



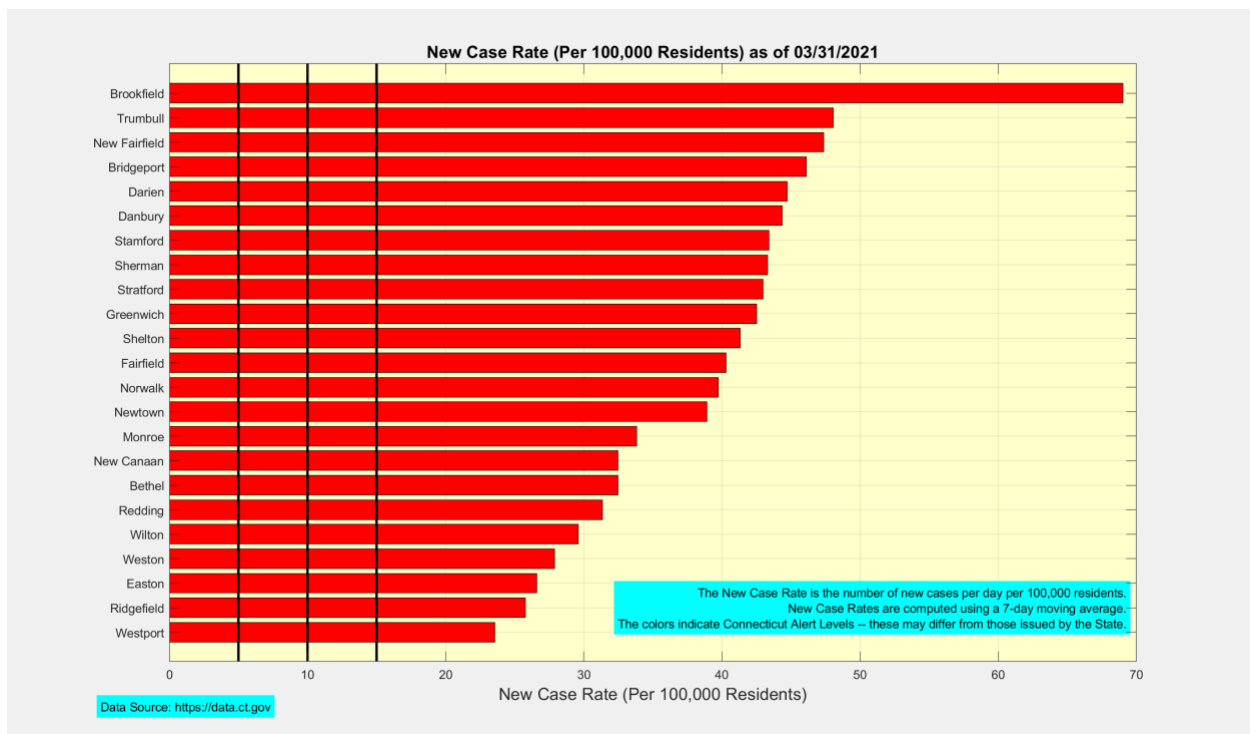

Ridgefield, CT: April 2, 2021: "Ridgefield is returning to previous lower levels of Covid new case rates and test positivity. However, with Passover/Easter and school spring break upon us, we must continue to follow protocols!" said First Selectman Rudy Marconi. "We have now brought our new case rate back to 25.8 per 100,000, which is currently one of the lower rates in Fairfield County, but we are experiencing higher fractions of new cases in ages 9 through 29." He adds that he understands pandemic fatigue and even spring fever, but he asks the community once again, to keep their eye on the goal.
