- o Opiate forum
 - RPC interested in hosting. Laura to bring to RCCASA to gage interest
 - Discussion re: event needs to be focused and moderated. Types of positions that should be on panel: police, first selectman, doctor, someone in recovery, CARES group
 - Importance of positioning RPC as a resource
