Draft Minutes of the Meeting of July 18, 2022

- 1. Mr. Binkley of Vanguard made a presentation to the Commission concerning year-to-date market performance, investment performance and overall fund performance, as well as future market assumptions. Mr. Binkley exited the meeting at 6:27 PM.
- 2. Mr. Christiansen briefed the Commission on the recent reappointment of Mr. Hayes to the Pension Commission and the status of the appointment of Mr. Zigmas Kaknevicius.
