when planning travel outside of their local community. Know your <u>travel risk</u>. Do not travel if you are sick, are considered <u>infectious after testing positive for COVID-19</u>, or <u>should be quarantining after exposure</u> to a person with COVID-19. *(From: ct.gov website)*
