- 5. Bids may be held by the Town of Ridgefield for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of bidders prior to the awarding of the contract.
- 6. Insurance requirements, if any, must be submitted with the bid. This includes any Hold Harmless requirements as well as Certificates of Insurance, if required, for the full amounts specified. **Unauthorized changes** to these forms, i.e. adding, striking out and/or changing any words, language or limits will cause the bidder to be disqualified.

The Town will not consider "Or Equal" brands.

Work:

- One 2-ton Mitsubishi ductless split heat pump for recreation area.
- One 3-ton Mitsubishi ductless split heat pump for meeting room area.
- One 5-ton Air Handler and condenser for office area/lobby/kitchen. Air handler and all sheet metal ductwork would be installed in the attic area of the building and must be insulated per code.
- Ductwork, supply and return plenums all shall be made of sheet metal material.
- Ceiling diffusers shall be 2x2 dropping supplies with one central lobby area return.
- Excluding one ceiling diffuser for the kitchen that will have to be cut in due to the type of ceiling.
- Flex duct will be run from the main trunk line to the ceiling diffusers only.
- Outdoor condenser would be crane lifted to lower flat roof of firehouse.
- Provide a licensed and insured electrical contractor to install all necessary electrical wiring up to code.
