Plan to build bridge that spans this gap which dips about 1.5 feet down and is rocky

Hemlock Hills Bridge Project - Location

Located just into the blue trail off the main path at Hemlock Hills in Ridgefield, CT.





Two post spots for the bridge, relatively clear allowing for concrete posts.






On top - a clearer look at the span to be covered, about 10 feet in length.

On bottom - a look at the dip, and after rainfall or in spring water runs through here making the rocks harder to navigate over.

4x4 6' post (1)


One box 3" screws (250 screws)
